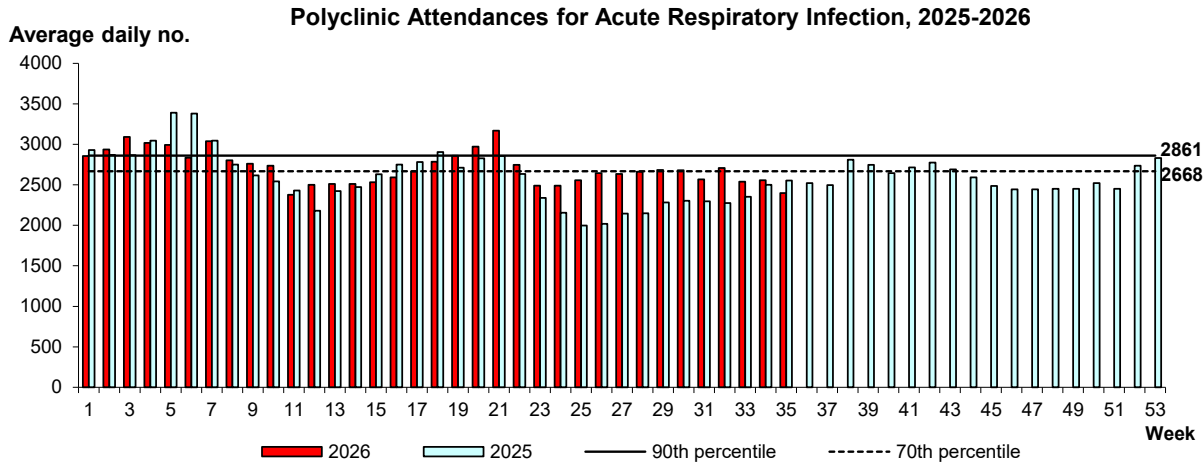

Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) Situation in Singapore 2026

ARI indicators for E-week 35 (30 Aug 2026 - 5 Sep 2026) were as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI was 2399 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 35.



In E-week 35, the top respiratory pathogens among adult and paediatric samples from the National Surveillance Programme for Acute Respiratory Infection[§] (ARI) were:

- Adult samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (22%), influenza (20%), and human metapneumovirus (5%).
- Paediatric samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (24%), influenza (24%), and respiratory syncytial virus (14%).

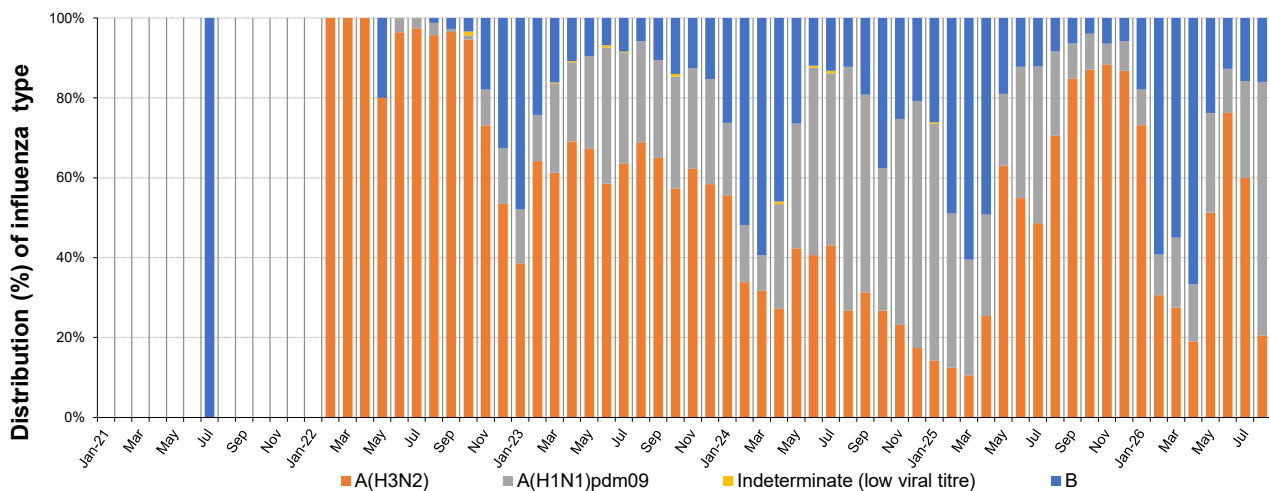
[§] CDA monitors the trends of respiratory pathogens in the community through our sentinel surveillance programme for Acute Respiratory Infections (ARI) which includes polyclinics and selected general practitioner (GP) clinics.

