Things to Note Before Applying

Progression Criteria

You can view the criteria for progression to *Higher Nitec* courses based on your *Nitec* course, and the list of Colleges offering each course, at <https://for.edu.sg/nchn-entry-requirements>.

Updating of Contact Details

In your application, please check that you have updated your contact details (home and mobile phone numbers, and personal email address), so that you can receive updates regarding your application via email and SMS.

Applying for Year 2 of *Higher Nitec* Course

If your *Nitec* GPA is eligible and you are applying for entry to **Year 2** of a *Higher Nitec* course, please check that you have selected '**Yr 2 Entry**' for the course at the 'Choices' application panel.

ITE Early Admissions Exercise (ITE EAE)

ITE EAE applicants with confirmed EAE offers under Apr 2025 intake are not allowed to participate in NCHN, or transfer to another course or College.

Main Phase Application

You must meet the [progression criteria for your Nitec course](#), to submit your NCHN application under the main phase.

If you do not meet the criteria for progression to a *Higher Nitec* course, you may submit an appeal under the Final Appeal phase from Fri 14 Mar 2025.

Courses with Interview Requirement

If you have applied for **Higher Nitec in Nursing** and/or **Higher Nitec in Early Childhood Education**, you are required to login at <https://istudent.ite.edu.sg> on **Mon 3 Mar 2025 (from 9am)** to check if you are shortlisted to attend a course interview.

Course interviews will be conducted on Tue 4 Mar 2025, Wed 5 Mar 2025 or Thu 6 Mar 2025.




Under the Final Appeal phase, you can appeal for a *Higher Nitec* course listed in the [progression criteria for your Nitec course](#), regardless of whether your *Nitec* GPA meets the minimum entry requirement.

If you are appealing to transfer from your main phase course offer, to another course or College:

- ➔ You should accept the main phase course offer first at <https://istudent.ite.edu.sg> during the offer acceptance period, before submitting an appeal for change of course/College. If you accept the main phase course offer, your place in the original course will be retained if your Final Appeal application is unsuccessful.

Guide to Submitting NCHN Application / Appeal for Full-Time *Higher Nitec* Courses

Please follow the instructions given carefully. Screenshots for Steps 1 to 6 are provided from the next page.

- **Microsoft Edge and Google Chrome** are recommended. Mobile devices are not recommended.
- Go to <https://www.ite.edu.sg> and click on '**Apply for ITE Courses**'.
- Click on '**For Nitec Progression to *Higher Nitec* (NCHN)**' under '**Full-Time *Higher Nitec* Courses (Apr 2025 Intake)**'.
- Click '**Apply Now**' to link you to the application website.

Step 1

- Enter your NRIC / FIN and Date of Birth.
- Click '**I WANT TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION**'.

Step 2

- Read instructions on the screen.
- You must pass the colour vision test if you wish to apply for Applied Food Science; Architectural Technology; Automotive Technology; Chemical Process Technology; Communication Design; Electrical Engineering; Electronics Engineering; Facilities Management & Engineering; Facility Management; Film & Video Production; Filmmaking (Cinematography); Interactive Design; Interior & Product Design; Landscape Management & Design; Mechatronics Engineering; Motion Graphics; Rapid Transit Engineering; Robotics & Smart Systems; Security System Integration; Technical Theatre & Production; Vertical Transportation; Visual Effects; and Visual Merchandising courses. To find out if you are free from colour appreciation deficiency, go to <https://colormax.org/color-blind-test> to do a self-check.
- Otherwise, click '**NEXT**' to proceed.

Step 3a

- Check through the particulars displayed on the screen. You may make changes to your NS status (if required).
- Click '**NEXT**' to continue.

Step 3b

- Update your address, home & mobile phone numbers and email address. Your email address will be used to provide you with details of your application; notification of interview (if shortlisted), and your Enrolment Letter (if successful).
- Click '**NEXT**' to continue.

