Established in 2001, the Economist Service (ES) is the premier scheme for professional economists in the Singapore public sector.

The Ministry of Trade and Industry is the ministry headquarters for the ES. ES officers are deployed across various public agencies in Singapore to shape public policies through the application of Economics thinking and the conduct of rigorous economic research and analyses. Through the use of robust data-driven empirical approaches, ES officers contribute their expertise to inform a wide range of public policies, from economic policies to fiscal, socio-economic, health, security and infrastructural policies.





As an ES officer, you will have a well-defined career progression pathway with systematic rotation opportunities. You will have opportunities to attend local and overseas conferences, be seconded to international organisations, and further your studies through our Master's and PhD scholarships. These opportunities will enhance your technical skills and keep you updated on the latest economic research and policy initiatives.

Our remuneration packages are competitive, regularly reviewed, and benchmarked against private sector salaries to reflect market developments.



ECONOMIST SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP



The ES Scholarship attracts talented students (pre-tertiary and tertiary) to become public sector economists. It supports local and overseas undergraduate studies in Economics under the terms and conditions of Public Service Commission (PSC) scholarships.

As an ES scholar, you will be integrated into the community of ES officers throughout your studies and have the opportunity to participate in internships at MTI and relevant ministries. You may also be sponsored for a Master's degree upon graduation.

ECONOMIST SERVICE RESEARCH ASSISTANT PROGRAMME

The ES offers internships through the ES Research Assistant Programme. As a research assistant, you will work with ES officers in MTI and other government agencies to conduct quantitative analyses to inform public policy development. This programme allows you to participate in applied research work, expand your professional network, and gain an understanding of a career in the ES and the Singapore public sector.

The ES Research Assistant Programme is open to undergraduates or graduate students enrolled in an Economics or related course.

Internship positions are available throughout the year. As places are limited, priority will be given to the penultimate-year university students.
