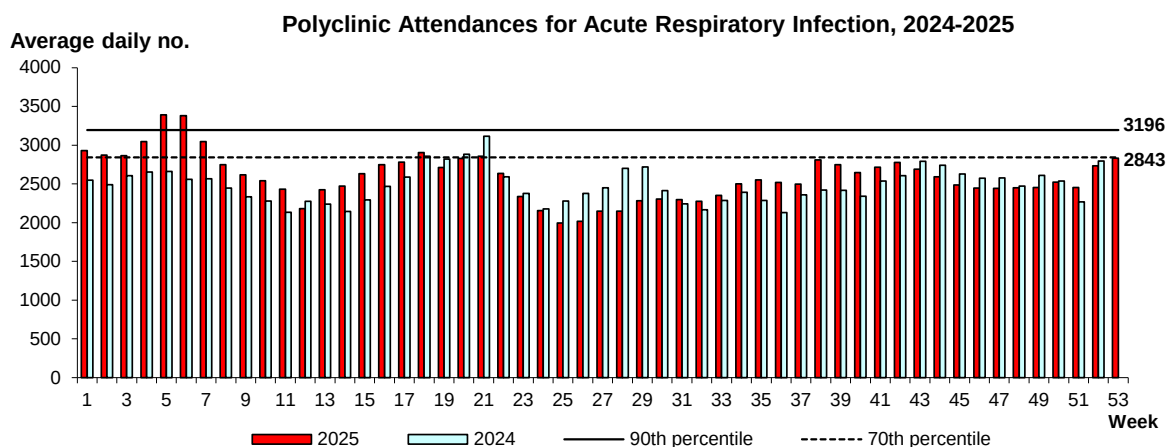

Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) Situation in Singapore 2025

ARI indicators for E-week 53 (28 Dec 2025 - 3 Jan 2025) were as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI was 2832 (over 4 working days) in E-week 53.



In E-week 53, the top respiratory pathogens among adult and paediatric samples from the National Surveillance Programme for Acute Respiratory Infection[§] (ARI) were:

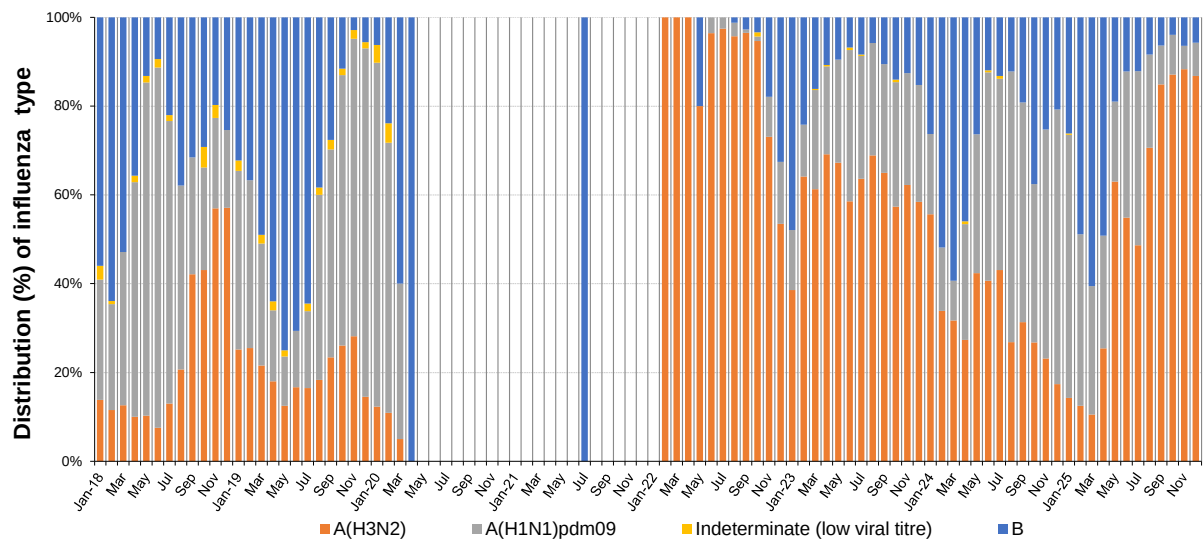
- Adult samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (20%), influenza (18%), and non-SARS seasonal coronaviruses (7%).
- Paediatric samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (34%), influenza (12%), adenovirus (7%), parainfluenza viruses (7%), and respiratory syncytial virus (7%).

