



Application / Appeal Guide for Joint Admissions Exercise (2026 Intake) ITE 2-Year *Higher Nitec* Courses

Overview

The Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE) intake for ITE 2-year *Higher Nitec* courses takes place over 3 phases:

Main Phase Application (MOE JAE)

Application Period: **Wed 14 Jan 2026 (4pm) to Mon 19 Jan 2026 (4.30pm)**



You can only submit your MOE JAE application through MOE's JAE Internet System (JAE-IS) using your Singpass.

If you do not have a Singpass, apply for your Singpass at <https://www.singpass.gov.sg> before the start of MOE JAE application.

Application will be open over 6 calendar days following the release of 2025 Singapore-Cambridge GCE 'O' Level Examination results, starting from 4pm on the 1st day of application until 4.30pm on the final day of application.

You can submit your MOE JAE application online through MOE's JAE-IS at <https://www.moe.gov.sg/jae>. You will need to login to JAE-IS using your Singpass to submit your application. If you are applying for ***Higher Nitec* in Nursing**, and are posted to the course, you will have to attend a **pre-course evaluation** at ITE College East on **Wed 4 Feb 2026**.

Combined Polytechnic-ITE JAE Appeal



Application Period: Tue 3 Feb 2026 (9am) to Fri 6 Feb 2026 (4pm)



Only those who have applied under 2026 MOE JAE are allowed to apply under the Combined Polytechnic-ITE JAE Appeal phase.

If you did not apply under the main phase, you can submit an appeal for ITE 2-year *Higher Nitec* courses under the next phase (Final JAE ITE Appeal).

If you applied under MOE JAE and were not offered an ITE course:

- You may submit an appeal for admission through the Combined Polytechnic-ITE JAE Appeal Portal at <https://jaeappeal.edu.sg> within 4 working days upon official release of MOE JAE posting results.

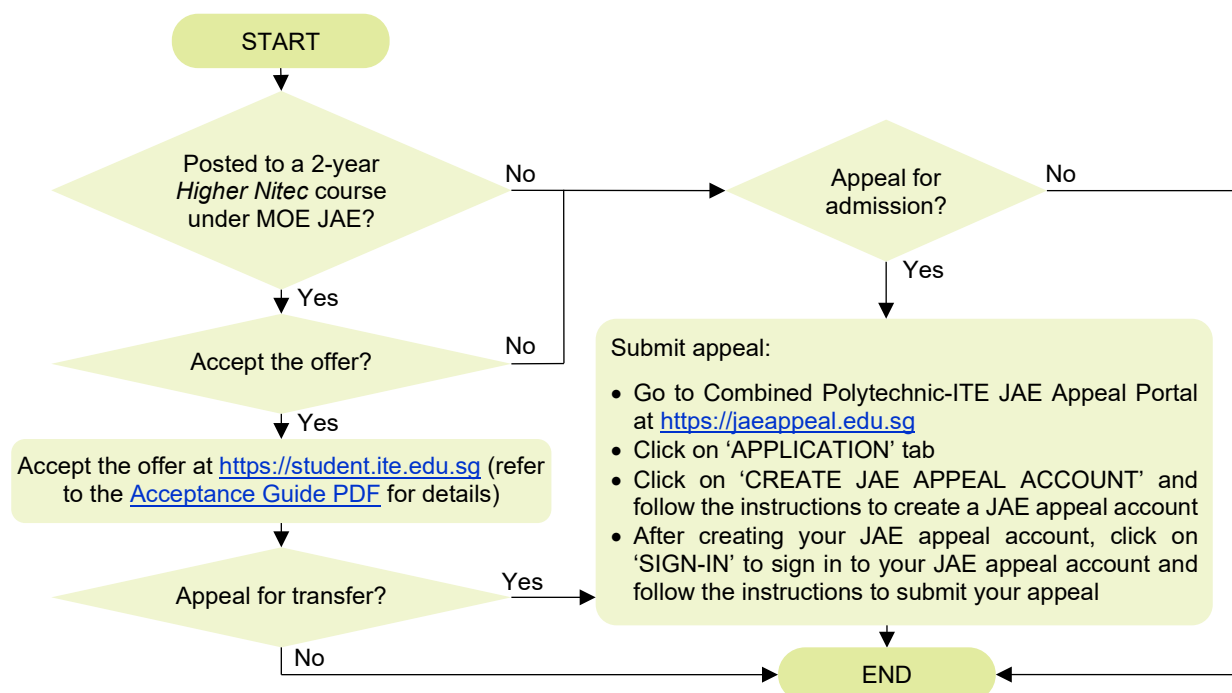
If you are appealing to transfer from your ITE course offer under 2026 MOE JAE, to another ITE course or College:

- You should **accept the MOE JAE course offer first** at <https://student.ite.edu.sg>, before submitting an appeal for change of course/College through the Combined Polytechnic-ITE JAE Appeal Portal at <https://jaeappeal.edu.sg> within 4 working days upon official release of MOE JAE posting results. If you accept the MOE JAE offer, your place in the original course will be retained if your appeal is unsuccessful.



If you are appealing for **Higher Nitec in Nursing**, and are posted to the course, you will have to attend a **pre-course evaluation** at ITE College East on **Tue 24 Feb 2026**.

