The ITE Early Admissions Exercise (ITE EAE) allows you to apply for *Higher Nitec* courses based on your **aptitude and interests**, before receiving your *Nitec* final exam results.

If you choose not to apply to *Higher Nitec* courses through ITE EAE, you may still do so through the *Nitec* Progression to *Higher Nitec* Intake Exercise.

criteria

ITE EAE is open to:

- ITE Full-Time and Traineeship students who are in the final year of their *Nitec* course in 2025; and
- ITE Full-Time and Traineeship *Nitec* course graduates.

Your offer will be automatically confirmed if you meet GPA requirements (inclusive of CCA bonus points) for the *Higher Nitec* course. If your ITE EAE offer is confirmed, you **will not** be eligible to participate in the 2026 *Nitec* Progression to *Higher Nitec* Intake Exercise.

Bring along supporting documents e.g. portfolio of related works, evidence of relevant experiences, and CCA records to the interview.
