

Insolvency & Public Trustee's Office

Insolvency & Public Trustee's Office ("IPTO") is a department of the Ministry of Law having statutory responsibilities relating to, among other things, individual and corporate insolvency, the Public Trustee and the regulation of moneylenders and pawnbrokers.

Expectations/ Scope of Internship	Interns will be exposed to the work of Legal Service Officers (LSOs) in IPTO, who perform duties that include rendering legal advice and appearing in civil and criminal matters in Court to discharge IPTO's statutory functions and duties. You may be asked to assist LSOs by conducting legal research and writing opinions on legal issues arising in the course of IPTO's work as well as to accompany LSOs to physical or virtual Court hearings.
Eligibility	1 st – 4 th year law students.
Period of Internship	Choose between either one of the two windows available: i) May – Jul 2026 ii) Dec 2026 – Jan 2027
Duration	Between 1 and 2 months. All applicants who wish to be shortlisted for an internship must be able to commit to the full period/duration of the internship.
