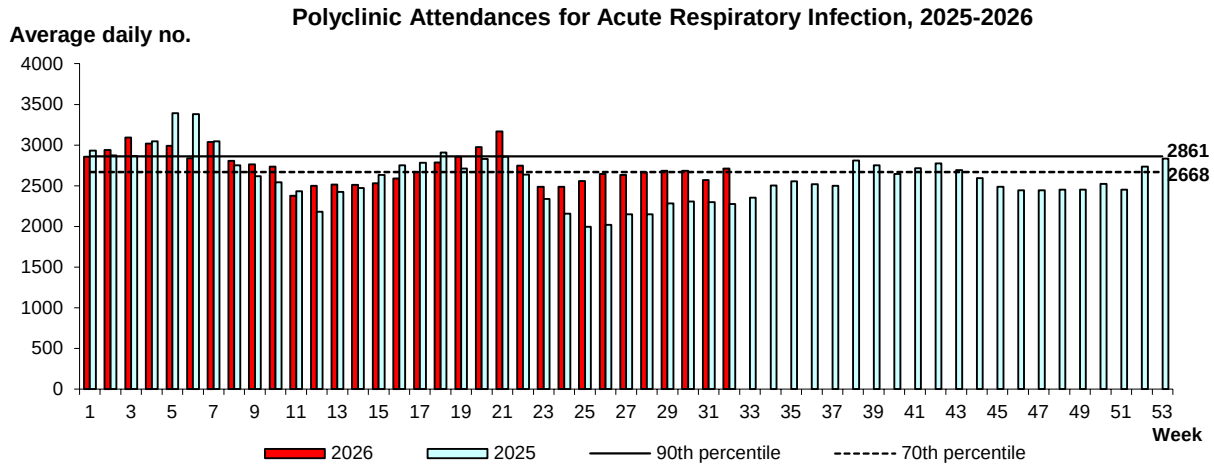

Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) Situation in Singapore 2026

ARI indicators for E-week 32 (9 - 15 Aug 2026) were as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI was 2709 (over 4.5 working days) in E-week 32.



In E-week 32, the top respiratory pathogens among adult and paediatric samples from the National Surveillance Programme for Acute Respiratory Infection^s (ARI) were:

- Adult samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (19%), influenza (14%), human metapneumovirus (5%) and parainfluenza viruses (5%).
- Paediatric samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (37%), influenza (17%), and respiratory syncytial virus (12%).

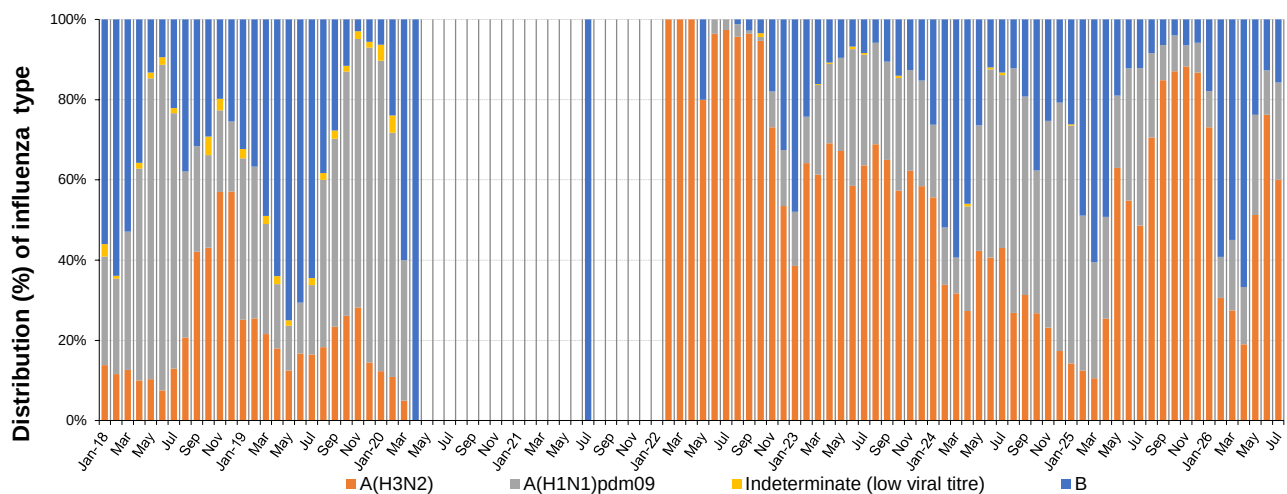
^s CDA monitors the trends of respiratory pathogens in the community through our sentinel surveillance programme for Acute Respiratory Infections (ARI) which includes polyclinics and selected general practitioner (GP) clinics.

