BEFORE REPORTING TO COLLEGE

1.ACCEPT COURSE OFFER ONLINE

- If you have forgotten your login credential, you can click on the 'Forgot Credential' link at the login page
- Update Bio-data/Admissions & Other records declarations



2. PAY 1ST TERM FEES

- You are required to make fee payment regardless of your bursary/financial assistance outcome

4. PAY FOR UNIFORM PURCHASE

Pay for uniform which will cost about \$30-\$50 for 1 set (including 1 piece of PE T-shirt)

5. YOUR ORIGINAL EXAMINATION RESULT SLIP AND CCA CERTIFICATE

Bring these documents if you have self-declared this information during application



6. (FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ONLY) STUDENT PASS OR VALID IMMIGRATION PASS

 Bring your Student Pass issued by the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) for study in ITE or valid immigration pass (e.g. dependant's pass / long-term visit pass)

4. COLOUR VISION TEST (CVT)

· Applicants registering for courses that require them to be free from colour appreciation deficiency will need to take a Colour Vision Test at the College. You can do a self-test at https://for.edu.sg/cbt (see final page for list of courses)



5. NATIONAL SERVICE (NS) DEFERMENT

- NS-liable males will be granted NS deferment for the pursuit of full-time studies at pre-university government-funded institutions including ITE if they attain a place and are pursuing a course for higher academic qualifications from what they have previously attained (e.g. from N/O Levels to *Higher Nitec* or from *Nitec to Higher Nitec*)
- NS deferment will no longer be subject to cut-off ages

- Students who are not eligible for NS deferment will need to withdraw from the course that they are enrolled in.