[§] CDA monitors the trends of respiratory pathogens in the community through our sentinel surveillance programme for Acute Respiratory Infections (ARI) which includes polyclinics and selected general practitioner (GP) clinics.

COVID-19 and Influenza

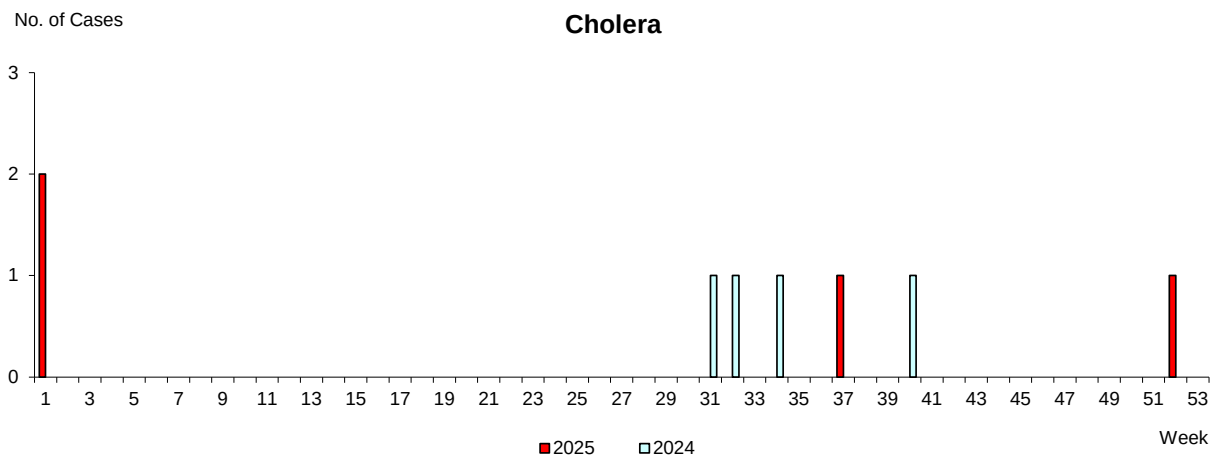
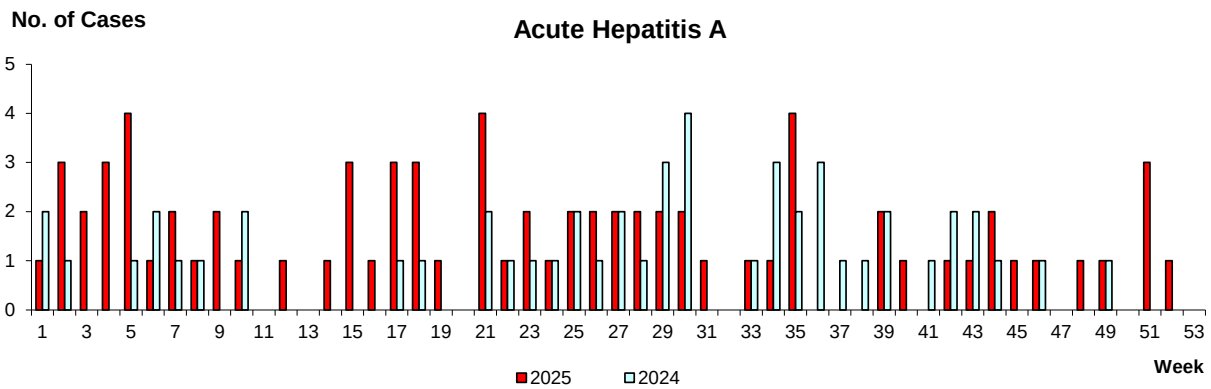
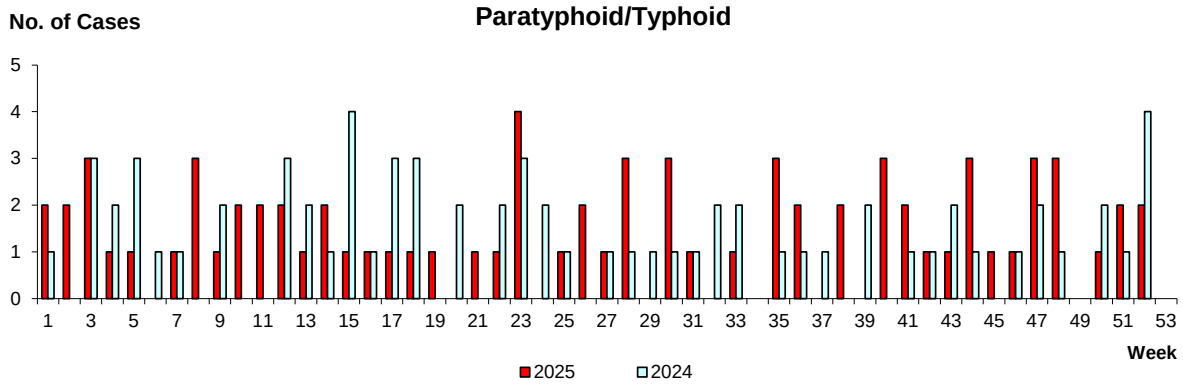
The proportion of patients with influenza-like illness (ILI) among the polyclinic attendances for ARI was 0.4%. The positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n= 119) in the community was 22% in E-week 53. The positivity rate for COVID-19 among ARI samples (n= 194) in the community was 1% in E-week 53. Of the 121 specimens tested positive for influenza in December 2025, nine were positive for influenza A(pH1N1) (7%), 105 were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (87%), and 7 were positive for influenza B (6%).

