Applicants are required to present:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Portfolio of related projects; • Documentation of participation in MOE Electives, Applied Learning Modules (ApLM) & Applied Subjects; and/or • Documentation of participation in related work attachments, community/volunteer work, school/personal activities & projects, CCAs and competitions.
