Deputy Prime Minister (DPM) and Minister for Trade and Industry Gan Kim Yong is on his first trip to Germany in his current capacity from 25 to 28 March 2026, to build bilateral relations with his counterparts and strengthen economic ties.

2 In the first leg of his trip, DPM Gan was in Berlin and met with German political leaders, including Federal Minister of Research, Technology and Space Dorothee Bär, Federal Minister for Digitalisation and State Modernisation Karsten Wildberger, Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy (BMWE) Parliamentary State Secretary Stefan Rouenhoff, and other Members of the Bundestag. He also met with the German business chambers including the German Chambers of Industry and Commerce (DIHK) and the Federation of German Industries (BDI).
