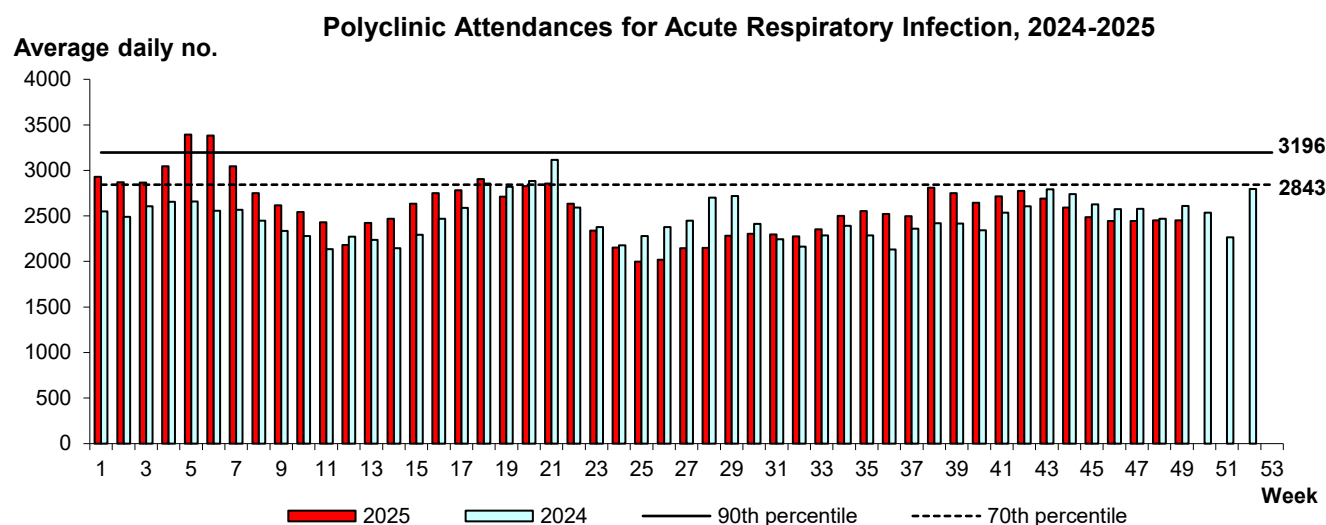

Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) Situation in Singapore 2025

ARI indicators for E-week 49 (30 Nov 2025 - 6 Dec 2025) were as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI was 2452 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 49.



In E-week 49, the top respiratory pathogens among adult and paediatric samples from the National Surveillance Programme for Acute Respiratory Infection[§] (ARI) were:

- Adult samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (22%), influenza (12%), and non-SARS seasonal coronaviruses (9%).
- Paediatric samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (42%), influenza (10%), and non-SARS seasonal coronaviruses (10%).

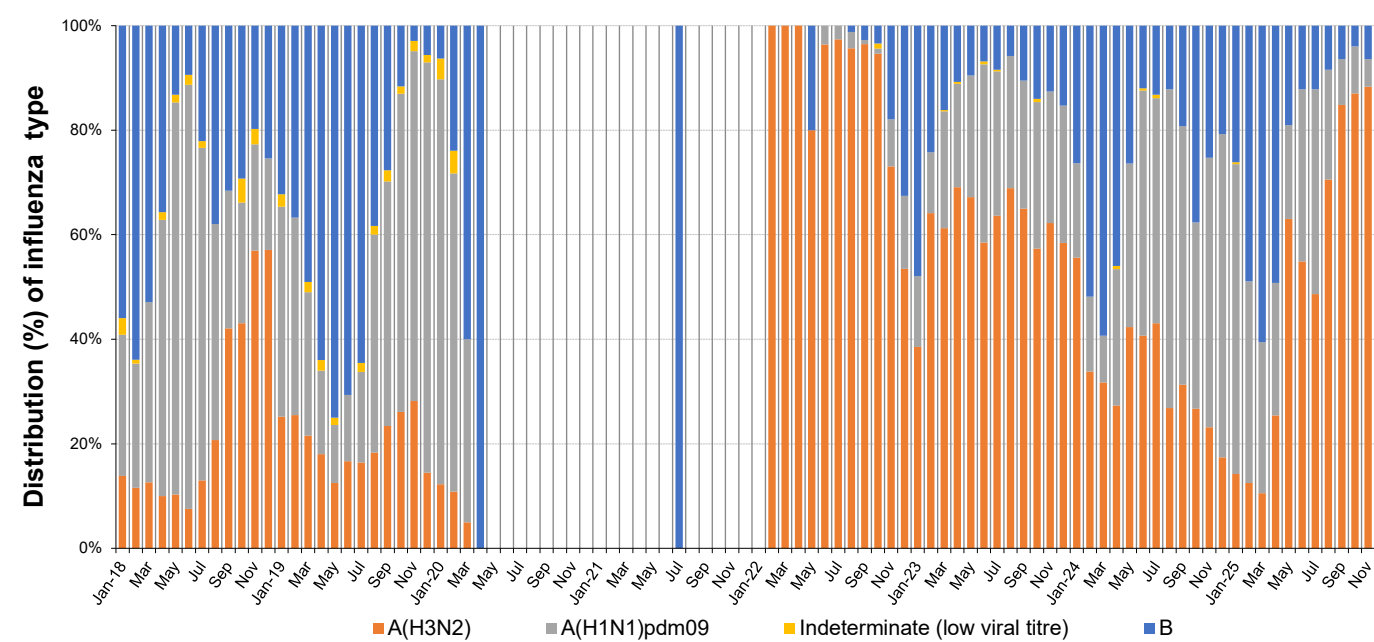
[§] CDA monitors the trends of respiratory pathogens in the community through our sentinel surveillance programme for Acute Respiratory Infections (ARI) which includes polyclinics and selected general practitioner (GP) clinics.