COVID-19 and Influenza

The positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n= 183) in the community was 38% in E-week 35. The positivity rate for COVID-19 among ARI samples (n= 323) in the community was 3% in E-week 35.

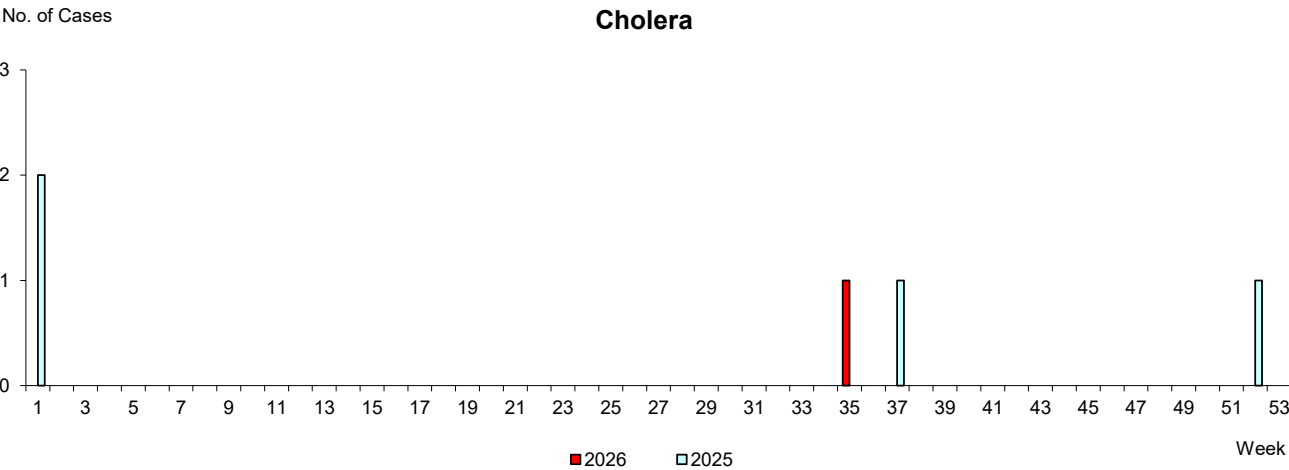
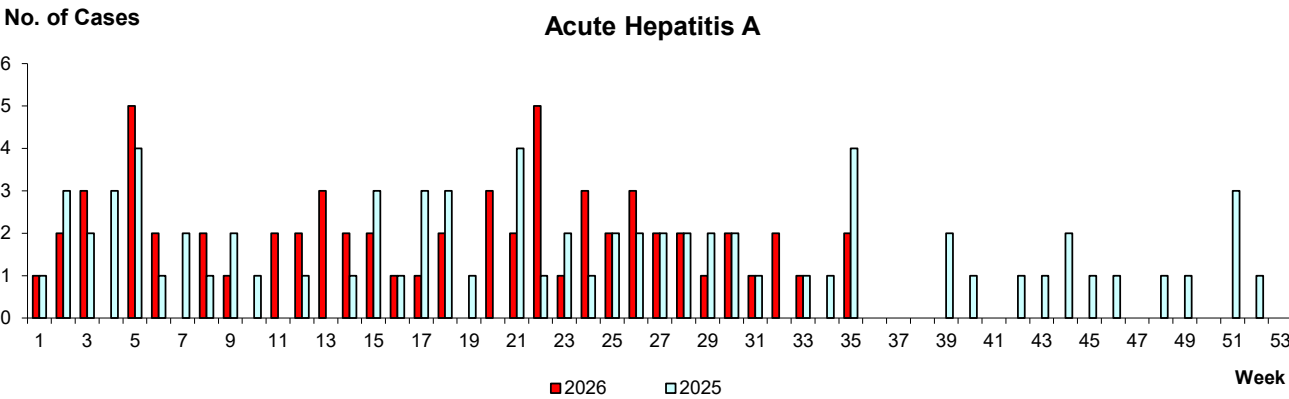
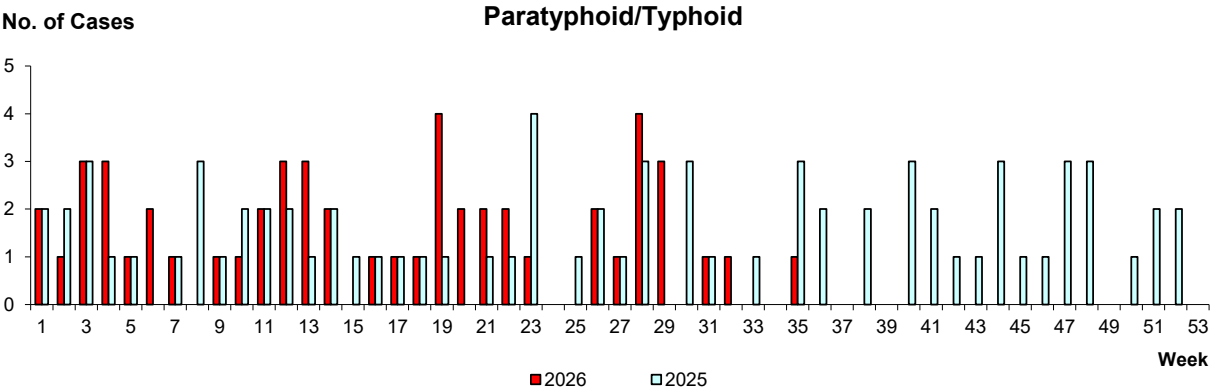
Of the 200 specimens tested positive for influenza in August 2026, 127 were positive for influenza A(pH1N1) (63.5%), 41 were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (20.5%), and 32 were positive for influenza B (16.0%).