Monthly Influenza Surveillance

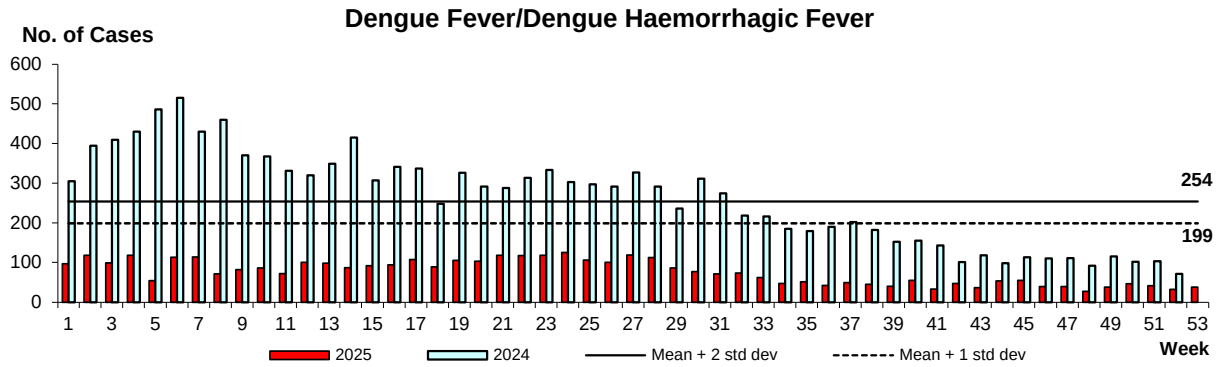

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



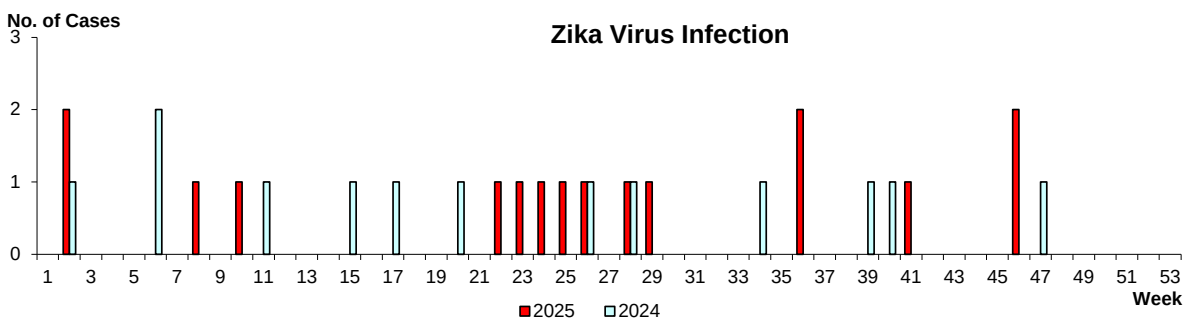
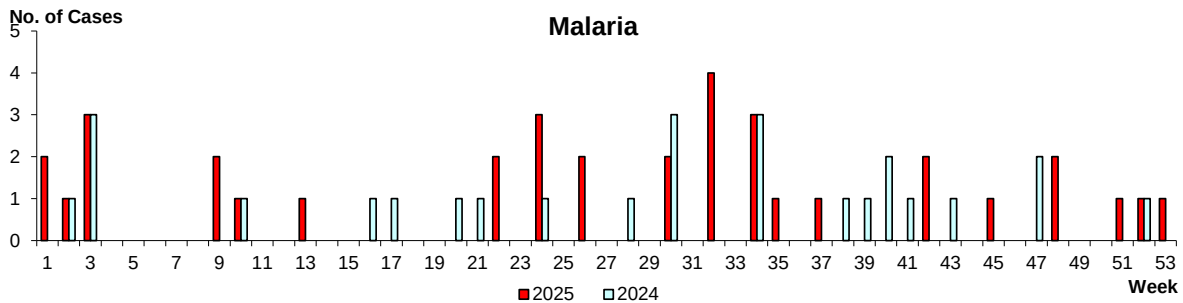
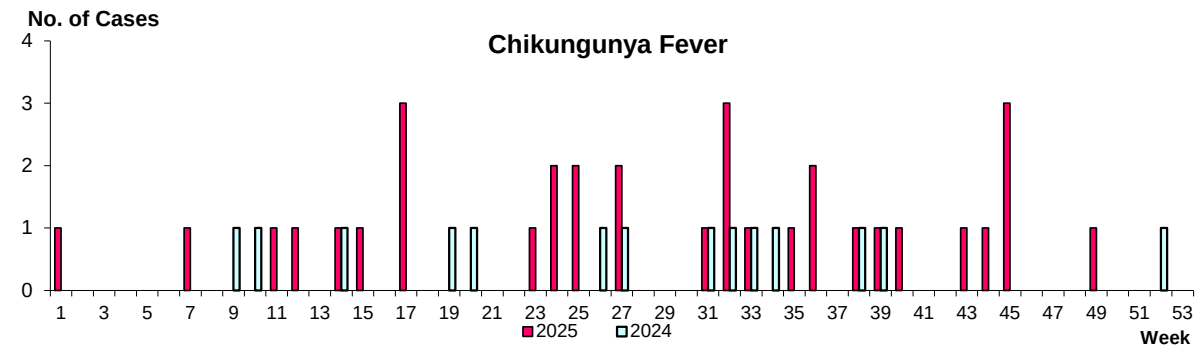
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF VECTOR-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