COVID-19 and Influenza

The positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n= 121) in the community was 24% in E-week 32. The positivity rate for COVID-19 among ARI samples (n= 243) in the community was 2% in E-week 32.

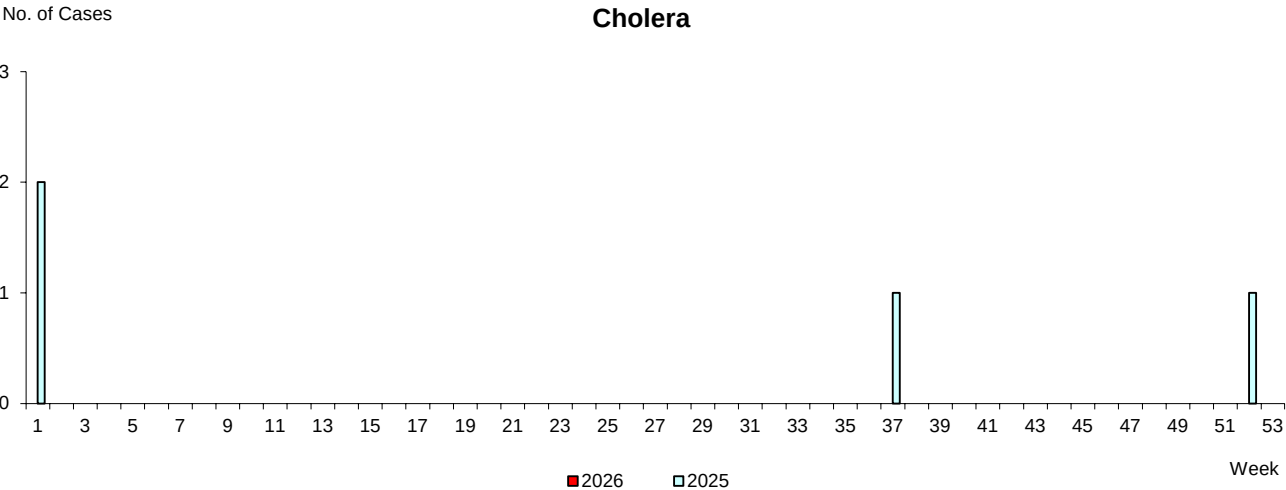
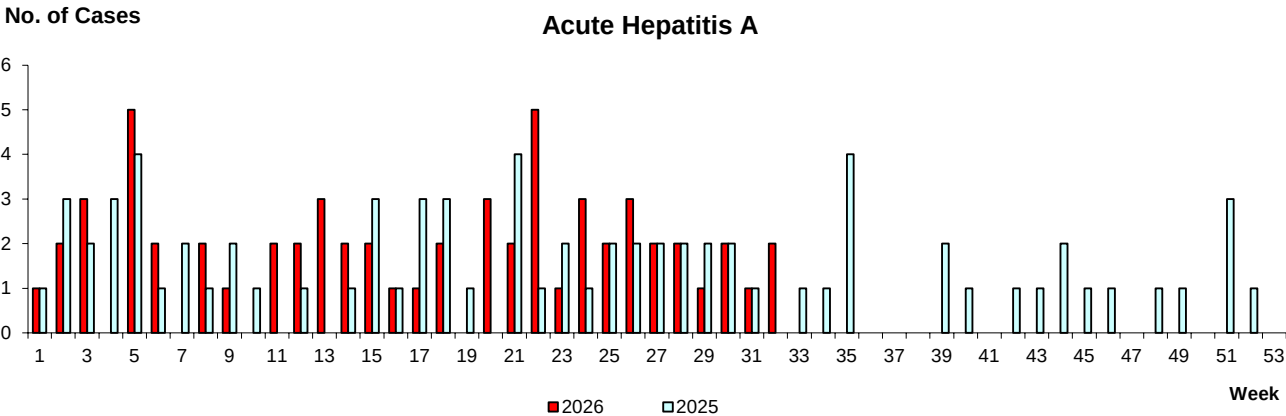
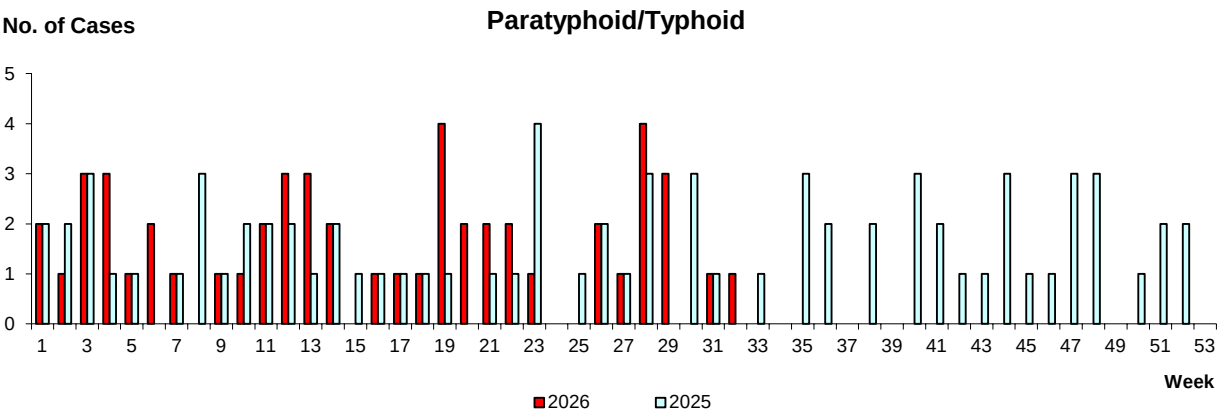
Of the 165 specimens tested positive for influenza in July 2026, 40 were positive for influenza A(pH1N1) (24.2%), 99 were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (60.0%), and 26 were positive for influenza B (15.8%).

