WTC - 1 Year On: Expanding Skills Development ITE's Workplace Training Centre Initiative Grows into Lifestyle Sector

In a continued effort to equip Singapore's workforce with practical, industry-relevant skills, ITE has expanded its **Workplace Training Centre (WTC)**¹ initiative into the lifestyle sector through a strategic partnership with anchor partner Jean Yip Pte Ltd.

This latest addition complements ITE's existing network of 15 WTCs in the Process, Construction & Maintenance (PCM) sector, reinforcing its commitment to hands-on, workplace-based training across diverse industries.

Since the inception of the collaboration with the Singapore Chemical Industry Council (SCIC) in July 2024, more than 10,000 training placements have been provided across these centres, underscoring the programme's scale and impact.

Driving Workforce Transformation

The WTC model is designed to bring structured, on-the-job training directly into the workplace, enabling companies to upskill employees in real-world environments. With the expansion into the lifestyle sector, ITE continues to respond to industry needs, ensuring training remains relevant, accessible, and aligned with sector-specific demands.