Monthly Influenza Surveillance

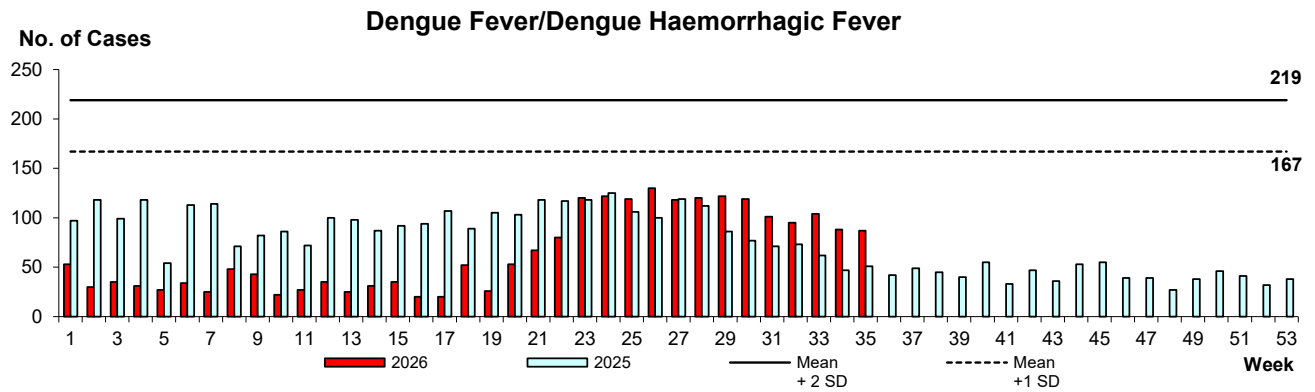

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026



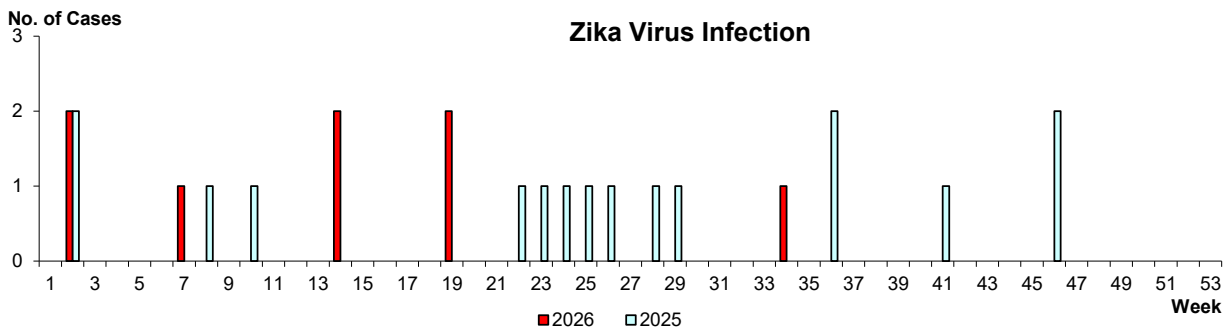
