

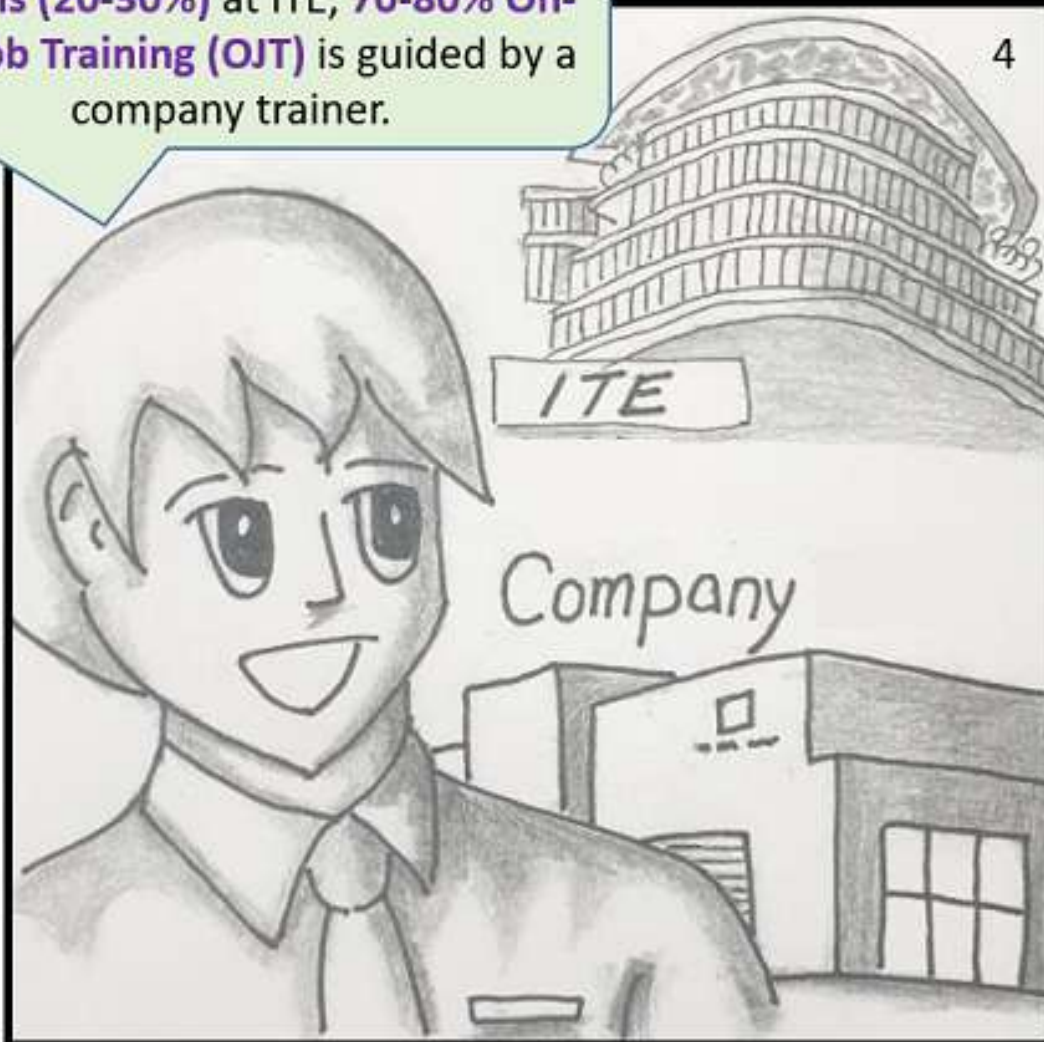

Entry requirements are as follows:

- **Nitec graduates** from relevant feeder courses with **minimum GPA 2**
- **Higher Nitec graduates** from relevant feeder courses
- **Existing (In-service) employees** with strong support from their employer

To prepare for the application:

- **Read up about the course**
- **Find out about the nature of the industry** to prepare for the job interview
- **Update your resume with relevant skillsets**

