Withdrawal & Deferment

Withdrawal or deferment notice must be made in writing:

Food Safety Course Level 1 (Refresher)

Objective

The refresher training aims to ensure sustained awareness on good hygiene practices by food handlers as required by the Singapore Food Agency (SFA).

Who Should Attend

Chefs, cooks, kitchen helpers, food stall assistants and anyone who is involved in the preparation and handling of food.

Admission Guidelines

Participants must be able to understand and communicate in English as the training and assessment is conducted in English Language.

Participants must have passed the Basic Food Hygiene course or equivalent.

Content

- Practise good personal hygiene;
- Use safe ingredients;
- Handle food safely;
- Store food safely;
- Maintain cleanliness of equipment and premises; and
- Legislation and Case Studies; Workplace Safety

Certification

Participants who complete the course and pass the end course assessment will receive the WSQ Statement of Attainment (SOA).

Candidates certified as competent have met the licensing requirement by SFA for food handlers.