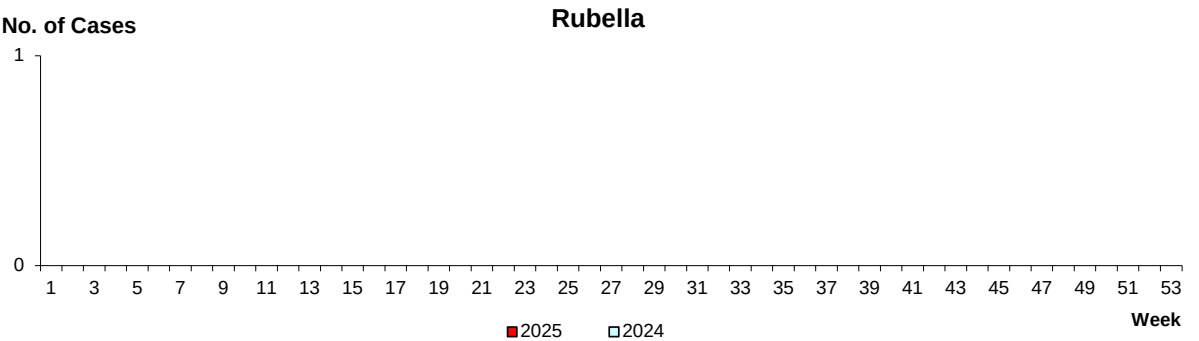
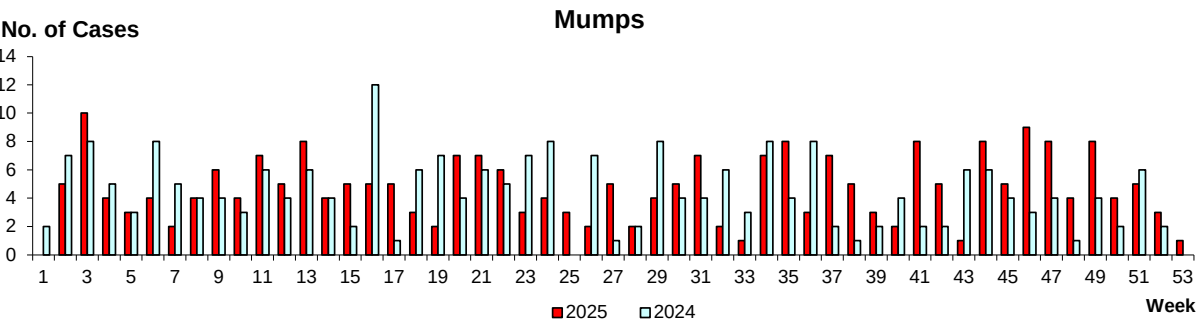
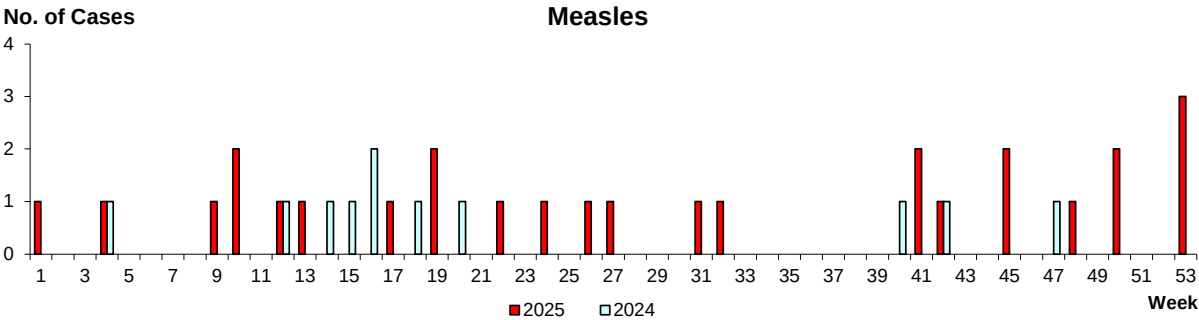
The number of dengue notifications was 38 in E-week 53.

The number of hospital admissions remains stable at 4 in E-week 53, compared to 4 in E-week 52.

