COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCILS ADVANCE A 'WE FIRST' SOCIETY WITH THE LAUNCH OF JOBS NEARBY @ CDC

 Initiative brings jobs closer to residents through personalised support that bridges the last mile gap in connecting jobseekers to opportunities closer to their homes

Following Prime Minister and Minister for Finance, Mr Lawrence Wong's National Day Rally announcement that the Community Development Councils (CDCs) will spearhead a new job matching initiative, the CDCs officially launched Jobs Nearby @ CDC on 23rd October 2025 at Taman Jurong CC.

- 2 Prime Minister Wong attended the event as the Guest-of-Honour. Also in attendance were Ms Low Yen Ling, Senior Minister of State for Trade and Industry & Culture, Community and Youth, Chairman of the Mayors' Committee, and Mayor of South West District; Mr Baey Yam Keng, Mayor of North East District; Mr Dinesh Vasu Dash, Mayor of South East District; Ms Denise Phua, Mayor of Central Singapore District and Mr Alex Yam, Mayor of North West District.
- Jobs Nearby @ CDC is a localised job matching initiative that will bolster employment support for residents by connecting them with job opportunities within their communities. Recognising the importance of accessible employment options, the initiative leverages on the CDCs' deep understanding of local needs and networks. Jobs Nearby @ CDC has three key components:















- i) Job Ambassadors ambassadors will be deployed progressively across the five districts and will serve as the first touchpoint, offering residents personalised support and career advice tailored to their needs and aspirations. This hands-on approach goes beyond traditional job boards by providing customised support, end-to-end guidance throughout the job matching and placement process between jobseekers and potential employers.
- ii) **District Job Banks** each district will maintain a Job Bank consolidating opportunities from local employers, providing a one-stop platform for residents to access openings within their community while strengthening ties with businesses keen to hire locally.
- iii) Community Job Clinics currently held at 42 locations, the clinics in the neighbourhood will make job searching more accessible, giving resident jobseekers interview opportunities with potential employers and equipping residents with the tools and confidence to secure meaningful employment closer to their homes. The job clinics, as listed in Annex B, will be operational from 23 October 2025 and more will be progressively rolled out in every district.
- Jobs Nearby @ CDC was soft launched in the South West District on 31 August 2025 and has received encouraging results.
- One successful jobseeker was Ms Jariis Tan, 36, who had been a stay-home-mum caring for her young children. Ready to return to full-time work, she needed a job close to her home in Boon Lay, with flexibility for family responsibilities. Through the support and guidance from Job Ambassador, Ms Cheryl, interviews from prospective employers who could accommodate her circumstances were arranged, and Ms Tan successfully secured a suitable customer service position within two weeks.















A "We First" Commitment

- For over two decades, CDCs have been trusted community partners, demonstrating proven capability through their extensive networks and last-mile delivery of national schemes such as SME Centres @ CDC (since 2013), SkillsFuture @ CDC (since 2017), and the CDC Vouchers Scheme (since 2020).
- Building on this strong foundation, new initiatives such as Jobs Nearby @ CDC will further strengthen the CDCs' role in aggregating partners and resources to build cohesive communities and meet residents' evolving needs—embodying the "We First" spirit that will guide Singapore's continued development.
