The Ministry of Law's Legal Group (comprising the Legal Policy Group and the International & Advisory Group) steers policy and legislative reforms to uphold the rule of law, strengthen access to justice, and ensure a sound, progressive legal framework.

Expectations/ Scope of Internship	Interns will assist in various projects and initiatives, and undertake research and policy analysis on domestic and international legal policy. This will cover areas such as civil and criminal justice, family law, litigation funding, restructuring and insolvency, legal industry, land, intellectual property, community legal services, and international legal policy. Interns can expect to embark on rigorous legal research and analysis, study developing trends and practices in other countries, assist with statistical collation and analysis, undertake cross-jurisdictional comparative studies, and experience the application of such knowledge to policymaking in practice.
Eligibility	2 nd – 4 th year law students.
Period of Internship	Choose between either one of the two windows available: i) May – Sep 2026 ii) Dec 2026 – Feb 2027
Duration	4 weeks. All applicants who wish to be shortlisted for an internship must be able to commit to the full period/duration of the internship.
