The Lee Kuan Yew Awards for ITE students were instituted in 1999 through the sale proceeds of the special edition of the memoirs of Singapore's first Prime Minister, Mr Lee Kuan Yew, titled, The Singapore Story. A sum of \$555,000 was donated to ITE for the establishment of the awards.

The Lee Kuan Yew Gold Medals for ITE students are aimed at promoting technical education by giving greater recognition to the achievements of ITE students and trainees.

Lee Kuan Yew Gold Medals are awarded to the top graduates from ITE College Central, ITE College East and ITE College West, who have excelled in their course of study and co-curricular activities, and made contributions to an enriching College life.

His passion for the built environment sparked her own interest in the field. Although she faced challenges with English and foundational subjects from a young age, the unwavering support of her parents, coupled with her determination, gave her the confidence to pursue this course at ITE.

At ITE, hands-on training in AutoCAD, technical drawing, and industry-linked projects strengthened her skills and confidence in Civil and Structural Engineering Design. She excelled through discipline, perseverance, and the support of her lecturers and peers. This dedication led to strong academic achievement, including a GPA of 4.0, repeated appearances on the Director's List, and completion of the ACE Programme for high academic achievers. Qian Tong emerged as Outstanding Graduate (School of Engineering) for the Class of 2026, ITE College East.

As President of the Community Service Club, she led meaningful initiatives such as Meals on Wheels, partnering with Bethesda Care Services to deliver meals to beneficiaries monthly. GRIT MEETS GROWTH

After graduating with a *Nitec* in Electronics, Computer Networking & Communications in 2022 with a perfect GPA of 4.0, Eden Lai Guan Sen chose to pursue an ITE Work-Study Diploma (WSDip) in Applied Electronics & AI. It was a pathway that offered both industry experience and a measure of financial independence.

His decision was driven by both ambition and necessity. During his *Nitec* years, Eden worked in food delivery to support himself. For the past three years, he has lived independently, paying for his own rent, utilities and essentials. As one of six siblings, he learnt early the value of self-reliance while his younger siblings were cared for at home.

Through the WSDip programme, Eden grew in confidence and maturity. He learnt to take initiative, speak with assurance and see the bigger picture. Entrusted with projects that improved workplace processes, he contributed meaningfully while deepening his skills on the job.

Balancing the demands of school and work was not easy, but Eden persevered, driven by a determination to build a better future for himself.

FROM CIRCUITS TO CODE

Foo Wei Jiang Ronald's interest in software development began not in a classroom but online. Watching videos of people build websites and train machine learning models, he became fascinated by what code could create. Building on the strong electronics foundation from his *Nitec* in Aerospace Avionics and *Higher Nitec* in Robotics & Smart Systems, Ronald enrolled in ITE's Work-Study Diploma (WSDip) in IoT & Data Engineering after National Service to deepen his expertise in software and AI.

At Anewtech Systems, Ronald contributed to Aitom, an AI agent platform designed to help businesses address manpower shortages, improve customer engagement, and reduce operational costs. He trained AI agents using the company's products, services, and operational knowledge. As a result, Aitom's AI agents can now handle routine customer enquiries through avatar-based interactions. As part of the project, Ronald developed an AI retail agent which was deployed at a jewellery retailer, enabling customers to receive personalised product recommendations through a self-service kiosk without a salesperson.

He also contributed to developing an AI trainer agent capable of delivering lessons from uploaded slides, assessing students' understanding, and responding to queries in real time. The solution was trialled at ITE and later adopted by a polytechnic.

Like most people, Muhammad Hafiz Bin Abdul Rahman used to step into a lift without thinking twice about how it worked. Today, he knows just how much skill, precision and responsibility go into keeping lifts safe and reliable.

After earning a polytechnic diploma in Mechatronics Engineering and completing National Service, Hafiz began his career in the shipyard industry. When the COVID-19 pandemic disrupted the sector, he joined Sigma Elevator Singapore Pte Ltd as a technician in 2020. In 2023, his manager encouraged him to enrol in ITE's Work-Study Diploma (WSDip) in Vertical Transportation to deepen his skills.

As a husband and father of one, Hafiz balanced work, study and family life, often waking at 4 a.m. to revise. The WSDip programme equipped him with knowledge he could apply directly at work, strengthening his skills and confidence. He also valued his lecturers' industry experience and practical teaching.

Today, Hafiz leads a team of nine service technicians supporting lifts across a town council and private and commercial buildings. His story is one of reinvention, resilience and a drive to keep learning.