Monthly Influenza Surveillance

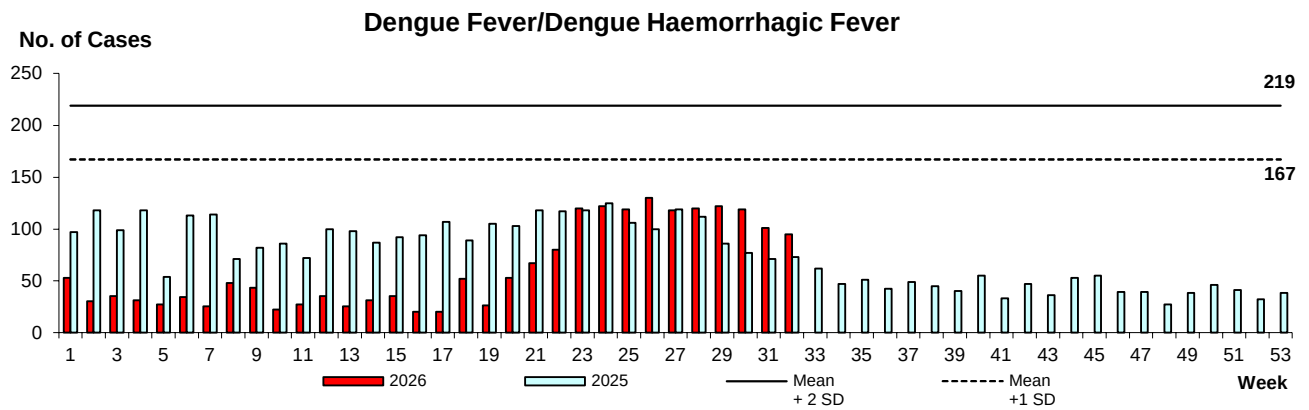

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026



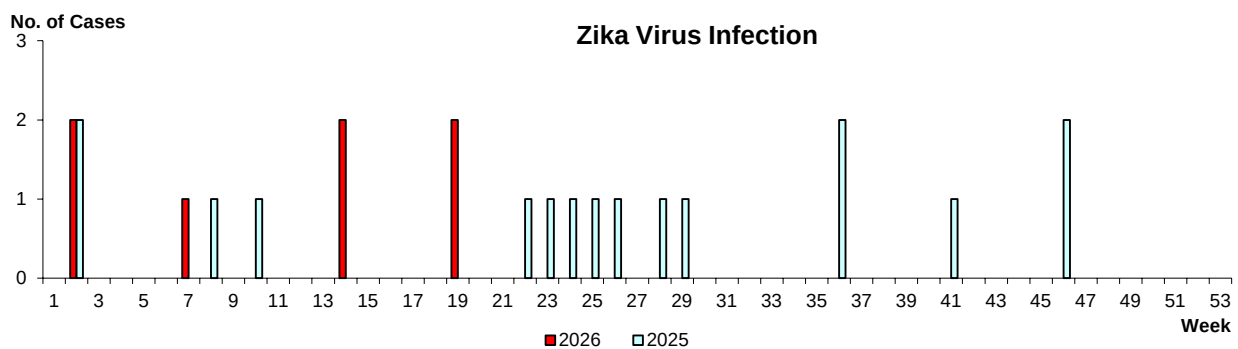
