Expectations/ Scope of Internship	In 2026, the Attorney-General's Chambers will be offering two tranches of the internship programme, each of a three-week duration, designed to introduce applicants to what AGC does, and to find out how Legal Service Officers (LSOs) in the AGC make a difference every day. AGC's internship programme gives interns broad exposure to our work as the Public Prosecutor and Legal Advisor to the Government. All interns will be rotated among the Crime Division, Civil Division, International Affairs Division, and Legislation Division. Through a comprehensive and structured programme, interns will be directly exposed to a wide range of advisory, legislative drafting, prosecution, litigation and negotiation work, and will meet and work alongside many of our LSOs. Besides having a chance to observe real-life criminal prosecutions and civil litigation, interns will also be exposed to the seldom-seen, behind-the-scenes deliberations that shape and inform the Attorney-General's / Public Prosecutor's decisions. Apart from observing and assisting, interns will also have the opportunity to hone their litigation, advocacy, negotiation, advisory and drafting skills in simulated exercises based on real-life cases. To answer any questions and to give deeper insight into life at AGC, mentors will be assigned to interns for the entire internship programme, and the interns will also have the opportunity to speak to seasoned LSOs in management roles at each division.
Eligibility	Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents who are undergoing any course of study in the law, whether at local or overseas Scheduled Universities. Applicants must be in at least the second year of their law course. Internship places are limited and applicants will be considered on a competitive basis. AGC is looking for dynamic and committed individuals who are interested or considering a career in public service. We also seek interns who possess leadership qualities and extra-curricular or community-service experience, beyond purely academic ability. Interested applicants should fill up and return the AGC Internship Application Form (within the Internship Application Form for mid-2026 cycle), in addition to their CV and academic transcripts. Applicants are advised to give careful thought to their application submissions.
Period of Internship	Choose between: i) Tranche 1: 11 May 2026 – 29 May 2026; or ii) Tranche 2: 6 Jul 2026 – 24 Jul 2026.
Duration	3 weeks. All applicants who wish to be shortlisted for an internship must be able to commit to the full period/duration of the internship.