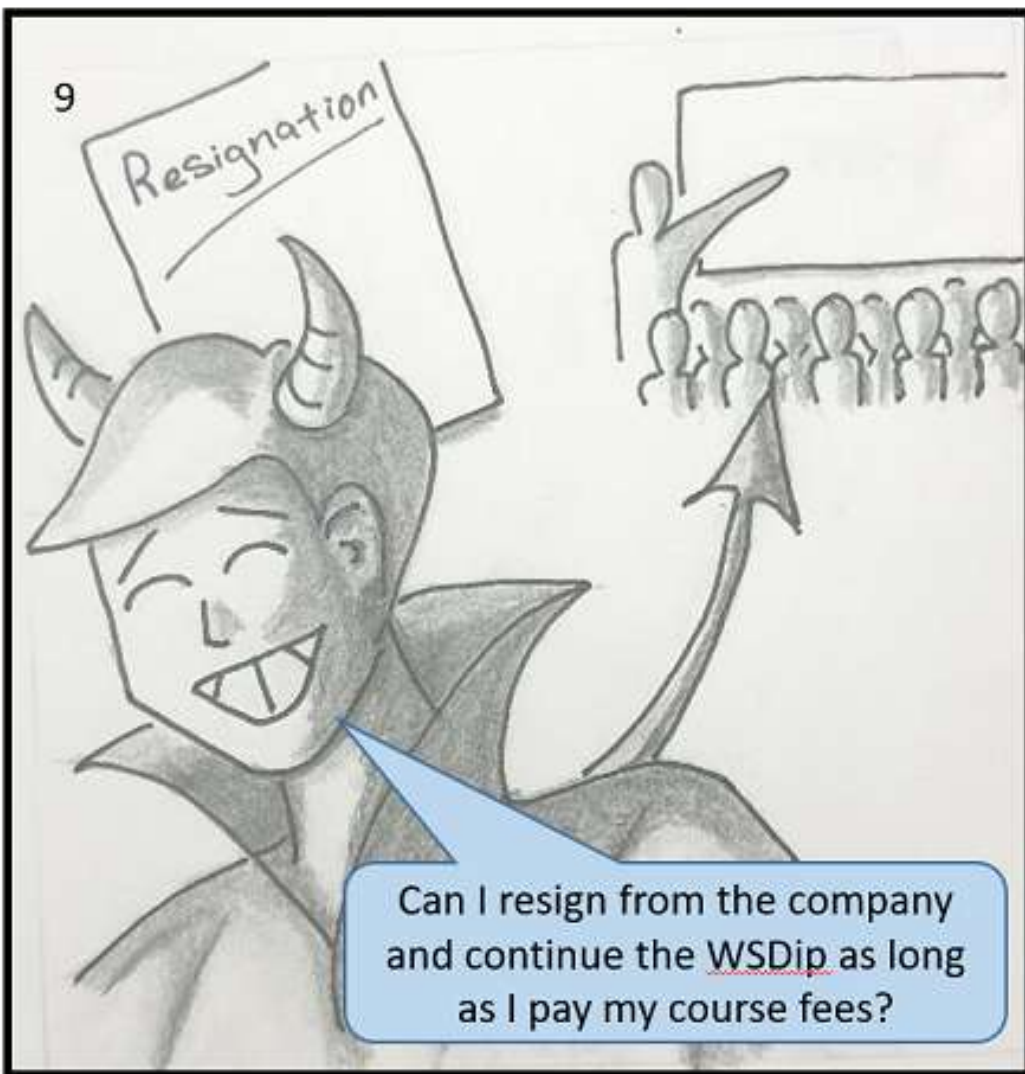


No, you can't.