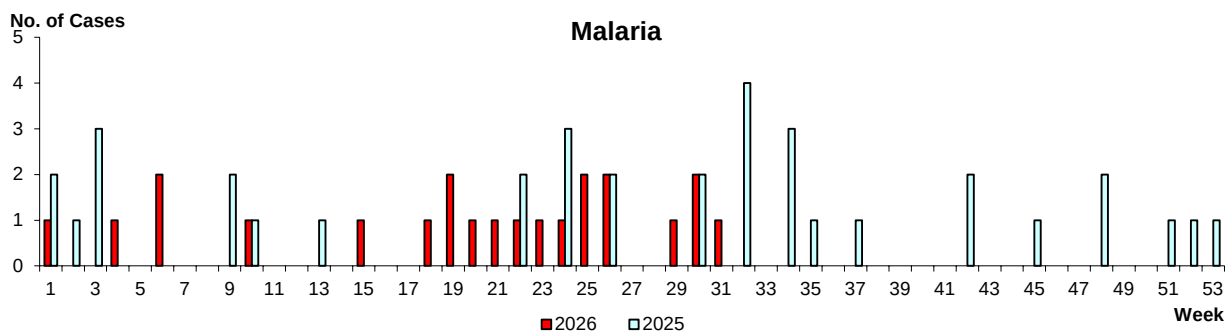
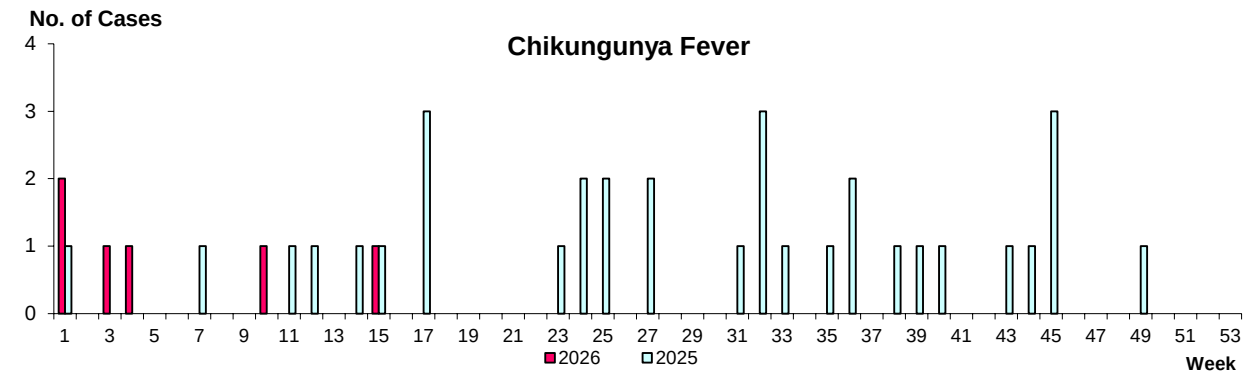
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF VECTOR-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026