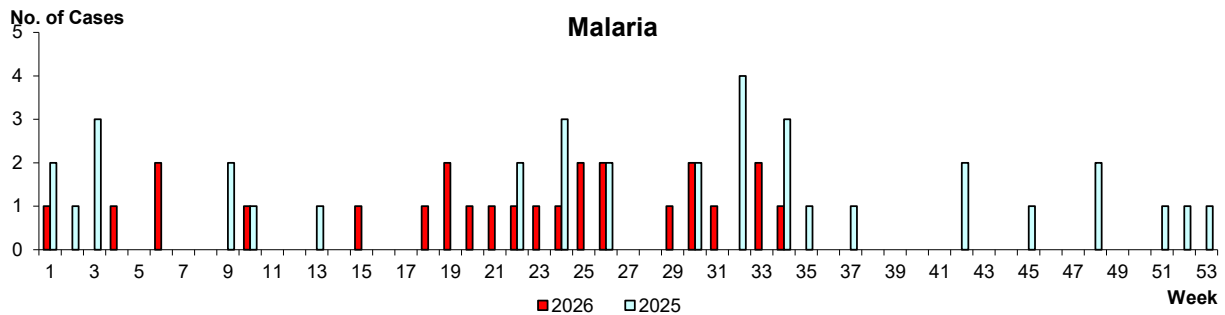
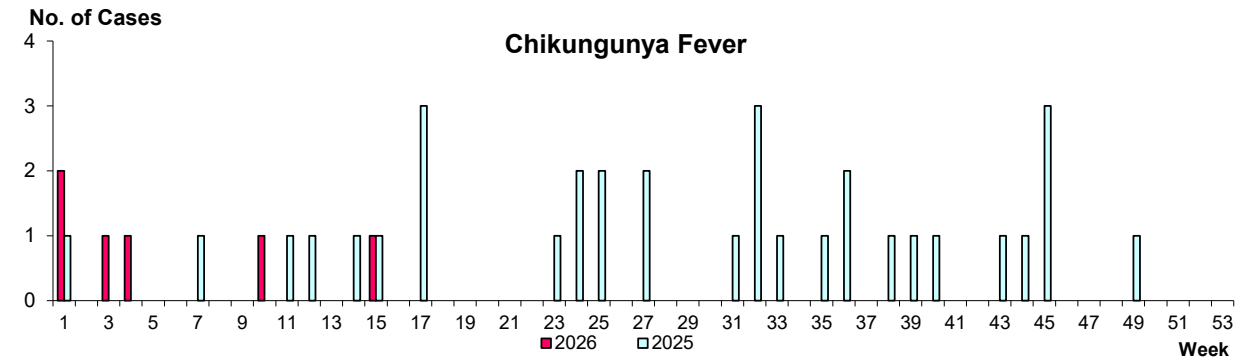
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF VECTOR-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026



