

Travelling to Singapore?



Here's what you need to know when going through customs



Step 01. Declare Before You Arrive

Use the Customs@SG Web App to quickly and securely declare and pay duty and/or GST online.



Scan QR code to use **Customs@SG** →

- ✔ Works on mobile
- ✔ Save time at checkpoints

Step 02. Understand Your GST Import Relief

If you are not a crew member or valid pass holder (work, student, dependant or long-term), you may qualify for GST import relief on your overseas purchases.

Time spent outside Singapore	Value of Goods Granted GST Import Relief*
48 hours or more	Up to S\$500
Less than 48 hours	Up to S\$100

*Excludes dutiable goods

*Only standardised packaging with the SDPC mark is allowed

Step 04. Duty-Free Concession

This applies to travellers aged 18+ and away for 48 hours or more:

	Spirits	Wine	Beer
A	1 litre	1 litre	-
B	1 litre	-	1 litre
C	-	1 litre	1 litre
D	-	2 litre	-
E	-	-	2 litre

Note: Travellers arriving from Malaysia are not entitled to the duty-free concession.

Step 05. Before You Go Through Customs

Choose the right channel:



If carrying:

- Used personal belongings
- Taxable goods within your GST import relief amount, or if you have paid the GST required
- Dutiable goods within your duty-free concession, or if you have paid the duty/GST required



If carrying:

- Dutiable or taxable goods exceeding your duty-free concession or GST import relief
- Controlled or restricted goods
- Prohibited goods
- Goods for sale or business use