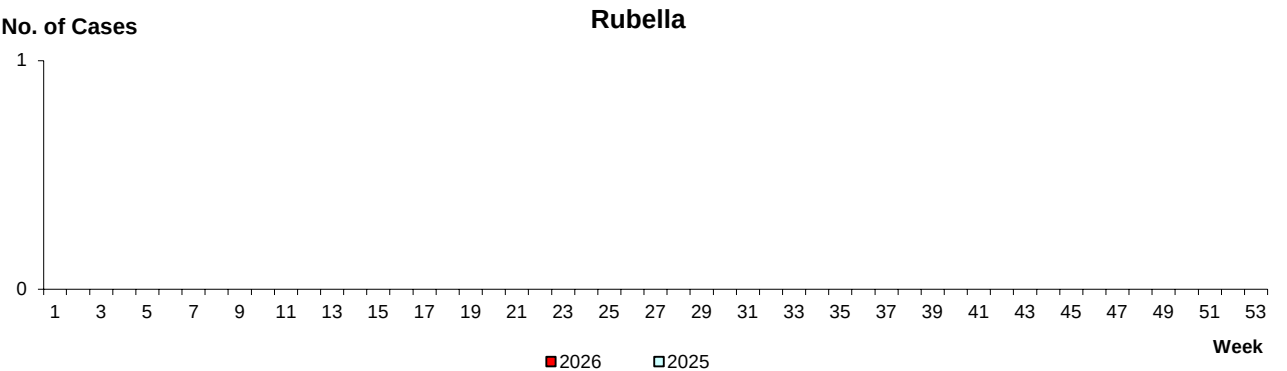
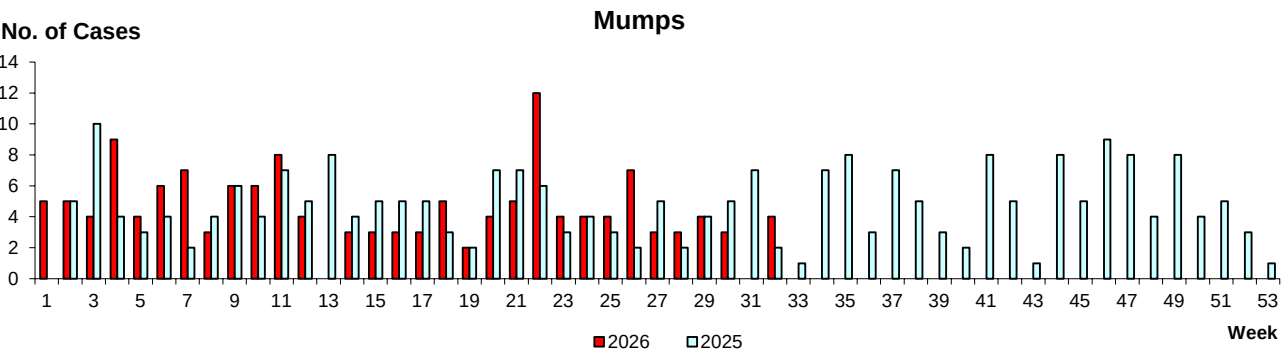
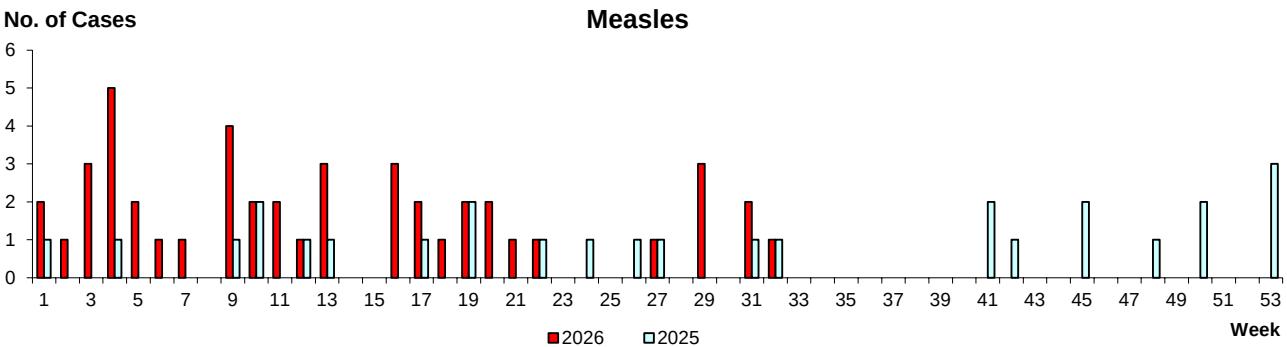
The number of dengue notifications was 95 in E-week 32.