COVID-19 and Influenza

The proportion of patients with influenza-like illness (ILI) among the polyclinic attendances for ARI was 0.4%.
The positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n= 146) in the community was 20% in E-week 49. The positivity rate for COVID-19 among ARI samples (n= 293) in the community was 1% in E-week 49.

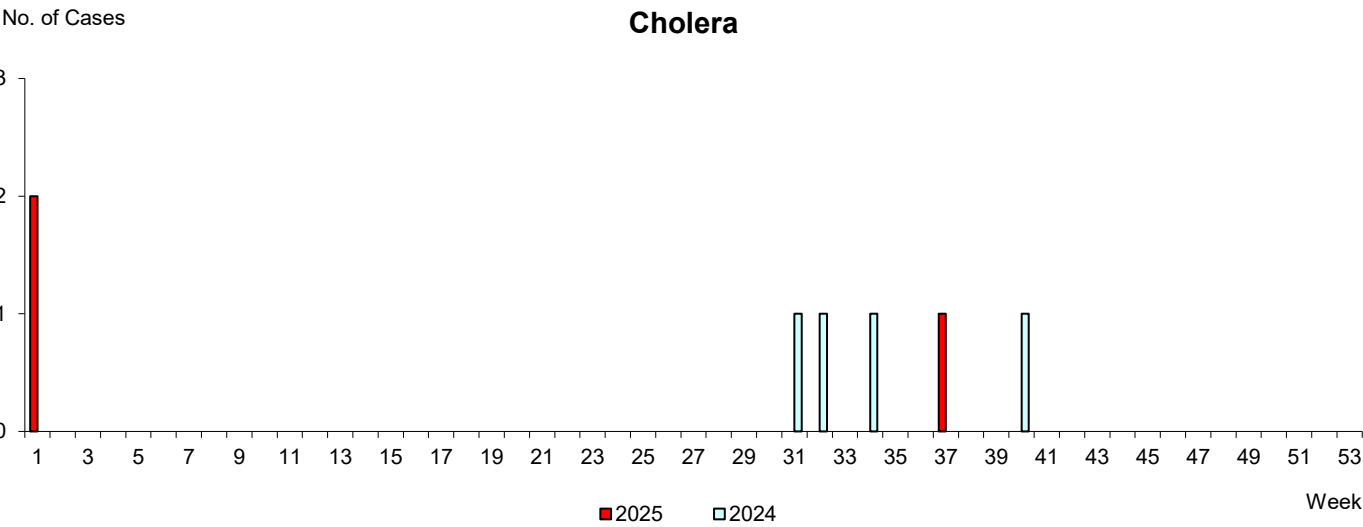
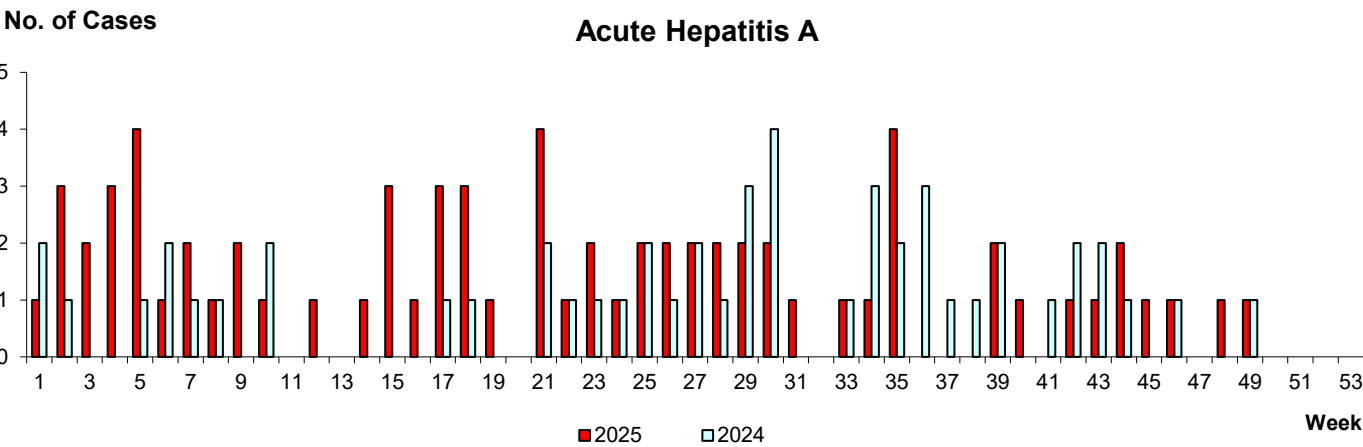
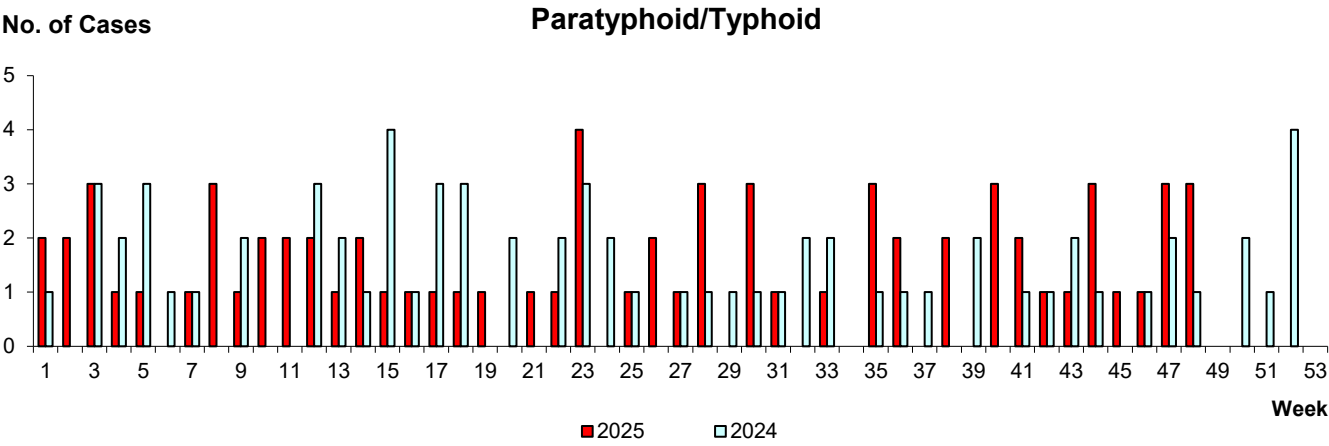
Of the 171 specimens tested positive for influenza in November 2025, 9 were positive for influenza A(pH1N1) (5%), 151 were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (88%), and 11 were positive for influenza B (7%).