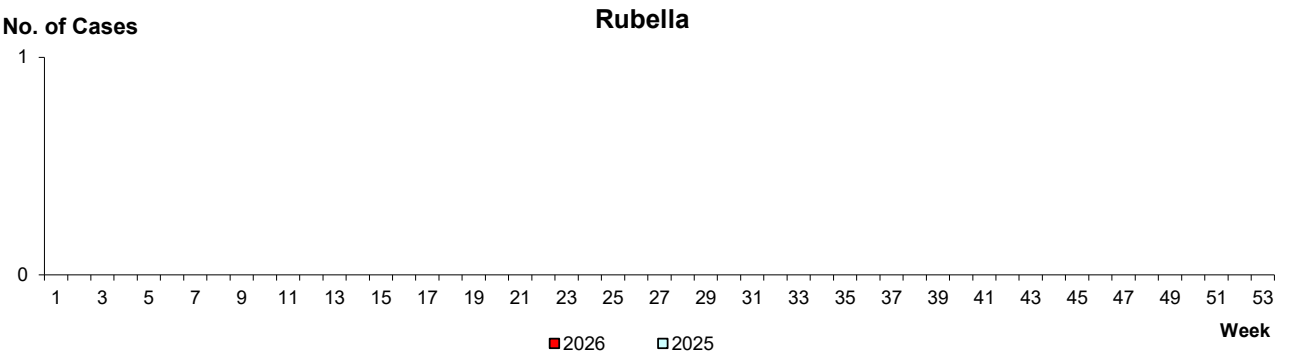
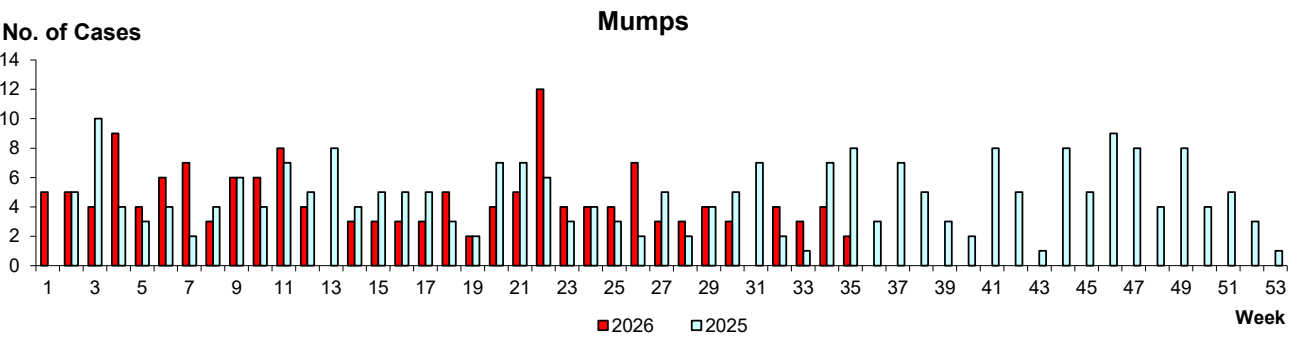
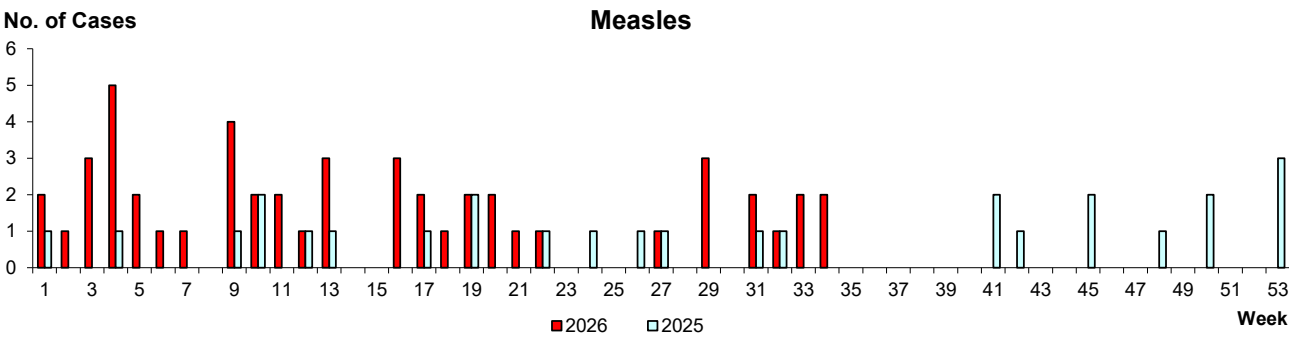
The number of dengue notifications was 87 in E-week 35.