MORE THAN A RIDE

"For many people, a lift ride lasts only a few seconds. For me, it opened the door to a stable and meaningful career. The WSDip programme gave me the chance to learn, work and earn a diploma at the same time, while building the skills needed in this industry."

Hafiz hopes to earn certification as a lift and escalator inspector, pursue a local degree, and advance into a managerial role in the lift industry within five years.

After completing *Nitec* in Automotive Technology with a GPA of 3.8 in 2022, he briefly followed what his family and friends saw as the typical route into Mechanical Engineering at a polytechnic. Returning to ITE in 2024 to pursue the Technical Engineer Diploma (TED) in Automotive Engineering allowed him to sharpen his skills, grow in confidence, and return to what he truly loved.

Andric's academic journey was not without obstacles. Beyond the financial pressures he faced, he also struggled with mathematics early on and had to put in extra effort to build his confidence. Beyond his studies, he led his class in organising a welfare visit to a nursing home. To support himself, he worked part-time in F&B while taking on freelance automotive photography jobs. His greatest source of strength remains his mother, a single parent whose love and sacrifices shaped his resilience.

Andric completed a 10-week internship with a premium car dealer, where he worked on high-performance vehicles and gained exposure to various aspects of the business, including customer service, operations, VIP events, and advanced hybrid vehicle systems. He also found a group project on producing a video about electric vehicles especially memorable, as it allowed him to combine his photography and videography skills with his engineering knowledge.

Keith further demonstrated his technical abilities, cross-cultural awareness and communication skills during the Overseas Student Exchange Programme at Germany's Gottlieb-Daimler-Schule 1. Working alongside German peers, he contributed to the "Robotic Arms Conveyor Sorting System" project, broadening his global perspective while deepening his engineering knowledge.

WIRED TO BUILD

Lee Yao Wei's fascination with machines began at a young age. As a child, he would take apart remote-controlled cars just to understand how they worked. At age 11, he watched a video of robots playing soccer, which left a lasting impression and inspired him to enrol in *Nitec* in Mechatronics & Robotics before progressing to ITE's Work-Study Diploma (WSDip) in Automation Engineering. There, he deepened his technical skills while gaining hands-on industry experience.

During his WSDip industry training, Yao Wei worked alongside engineers and suppliers to bring automation solutions to life, designing electrical panels, creating schematic diagrams, and programming logic controllers and collaborative robots (cobots).

One of his most significant assignments took him to a branch facility in Malaysia, where he was deployed for a month to implement an automated palletising system. Yao Wei designed the electrical schematics and carried out the system wiring, helping to transform a labour-intensive process into an automated production line capable of handling weight verification, sealing, and barcode scanning. The solution improved productivity while reducing human error and manpower needs.

FINDING CONFIDENCE THROUGH CHALLENGES

"I have always been passionate about automation and building systems that could improve or solve operational challenges. The WSDip gave me opportunities to apply what I learnt and take on projects I never imagined I could handle so early in my career. I am grateful to my manager and lecturers for their guidance, which helped me grow both professionally and personally."

AFTER ITE

Yao Wei is currently serving National Service. He hopes to sign on with MINDEF and pursue a Degree in Electrical and Electronic Engineering, or Robotics at a local university through sponsorship.

With each transition came new demands, and with them, a deeper conviction that learning is key to adapting and progressing.

Though trained in Human Resource Management, Moh Teck took on an additional Facilities Management portfolio in 2018. Instead of seeing the technical field as a hurdle, he saw it as a chance to grow. That decision led him to complete two part-time courses with ITE – a *Nitec* in Technology - Built Environment (Mechanical & Electrical Services) in 2023, followed by a *Higher Nitec* in Technology - Facility Management in 2025.

His training in air-conditioning, piping, plumbing, and electrical and mechanical services has helped him manage assets more effectively, strengthen workplace safety and health compliance, and respond more confidently to maintenance needs. More than a qualification, the experience gave Moh Teck renewed confidence and purpose. His journey shows that growth is not limited by age, but by the courage to step beyond one's comfort zone and embrace lifelong learning.

"Never underestimate vocational skills. They are hard skills for life, and to me, innovation often begins with those hands-on skills. I grew up learning technical drawing, metalwork, woodwork and basic electricity in secondary school, and these skills have served me in both my work and personal life in ways I never expected."

Moh Teck is currently taking a subject titled *Trusts & Advanced Planning*, which covers estate planning, as part of the Modular Certificate in Community Law, a part-time course at Temasek Polytechnic.