The number of hospital admissions decreased to 21 in E-week 32, compared to 23 in E-week 31.

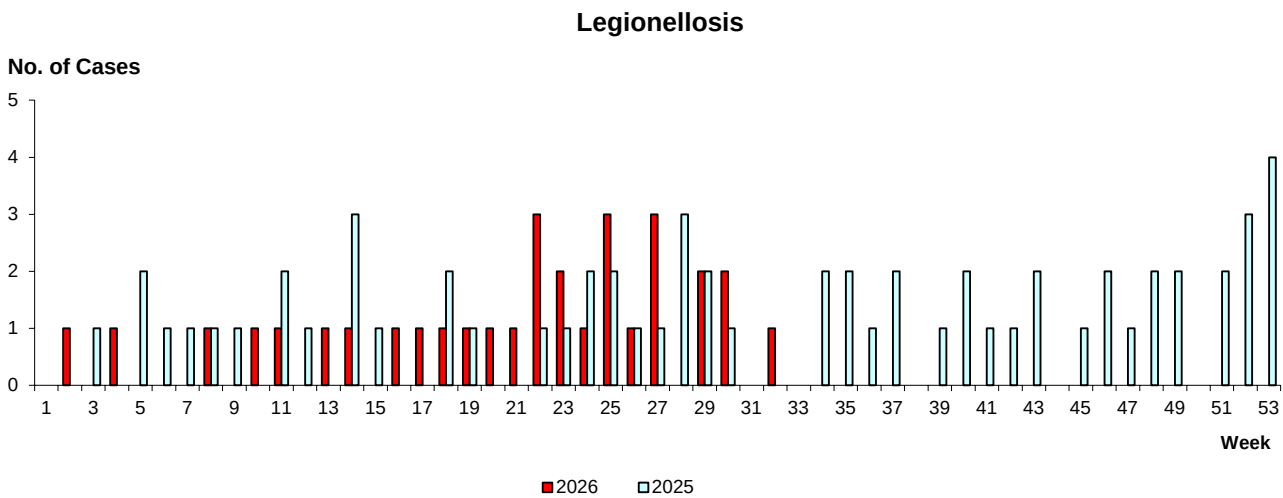
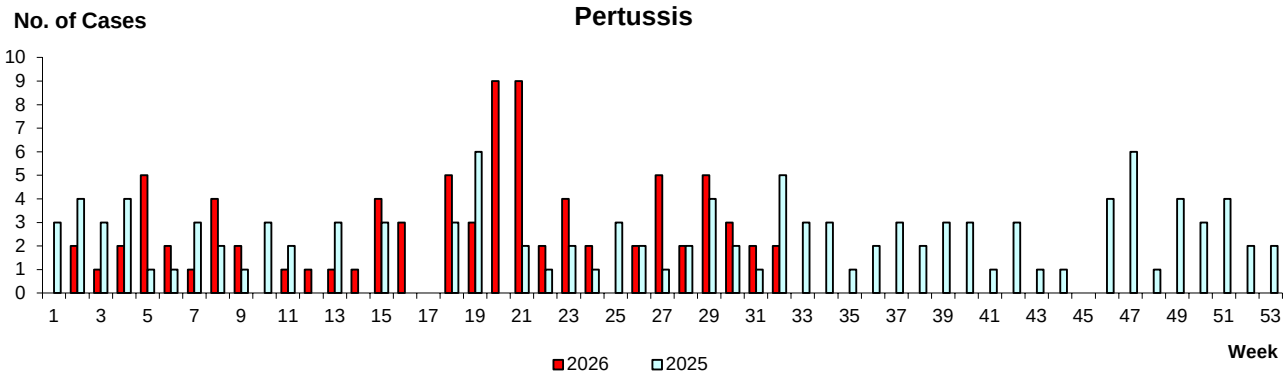
Preliminary results of all positive dengue samples serotyped in Aug 2026 showed DEN-1, DEN-2, DEN-3 and DEN-4 at 6.3%, 64.6%, 27.1% and 2.1% respectively.



WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026

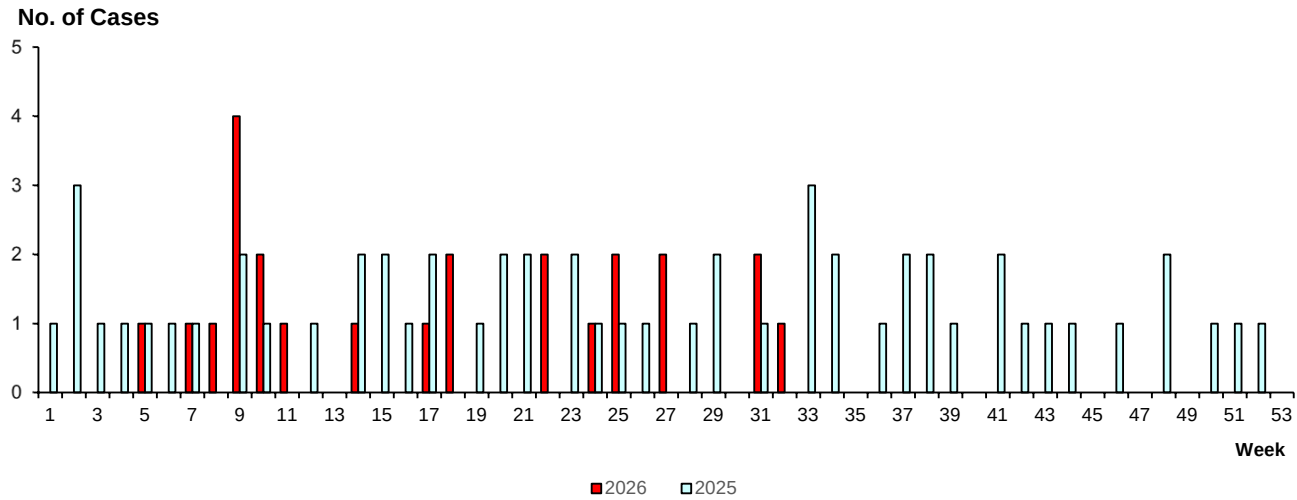


WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026

