




Frequency of Binge Drinking³ among 18-34 year olds


VOLUNTEERISM & CIVIC PARTICIPATION

Regular¹ Sports Participation by Age (%)




Top 5 Popular Sports Among Youths & Young Adults (%)



Individual Smartphone¹ and Internet² Users by Age (%)




Top Internet Activities on Mobile Equipment³ Among Youth by Age (%)