The number of hospital admissions increased to 12 in E-week 35, compared to 10 in E-week 34.

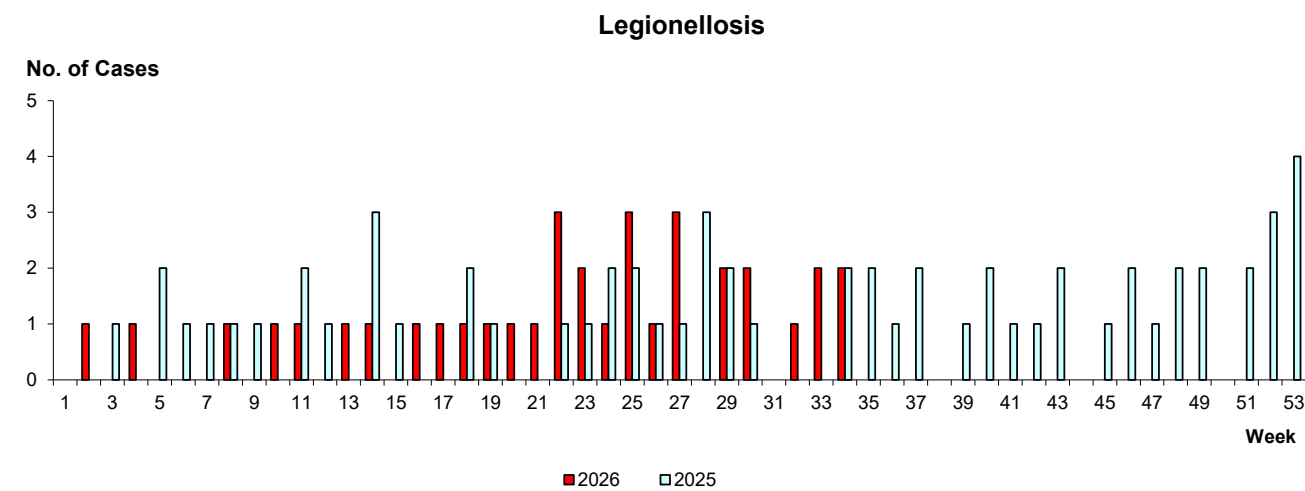
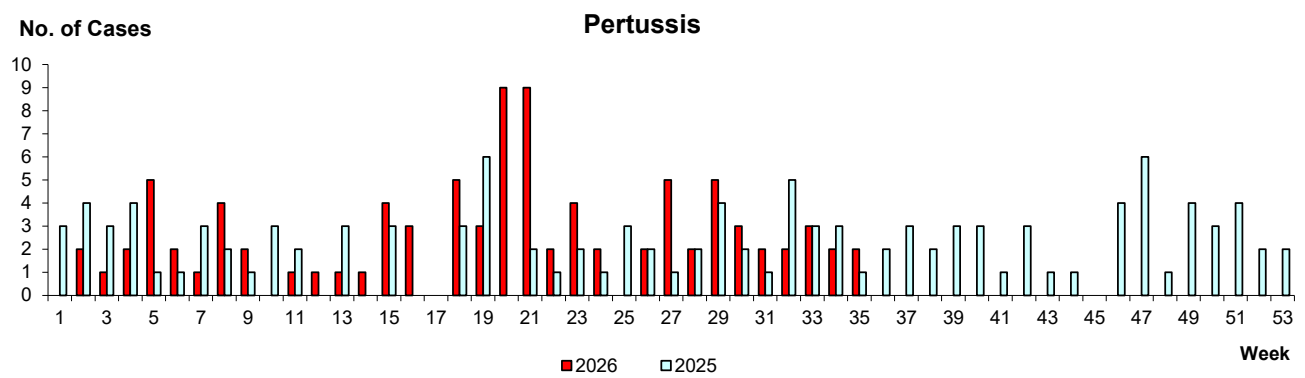
Preliminary results of all positive dengue samples serotyped in Aug 2026 showed DEN-1, DEN-2, DEN-3 and DEN-4 at 11.1%, 50.3%, 35.3% and 3.3% respectively.



WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026

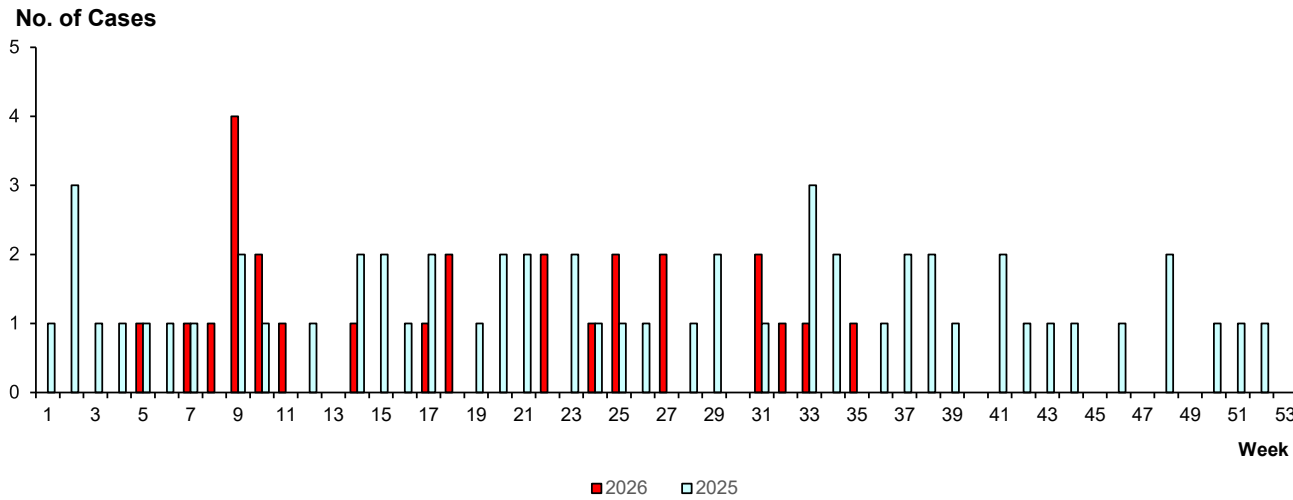


WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026