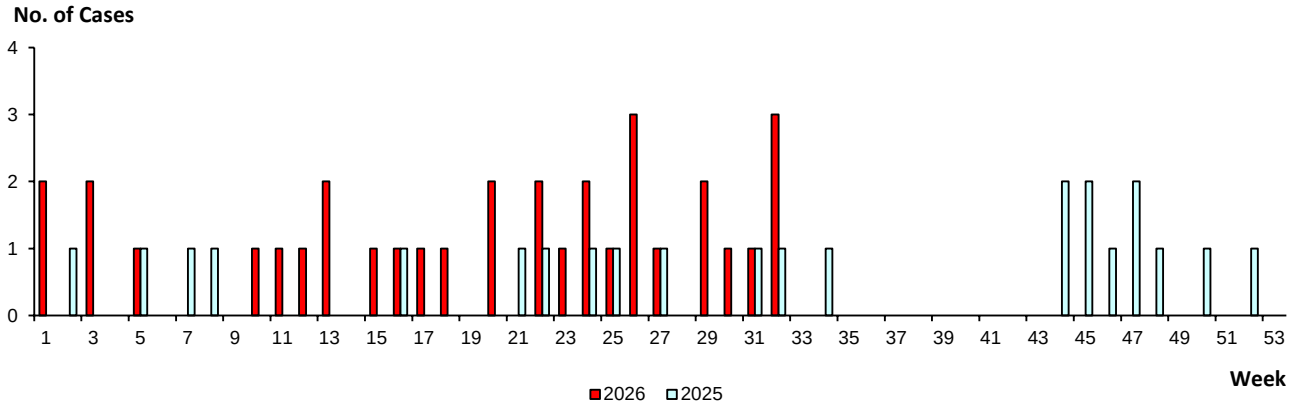

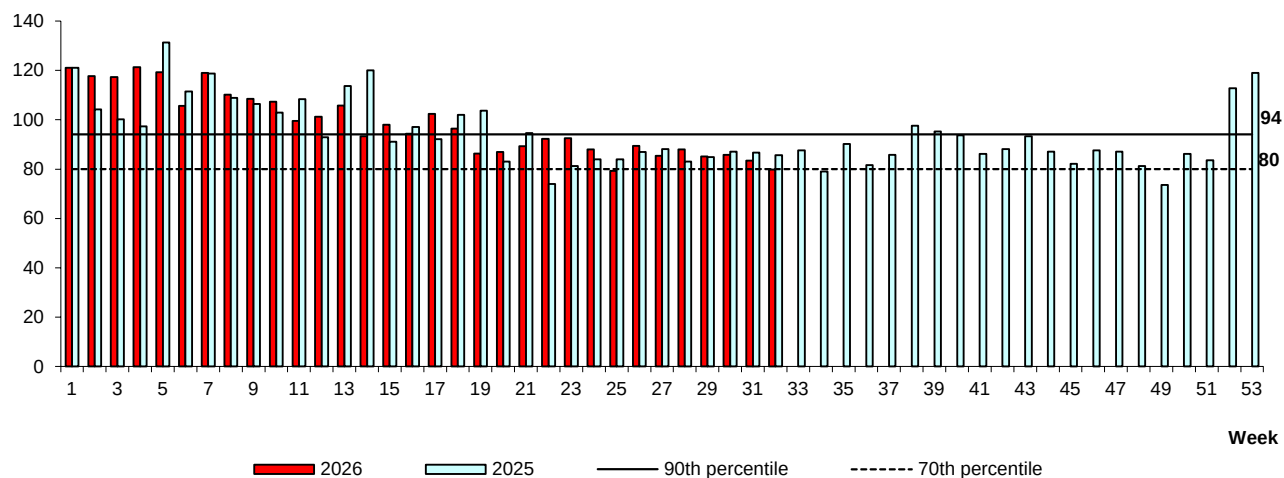

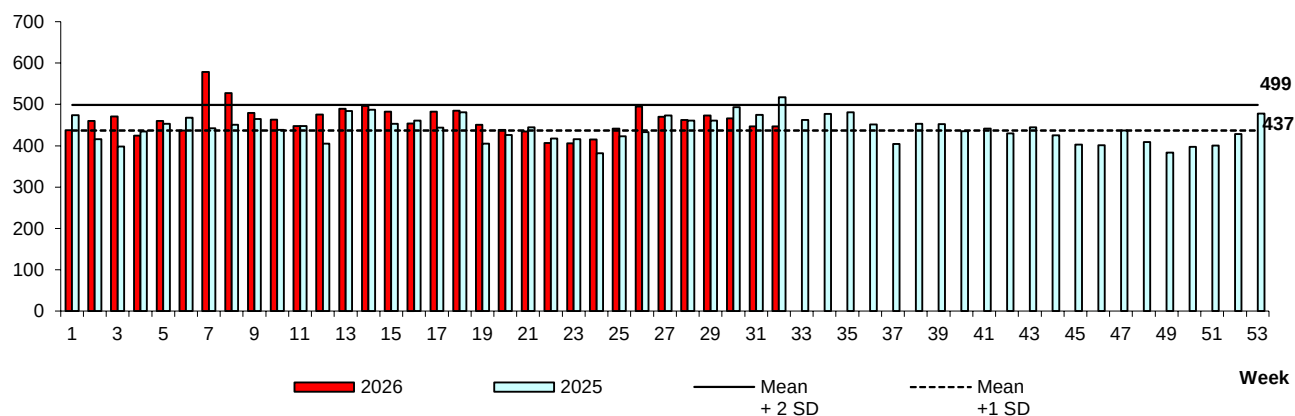
Conjunctivitis