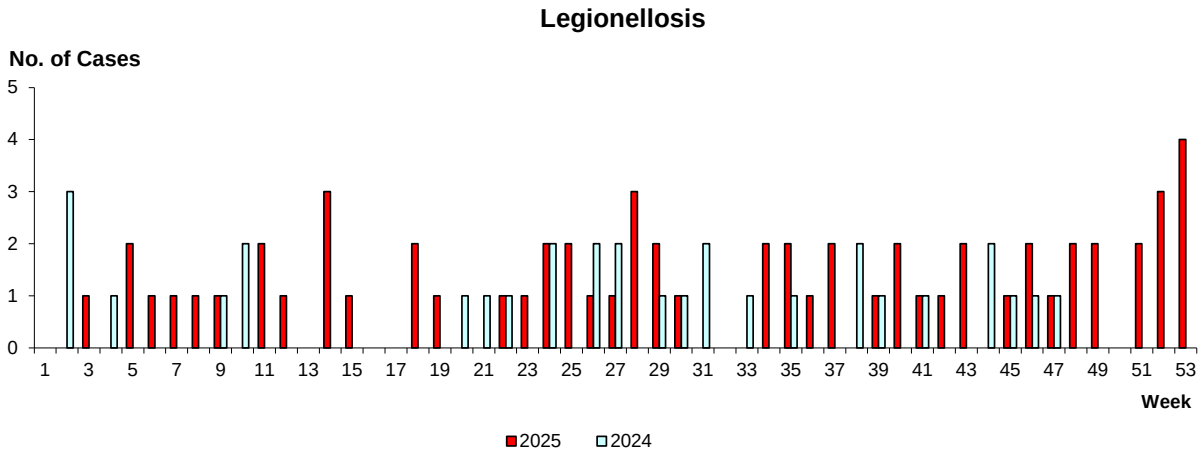
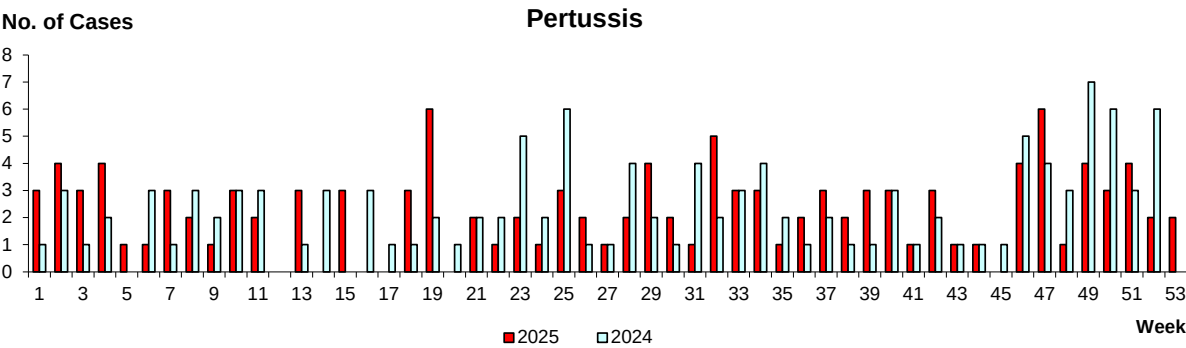
Preliminary results of all positive dengue samples serotyped in December 2025 showed DEN-1, DEN-2, DEN-3 and DEN-4 at 9.5%, 52.4%, 33.3% and 4.8% respectively.



WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025

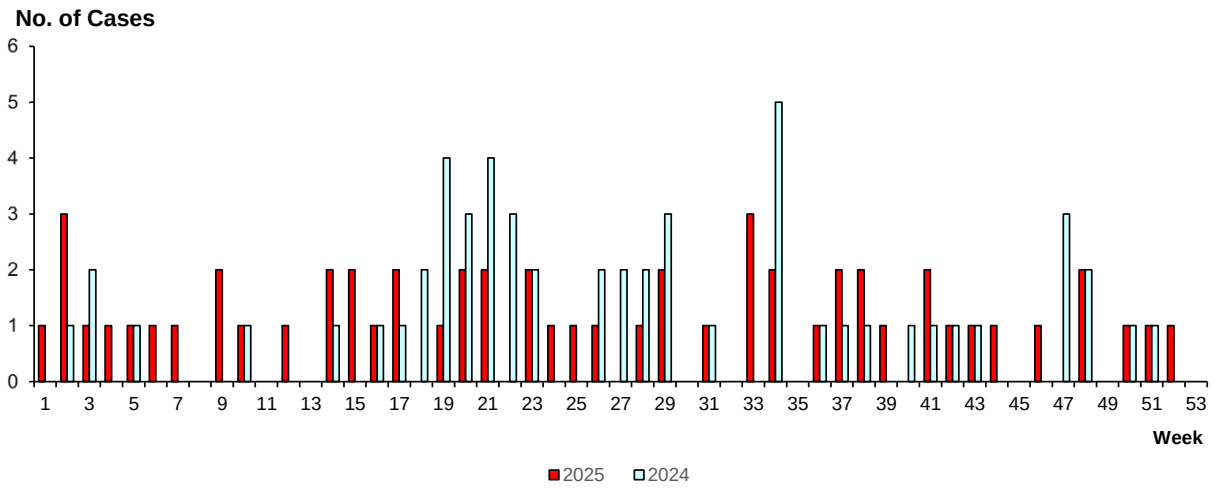


WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025

