PROTECTING OUR SEA LINES OF COMMUNICATION

Singapore sits astride major maritime trade routes, also known as sea lines of communication. Cut off our access to them and we will be isolated immediately.

The Navy plays a crucial role in maintaining access to these sea lines of communication and deterring disruption to maritime trade in the Singapore Strait.

ENHANCING OUR DIPLOMACY

The Navy contributes to the expansion of Singapore's policy space by making friends and sustaining strong relationships with fellow navies in the region and beyond.

This improves trust and interoperability, making it easier to tackle transnational maritime threats and security challenges together.





SAFEGUARDING OUR MARITIME SECURITY

The Singapore Strait is one of the world's busiest waterways, with close to 1,000 ships plying it daily. Given its proximity to our city centre and critical industries, it is crucial that the Navy ensures maritime security is never compromised.

The Navy operates 24/7 in our waters, supported by surveillance and sense-making hubs ashore, while working closely with other maritime agencies and navies to ensure our seas are safe and secure for all.

SECURING OUR PEACE

In peacetime, the Navy hones our warfighting capabilities. We are always ready to respond to the call of duty and work with friends and partners to protect the seas, which are global commons.

Should deterrence and diplomacy fail, the Navy will secure a swift and decisive victory for Singapore against any aggressor at sea.

↗ ENDURANCE-CLASS LANDING SHIP TANK

The Navy's largest ship, this platform transports personnel and equipment for overseas exercises and missions which span disaster relief to counter-piracy operations.



↗ VICTORY-CLASS MISSILE CORVETTE

Fast, feisty and fearless, these are the speediest ships in the Navy's arsenal and the backbone of our strike capabilities.



↗ FORMIDABLE-CLASS FRIGATE

Armed with cutting-edge sensors and weapon systems, these versatile stealth warships are capable of engaging multi-dimensional threats faster and further.



↗ ARCHER-CLASS SUBMARINE

These underwater hunters with enhanced stealth and endurance capabilities are armed with a high-tech sonar and torpedoes, making them deadly even from great distances.



↗ INVINCIBLE-CLASS SUBMARINE

Smarter, sharper and stealthier, the Navy's newest submarines are custom-built for Singapore's waters. With their improved endurance, sensors and firepower, nothing escapes these silent predators.

↗ **BEDOK-CLASS MINE COUNTERMEASURE VESSEL**

Its fibreglass hull lowers its magnetic and acoustic signature to reduce the risk of triggering mines, and its high manoeuvrability lets it turn 360° on its axis, making it the perfect hunter and destroyer of mines.



↗ **INDEPENDENCE-CLASS LITTORAL MISSION VESSEL**

Designed and built locally, this vessel's modularity makes it configurable for multiple missions. Its advanced combat capabilities, systems and improved automation make it mission-ready with a leaner crew.



↗ **SENTINEL-CLASS MARITIME SECURITY AND RESPONSE VESSEL**

Equipped with a range of calibrated capabilities to deal with diverse maritime security threats, these vessels improve the Navy's operational flexibility and persistence to protect Singapore's territorial waters.

↗ **SPECIALISED MARINE CRAFT**

Tasked with chasing down and cutting off rogue vessels, the Navy's coastal interceptors boast unmatched speed and agility, backed by sophisticated sensors and communication systems.

UNMANNED SYSTEMS



↗ **MINE COUNTER-MEASURE UNMANNED SURFACE VESSEL**

The Navy's next-generation mine hunters can be deployed rapidly and operated remotely with a leaner crew, all while weaving through heavy maritime traffic smartly.

↗ **SCANEAGLE UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE**

Able to be launched and recovered by vessels, the Navy's eyes in the sky extend a ship's vision by about 100km for better surveillance, situational awareness and target identification.

↗ **MARITIME SECURITY UNMANNED SURFACE VESSEL**

Capable of autonomous navigation, collision detection and avoidance in Singapore's dense and complicated maritime environment, these vessels enhance the Navy's surveillance, responsiveness and persistence at sea.


Configured for maritime patrols, this aircraft provides crucial maritime air surveillance over Singapore's sea lines of communication.



↗ S-70B SEAHAWK




↗ LANDING SHIP TANK REPLACEMENT



↗ MULTI-ROLE COMBAT VESSEL


↗ OFFSHORE PATROL VESSEL


(Trust me on this: I joined the Navy without attending a single recruitment seminar or knowing what a career in it entails. Best leap of faith ever, though!)
