

Curious about Becoming a Tourist Guide (TG)? Here's What to Expect and How to Get Started!

1

Register with your preferred Approved Training Organisations (ATOs)

Research and decide which ATO has a curriculum and schedule that best suits your needs!



2

Pass an interview to begin the TG Training Programme

Upon acceptance and successful registration, begin your training programme of a minimum of 120 hours or just 2 months*. Complete the course and pass the necessary assessments and become a licenced tourist guide!



3

Apply for your TG licence on the Travel Agent and Tourist Guides Licensing System (TRUST) after completion of course and passing relevant assessments to start guiding

Find job assignments via your networks, Travel Agents or Travel Operators. Join the TG Association / Union to stay ahead of the game!



4

Proactively upskill/ practice your craft in the next 3 years, and don't forget to renew your licence!

Give the best to our travellers – proactively upskill with relevant courses/ talks/ site visits, etc throughout your career. Practice your craft regularly. Don't forget to complete the licence renewal requirements every 3 years too!



*Note: The duration will depend on whether it is a full-time or part-time course, and on the ATO you choose.
