

**ANNEX E-6: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL VOUCHERS AND
BUDGET 2026 COST-OF-LIVING SPECIAL PAYMENT**

The Government will provide support to Singaporean households with their living expenses through the following measures:

- (A) Community Development Council (“CDC”) Vouchers; and**
- (B) Budget 2026 (“B2026”) Cost-of-Living (“COL”) Special Payment.**

(A) Community Development Council Vouchers

Every Singaporean household will receive \$500 in CDC Vouchers. The CDC Vouchers will be split equally for spending at participating hawkers, heartland merchants and supermarkets.

The CDC Vouchers will benefit about 1.4 million Singaporean households.

The CDC Vouchers will be disbursed in January 2027 and will be valid until 31 December 2027.

(B) Budget 2026 Cost-of-Living Special Payment

Eligible Singaporeans (i) who are aged 21 and above in 2026, (ii) residing in Singapore, (iii) who do not own more than one property, and (iv) with Assessable Income (“AI”) of up to \$100,000, will receive a one-off cash payment of between \$200 and \$400. The quantum is determined by their AI and the Annual Value (“AV”) of their place of residence. Refer to Table 1 for scheme details.

The B2026 COL Special Payment will benefit about 2.4 million adult Singaporeans. The payment will be disbursed in September 2026.
