OFFICERS

As a Supply Officer, you can look forward to leading and managing critical logistics operations—including procurement, inventory control, and distribution of supplies. We offer the opportunity to plan and coordinate mission-essential support for operational units, while upholding high standards of accounting and military logistics compliance.

WARRANT OFFICERS & SPECIALISTS

A Supply Warrant Officer and Specialist in the SAF takes charge of frontline logistics operations — overseeing the storage, accounting, and distribution of essential military equipment and supplies. You'll lead store teams, enforce logistics standards, and apply technical expertise to ensure mission readiness and sustain unit operations.
