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ITE Inspire Fellows Making an Impact

The President's Challenge Fellowship (ITE Inspire), launched in 2025, was established to underscore the importance of the ITE education pathway and to recognise the achievements and contributions of ITE alumni. Jointly supported by ITE and the Singapore Business Federation Foundation, **the ITE Inspire Fellowship** honours up to five ITE alumni each year, with each Fellow receiving a grant of \$10,000 to develop initiatives that uplift and support the ITE community.

Over the past year, our 2025 ITE Inspire Fellows (**Anders Tan, Edmund Lek, Jocelyn Ng, Noel Ng and Suhaimi Sukiman**) have been working actively with ITE to turn ideas into meaningful initiatives that support students' learning, growth and development. Through mentorship, peer learning, training programmes and industry exposure opportunities, the Fellows are giving back to the ITE community in many ways, drawing from their ITE education and career journeys.

Awarded annually, **the ITE Inspire Fellowship** honours outstanding alumni who have excelled in their respective fields and serve as role models to inspire ITE students to reach their full potential. **Nominations** for the 2026 ITE Inspire Fellowship are open from 4 May to 12 June.

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New ITE Facility to Advance Security Operations Training

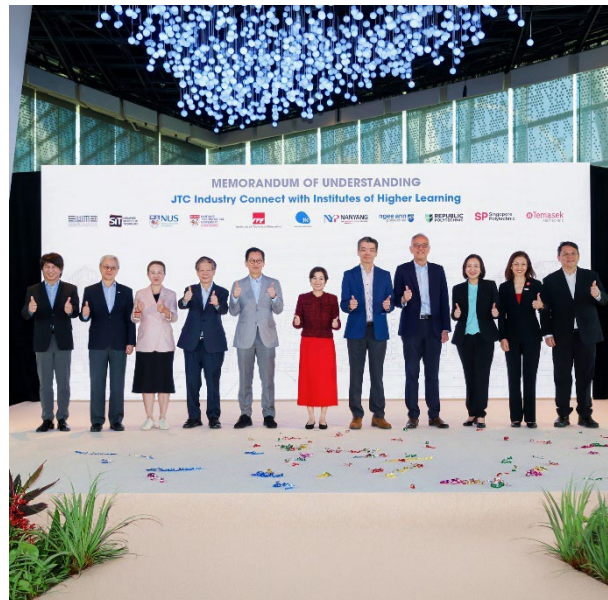
ITE has unveiled the Security Operations Training Command at ITE College Central, a purpose-built facility that enables nearly 300 Work-Study Diploma trainees annually to develop operational skills through realistic simulations. The facility features an X-ray scanning system, information galleries on prohibited and controlled items, and interactive learning stations. The launch of the facility was officiated by Assoc Prof Muhammad Faishal Ibrahim, Senior Minister of State for Home Affairs.

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ITE Joins JTC Initiative to Drive Industry Collaboration

ITE signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with JTC Corporation (JTC) and nine Institutes of Higher Learning at JTC's Customers' Day 2026 to support industry transformation. The collaboration advances efforts in digitalisation, talent development, sustainability and innovation under the JTC Industry Connect Initiative.

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ITE Strengthens Automotive Training with Porsche

ITE has partnered Porsche Asia Pacific to strengthen training in electrified automotive technologies. The collaboration includes the provision of a Macan Electric for hands-on learning, alongside internships and overseas attachments across Porsche's regional network for ITE students and staff to build industry-relevant expertise.

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New \$2 Million Sands Scholarship to Boost Hospitality Pipeline

ITE students will benefit from a \$2 million Sands Hospitality Scholarship programme launched by Marina Bay Sands and Las Vegas Sands. The programme offers scholarships, industry exposure and career development opportunities, including hands-on learning experiences within a world-class integrated resort environment.
