

SENIOR MINISTER OF STATE LOW YEN LING ATTENDED THE 23RD CHINA-ASEAN EXPO AND RELATED EVENTS IN NANNING, GUANGXI

1. Senior Minister of State (SMS) for Culture, Community and Youth & Trade and Industry Ms Low Yen Ling made an official visit to Nanning, Guangxi, China from 16 to 19 September 2026. SMS Low attended the opening ceremony of the 23rd China-ASEAN EXPO (CAEXPO) on 17 September and visited Singapore's National and Commodity Trade Pavilions. SMS Low also met with her counterparts and Singapore and Chinese businesses during the trip.
2. The CAEXPO is an annual trade fair and an important platform to promote bilateral economic cooperation between ASEAN countries and China. Singapore has been an active participant of the CAEXPO and its related activities since 2004, with the Singapore Business Federation consistently supporting our presence at the CAEXPO by organising the Singapore delegation and facilitating business connections. This year, the Singapore National Pavilion and Commodity Trade Pavilion featured over 50 Singapore exhibitors across technology, finance, transport and logistics, education, food and beverage and travel sectors keen to venture further into ASEAN and China. The CAEXPO provides participating Singapore companies with the platform to explore opportunities for collaborations and expansion into these new markets.
3. SMS Low said, "CAEXPO continues to be an important platform for leaders and businesses from ASEAN and China to build connections, exchange ideas and forge new partnerships. This year, we are glad to have over 50 exhibitors participate in the CAEXPO, the highest number we have had since 2023. As Singapore prepares to assume the ASEAN Chairmanship and CAEXPO Country-of-Honour in 2027, I encourage businesses across ASEAN and China to make full use of CAEXPO to deepen economic cooperation, including in emerging areas such as digital connectivity and green growth. Stronger ASEAN-China ties will create more opportunities for our businesses and people, and contribute to a more connected and resilient regional economy."
4. SMS Low also called on Guangxi Party Secretary Chen Gang, where they affirmed the strong ties between Singapore and Guangxi, and exchanged views on potential areas for future cooperation. As part of her visit, SMS Low also visited the Guangxi-ASEAN Embodied AI Pilot Training Base which develops and tests embodied AI and robotics solutions for industrial applications in Guangxi and Southeast Asia, as

well as the Pinglu Canal Exhibition Centre which documents the Pinglu Canal's development, key engineering features and strategic significance to Guangxi's maritime connectivity and regional trade.