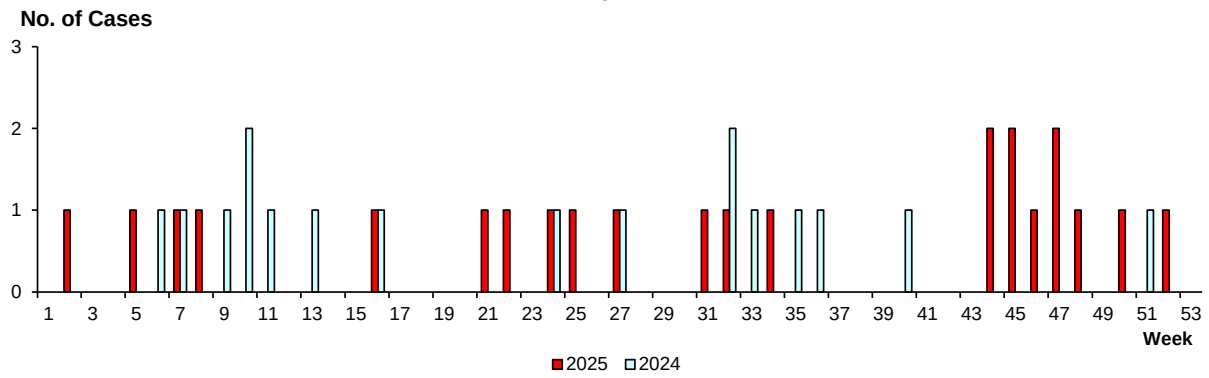

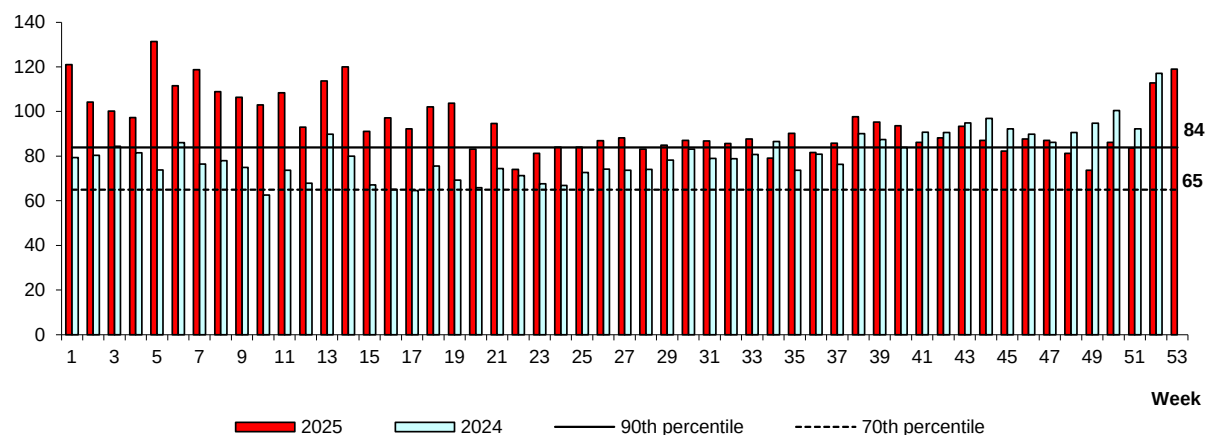

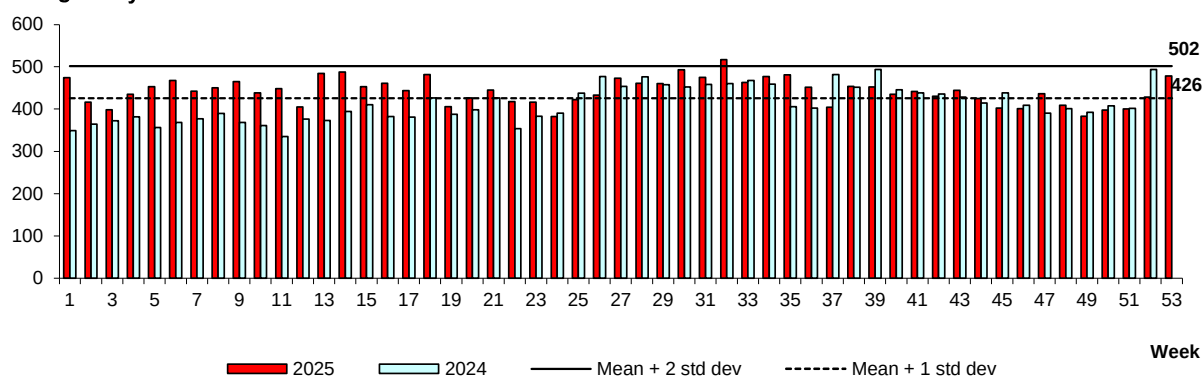
Conjunctivitis
