


# Refreshed Approach to Support Primary School Students with Academic Strengths and Talents

MOE will broaden access to existing school-based provisions in all primary schools to **develop students in their domains of strength**. Students assessed to benefit from further stretch can choose to attend weekly advanced modules after school at a designated centre near their primary school.



# More Support for Students from Disadvantaged Backgrounds

From 2026, MOE will:


Provide **additional manpower and funding to more schools** to strengthen structures, processes and programmes


# New Post-Secondary Admissions Exercise in 2028

MOE will **streamline the application process to Post-Secondary Education Institutions** through a new Post-Secondary Admissions Exercise (PSE) in 2028.

This new process will start with the results release of the first cohort of the Full Subject-Based Banding students sitting for the Singapore-Cambridge Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) examinations in 2027.




## SEC Timeline



# Expand Special Education (SPED) School Capacity

From the second half of 2026 to the early 2030s, **SPED school capacity will be expanded** to meet rising demand for students with Autism Spectrum Disorder with Intellectual Disability (ASD-ID).

# Strengthen Students' AI Literacy Throughout Their Education Journey

## General Education

We have **integrated AI literacy** into curriculum, co-curriculum, **self-directed learning** resources, and **updated Cyber Wellness lessons** so that students can identify information from generative AI or deepfakes.

We will **update the "Code for Fun" programme** to strengthen students' AI skills, and make it available to all schools in 2027.



## Higher Education

Institutes of Higher Learning (IHLs) will **enhance their AI curriculum**, such as by increasing opportunities for IHL students to learn domain- and discipline-specific AI competencies.

IHLs will continue to refine the delivery of soft skills and core competencies under the **Lifskills Framework\*** to help students meet the changing demands of an AI-pervasive world.

## More Support for AI Upskilling

SkillsFuture Singapore (SSG), in partnership with the Singapore Institute of Technology (SIT), will develop a **self-diagnostic AI readiness tool** that can be accessed via the MySkillsFuture portal, allowing users to gauge their AI readiness and receive relevant course recommendations. SSG will also work with partners to improve AI awareness and adoption in SMEs.

IHLs will offer selected AI-related courses for their alumni at a significant discount for one year.

\* The LifeSkills framework consists of 10 key competencies, which include innovation, critical thinking and interpersonal and collaboration skills.

## Taking SkillsFuture Forward

SSG and Workforce Singapore (WSG) will **merge into a new statutory board** in 2H2026.


This will integrate SSG's training and skills development capabilities with WSG's employment facilitation ecosystem to further advance the SkillsFuture movement.

MOE will continue to work with IHLs, to provide high-quality, industry-relevant, and accessible training for Singaporeans to upskill, leading to tangible career outcomes for individuals and employers.

## Expand the SkillsFuture Level-Up Programme (SFLP) Course Catalogue

From Q4 2026, the SFLP course catalogue will be expanded to include eligible **Workforce Skills Qualification (WSQ) full qualification courses**.

These courses span a wide range of sectors such as Healthcare, Information and Communications, Engineering, Media and Early Childhood.




## Improve Employer Incentives for the ITE Work-Study Diploma

For new cohorts from April 2026, MOE and SSG will **increase the incentive quantum**, with simplified milestone-based disbursements over the course duration.



SSG will launch a **revamped MySkillsFuture portal** by 2Q 2026 to provide a more customised user experience and encourage industry-relevant upskilling. Users can also expect a more seamless course enrolment process on the portal.



# More Support for Mother Tongue Language Learning and Promotion Committees (MTLLPCs) to Strengthen Bilingualism


**MTLLPCs will receive increased funding to support a wider range of Mother Tongue Language learning programmes for students and parents.**