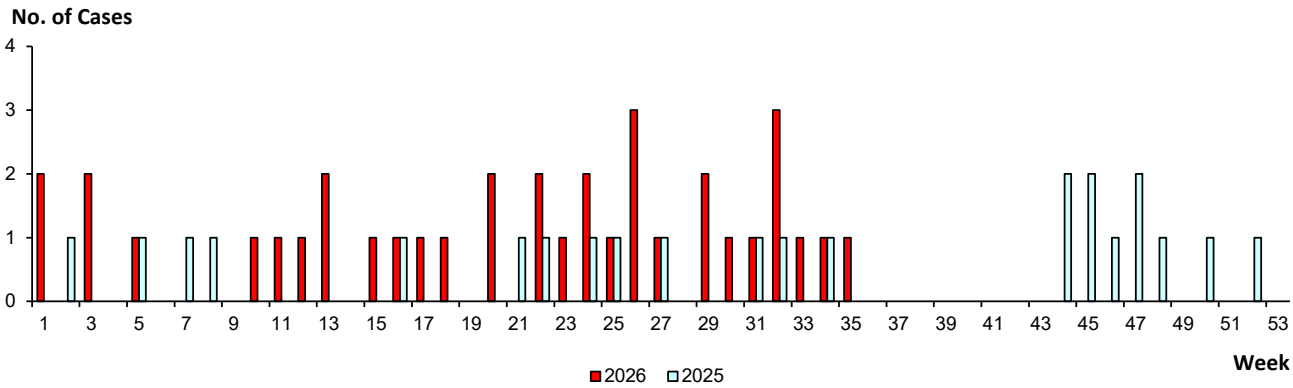

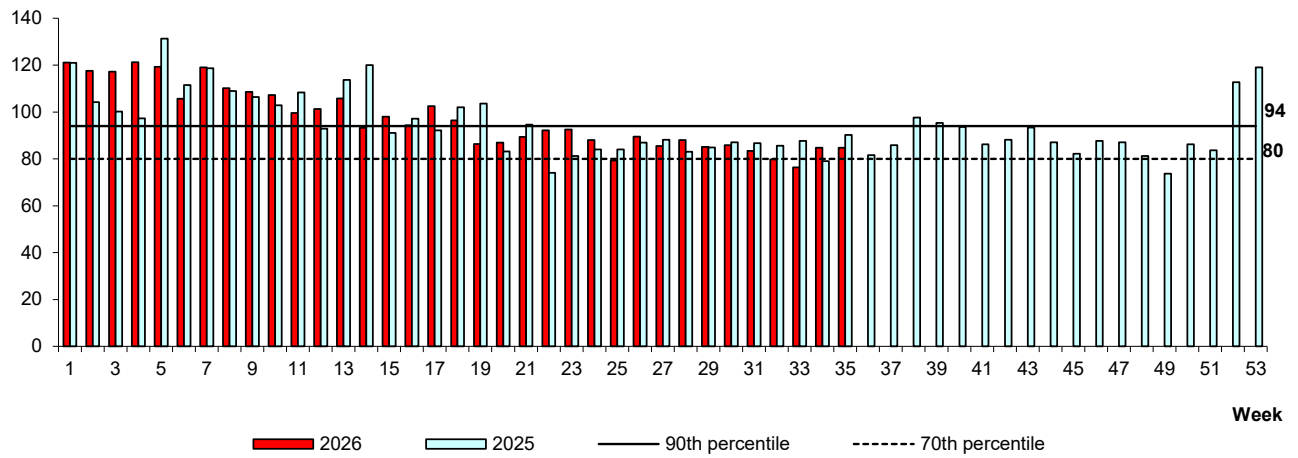

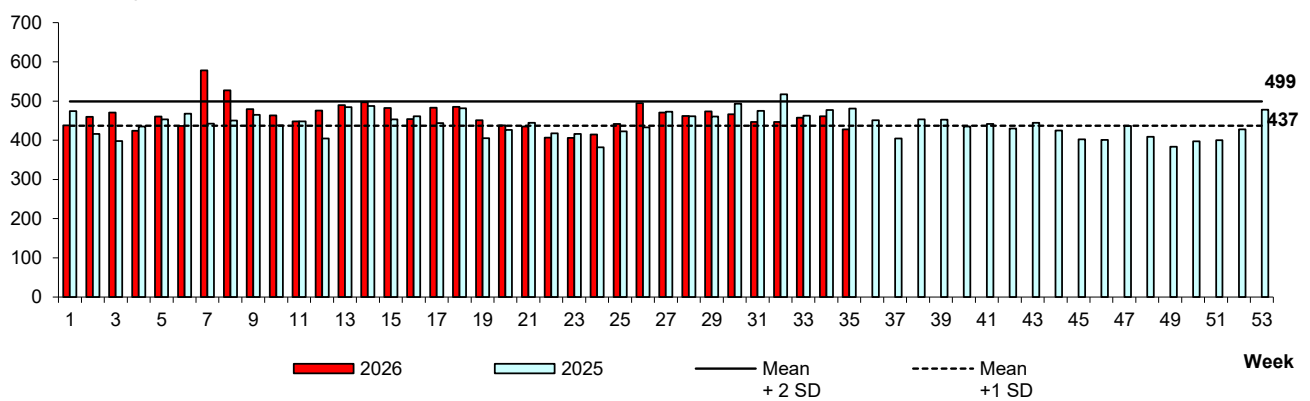