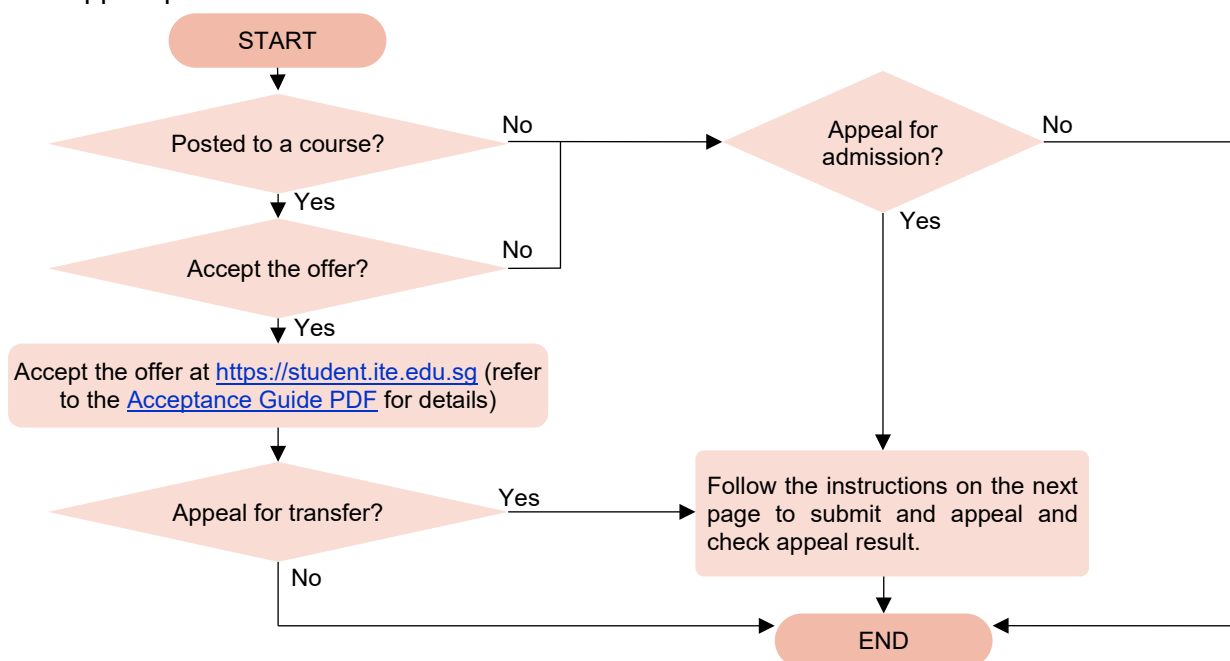

If you are appealing to transfer from your ITE course offer under 2026 Combined Polytechnic-ITE JAE Appeal, to another ITE course or College:

- You should accept the Combined Polytechnic-ITE JAE Appeal course offer first at <https://student.ite.edu.sg> during the offer acceptance period, before submitting an appeal for change of course/College through ITE website at <https://for.edu.sg/jae-ite-appeal>. If you accept the Combined Polytechnic-ITE JAE Appeal offer, your place in the original course will be retained if your Final JAE ITE appeal is unsuccessful.

You are requested to declare all information truthfully. Any false declaration will render you liable to appropriate action, including withdrawal from the course offered.

Admission is based on merit and choice of course.

Note : ITE Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) applicants with confirmed EAE course offers are not allowed to participate in this intake exercise or transfer to another course or College.

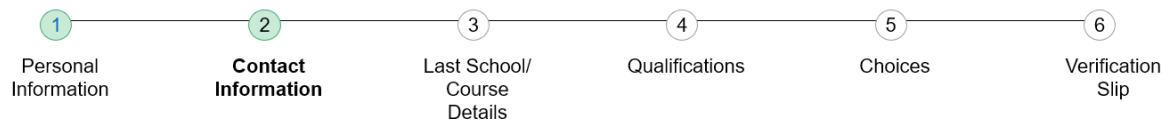
NS-liable males will be granted NS deferment for the pursuit of full-time studies at pre-university government-funded institutions including ITE if they attain a place and are pursuing a course for higher academic qualifications from what they have previously attained (e.g. from N/O Levels to *Higher Nitec*, from *Nitec* to *Higher Nitec* or from *Nitec/Higher Nitec* to ITE Work-Study Diploma/Technical Engineer Diploma/Technical Diploma courses) and NS deferment will no longer be subject to cut-off ages. Students who are not eligible for NS deferment will need to withdraw from the course that they are enrolled in.

3. You may self-declare your GCE results by following steps 4) and 5) below. You need to declare your results and CCA grade truthfully and accurately based on your result slips and CCA certificate. If you are offered a course, you are required to bring your original GCE result slips and CCA certificate for verification when you report to your College for registration. If you do not bring the documents for verification by the date stipulated in your Enrolment Letter or if you are found to falsely / incorrectly declare any part of your exam results or CCA grade, the offer of training place to you will be withdrawn and you will need to submit a new application. If you are not sure of how to self-declare your results and CCA grade, you are advised to contact or email to any of the ITE Colleges.

- For GCE 'O' Levels, key in grade 1-9, grade 9 is for failed/absent subjects

- For GCE N(A), key in grade 1-6, grade '6' is for failed/absent subjects

- For GCE N(T), key in grade A,B,C,D and E, grade 'E' is for failed/absent subjects

- For CCA grade, key in 'E' if you obtained Excellent grade, 'G' if you obtained Good grade, 'F' if you obtained Fair grade or 1-9 if you have obtained numeric grade

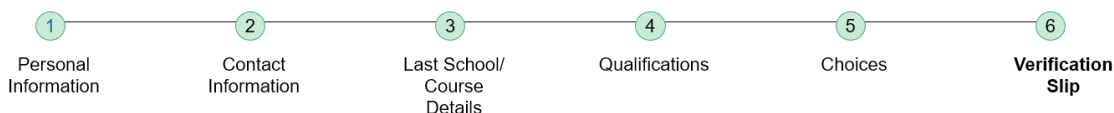
