The 10-day season, which complements the FORMULA 1 SINGAPORE AIRLINES SINGAPORE GRAND PRIX 2025, has become a staple on the calendar for motorheads, sports enthusiasts and party-goers alike. This year's GPSS will feature four Headliners, taking place at Sentosa, Marina Central, Plaza Singapura, and CQ @ Clarke Quay.

Jam Off 2025 at Sentosa, 27 & 28 Sep

- Music performances: Two nights of concerts headlined by Asian popstars like Rain, Ekin Cheng and Hins Cheung
- **Jam Off Voice & Jam Off Beats**: Singing and dancing contestants showcase their talents and compete for prizes and an opportunity to perform on a global stage
- Celebrity & KOLs' Streetwear Pop-ups & accessories: Retail pop-ups featuring celebrity and local designer and KOLs' streetwear, accessories & jewellery pieces.
- Race-themed F&B offerings: Booths designed with race-themed elements offering street food and specialty beverages

GrooveDriver Festival at Marina Central (Suntec City, South Beach, and Millenia Walk), 26 – 28 Sep & 2 Oct