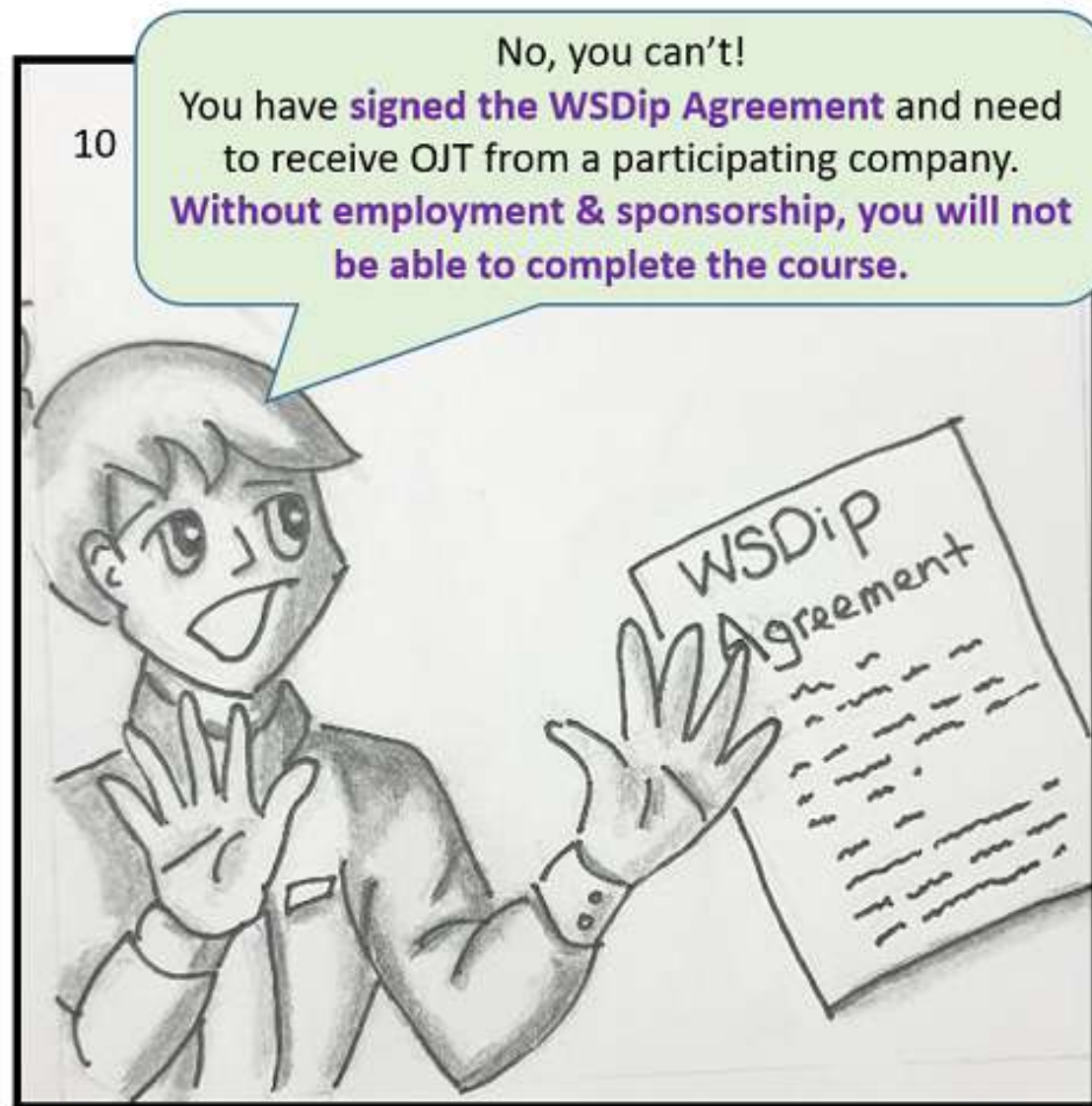

Can I resign from the company and continue the WSDip as long as I pay my course fees?

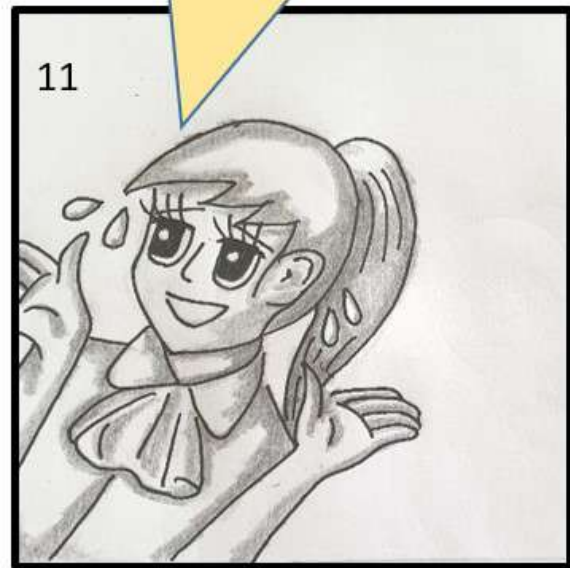

No, you can't!
You have **signed the WSDip Agreement** and need to receive OJT from a participating company.
Without employment & sponsorship, you will not be able to complete the course.

What happens if I give up halfway or fail some of the modules?

If you don't complete the course, you will **NOT**:

- **Attain the Work-Study Diploma**
- **Receive any module certificates**

AND will need to:

- **return the sign-on incentive that has been given to you**

Failing WSDip modules:

- **WSDip Trainee will have to pay the Module Repeat fees**
- **WSDip Trainee will also need support from company to repeat failed modules**

Singaporean trainees who have graduated
from a **ITE full-time relevant feeder course**
or **ORD within 36 months**;

and he/she is **NOT** a **BCA-Industry Built
Environment ITE Scholarship Recipient**

The following trainees are **NOT** eligible:

- **Singapore PR** and **LTVP+** holders
- Graduated from **Non-relevant** ITE course
- Graduated from ITE or ORD for **more than 36 months**
- Graduated from a **Continuing & Education Training (CET) course**