Step 3c

- This page shows your *Nitec* qualification used for the application. Check your *Nitec* qualification. If you have more than one *Nitec* qualification, you can click on the magnifying glass to select the *Nitec* qualification that you wish to use for your application.
- Click '**NEXT**' to continue.

Step 4

- Enter your choice(s) of courses and Colleges, in order of preference. You can select up to 12 choices under main phase, or one choice under Final Appeal.
- Select '**Yr 1 Entry**' for progression to Year 1 (1st year), or '**Yr 2 Entry**' for progression to Year 2 (2nd year) of *Higher Nitec* course. Depending on your progression eligibility, you can apply for Year 1 or Year 2, or both Year 1 and Year 2 of *Higher Nitec* courses in your application choices.
- Check through your choice(s). Then, click '**SUBMIT**'.

Step 5

- Click '**YES – SUBMIT**' to confirm and submit your application.

Step 6

- You will see on the screen a verification slip with the choice(s) you have made, and your web ID and password.
- Click '**PRINT**' at the bottom of the page to **print a copy of the verification slip for your reference**. You will need your web ID and password to view the result of your application.

- You are allowed to make changes to your application only once over the Internet. Please follow the instructions in the verification slip for making changes to your application over the Internet. The application for *Nitec* progression to full-time *Higher Nitec* courses (2025 April) is open from 10/01/2025 (4:00PM) to 15/01/2025 (11:59PM).

The main phase application from 10 Jan 2025 to 15 Jan 2025 is for *Nitec* graduates and *Nitec* (Sector) certificate holders who meet the GPA criteria for progression to *Higher Nitec* courses. *Nitec* graduates and *Nitec* (Sector) certificate holders who do not meet the GPA progression criteria could submit their appeal online at this website between 14 Mar 2025 and 10 Apr 2025.

Please read through the [progression criteria based on your Nitec course](#) before submitting your application.

Admission is based on relevancy of *Nitec* qualification to *Higher Nitec* courses applied, merit and vacancies. You are advised to select your choice of courses carefully and fill up all the choices, where applicable.

You are requested to declare all information truthfully. Any false declaration will render you liable to appropriate action, including withdrawal from the course offered.

Note : ITE Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) applicants with confirmed EAE course offers are not allowed to participate in this intake exercise or transfer to another course or College.

NS-liable males will be granted NS deferment for the pursuit of full-time studies at pre-university government-funded institutions including ITE if they attain a place and are pursuing a course for higher academic qualifications from what they have previously attained (e.g. from N/O Levels to *Nitec/Higher Nitec*, from *Nitec* to *Higher Nitec* or from *Nitec/Higher Nitec* to ITE Work-Study Diploma/Technical Engineer Diploma/Technical Diploma courses) and NS deferment will no longer be subject to cut-off ages. Students who are not eligible for NS deferment will need to withdraw from the course that they are enrolled in.

- For the following courses with interview requirement, **priority in selection will be given to first-choice applicants**, based on your results. It is **recommended that you indicate your preferred course as your first choice**, if you are applying for them:
 - Early Childhood Education
 - Nursing

Applicants who are keen in courses with interview are encouraged to apply for a mix of courses with interview and courses without interview in their choices to maximise their chance of posting.

If you are shortlisted for one of the above courses, you will be **required to attend an interview** to assess your suitability for the course. If you are unsuccessful at the interview, you will be **considered for your remaining choices which do not require interview for admission**.

For all other courses, based on the results of applicants, selection will be by merit and choice.
- Please select courses accordingly in the order of your choice. The order of your choices and number of choices will determine the course offered (01 for 1st choice, 02 for 2nd choice, 03 for 3rd choice, 04 for 4th choice, etc).
- Please select Yr 1 Entry for progression to Year 1 (1st year) and Yr 2 Entry for progression to Year 2 (2nd year) of *Higher Nitec* course. Depending on your progression eligibility, you can apply for Yr 1 Entry or Yr 2 Entry or both Yr 1 Entry and Yr 2 Entry to the *Higher Nitec* courses in your application choices.
