The Indian delegation comprised Minister of Finance and Corporate Affairs Nirmala Sitharaman, Minister of External Affairs Dr S Jaishankar, Minister of Commerce and Industry Piyush Goyal, and Minister of State for Ministry of Commerce & Industry and Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology Jitin Prasada.

Two Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) to collaborate on (i) food safety and (ii) maritime heritage, as well as (iii) one Letter of Intent (LOI) to cooperate in telecommunications and broadcasting, were exchanged.

The fourth India-Singapore Business Roundtable was held in parallel with the ISMR.
