





How will students apply to post-sec pathways in 2028?

With the common Singapore-Cambridge Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) examination from 2027, all students will use their SEC results to **apply for various post-secondary pathways at the same time, starting from January 2028.**



There will be a new **Post-Secondary Admissions Exercise** replacing the current admission exercises for admissions to Post-Secondary Education Institutions such as Junior Colleges (JC), Millennia Institute (MI), Polytechnics and the Institute of Technical Education (ITE).



FOR STUDENTS COMPLETING SECONDARY SCHOOL IN 2027





“All pathways and courses are available for selection on a single platform. Students can see all the courses that they are eligible for, and they can select and rank their choices based on their preference.

To encourage students to choose schools and courses based on their strengths and interests, choice order will be introduced as a posting tie-breaker when they have the same net aggregate scores, in the following order:
