RETURN TO




This year's National Day Parade (NDP) will return to the National Stadium for the **first time in 10 years, bringing together 42,000 Singaporeans** for a more immersive and inclusive celebration. NDP 2026 also marks 50 years since the first parade was held at the old National Stadium in 1976.

- Suggested questions for facilitators to pose to audiences:

 4. Besides the National Stadium, what other spaces bring Singaporeans together to create shared memories? *(e.g., hawker centres, neighbourhood parks, community clubs, Gardens by the Bay, Marina Bay, Sentosa, libraries, Changi Airport, heartland town centres, East Coast Park, void decks)*

PARADE HIGHLIGHTS

NDP 2026 will feature the **largest civilian participation** in over a decade, with more than 1,200 participants from 26 civilian contingents in the Parade & Ceremony segment. It will also see the **largest and most diverse representation of persons with disabilities** to date.

For the first time, the **Presidential Gun Salute (PGS) and State Flag Flypast will be conducted at the Kallang Basin**, bringing the parade experience closer to spectators across the wider Kallang precinct.

The Show segment will showcase NDP's **first indoor drone show** with 300 drones and its **largest indoor special effects presentation**. It pays tribute to **Singaporeans' unwavering spirit and resilience** that have shaped our nation's past, strengthened our present, and inspire us to *Go Beyond*.

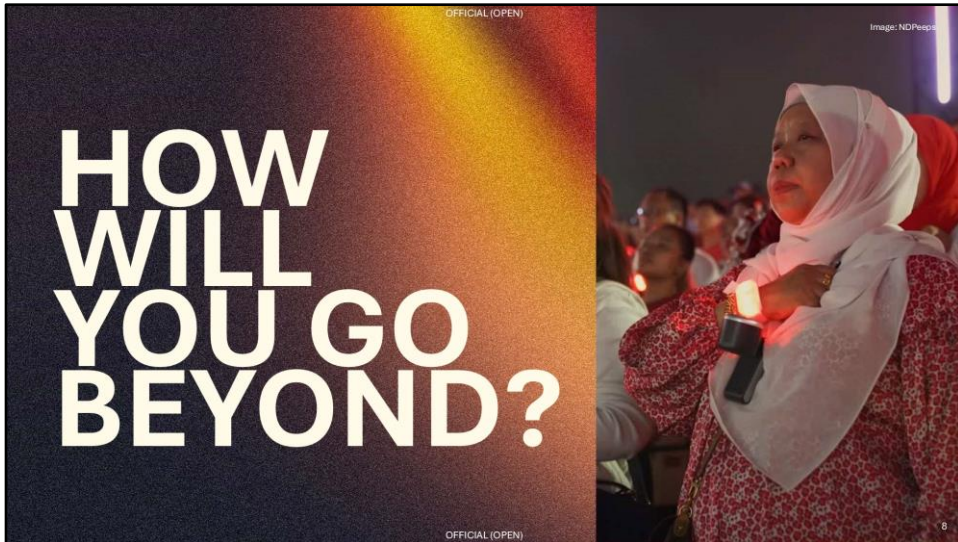
WE, THE CITIZENS