Monthly Influenza Surveillance

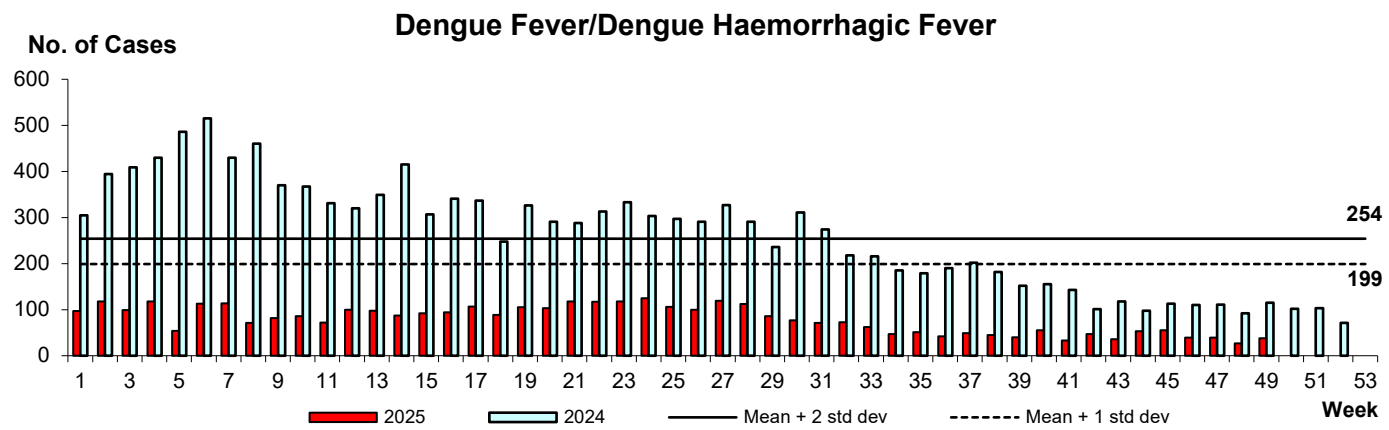

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



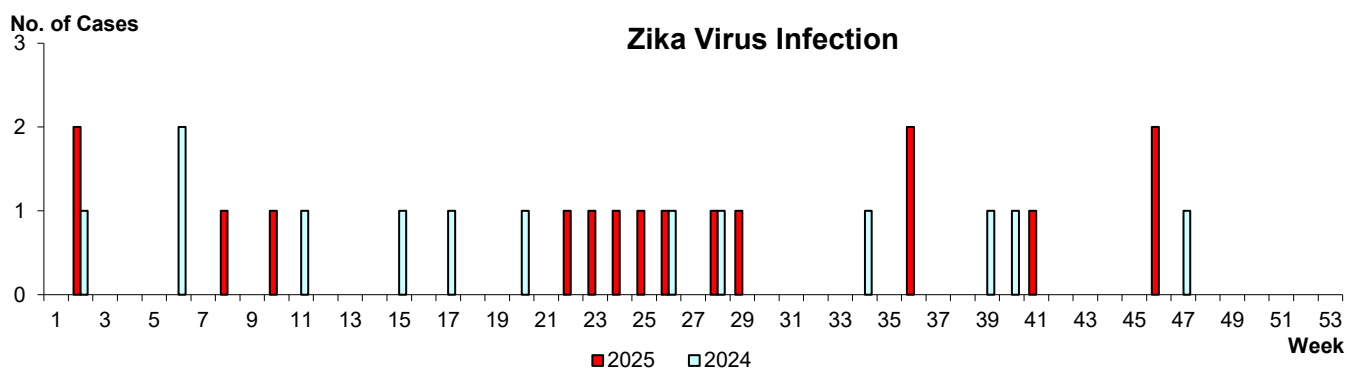
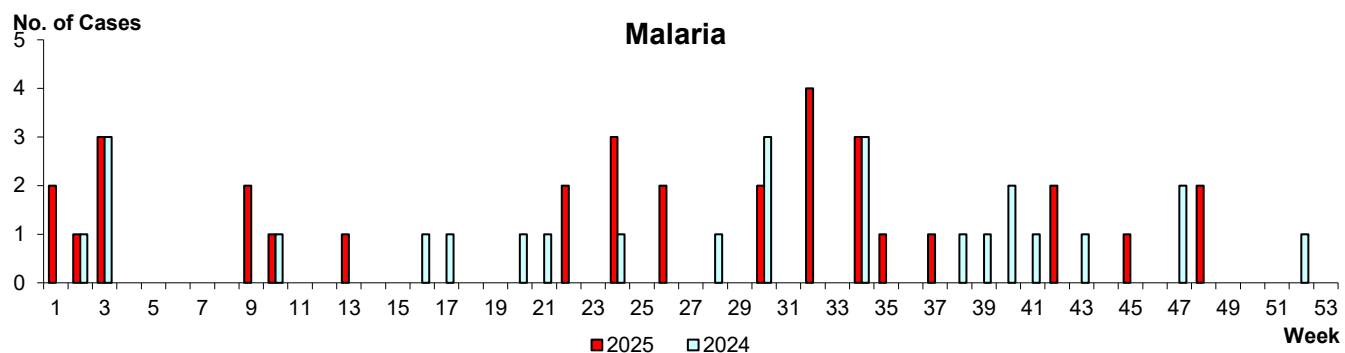
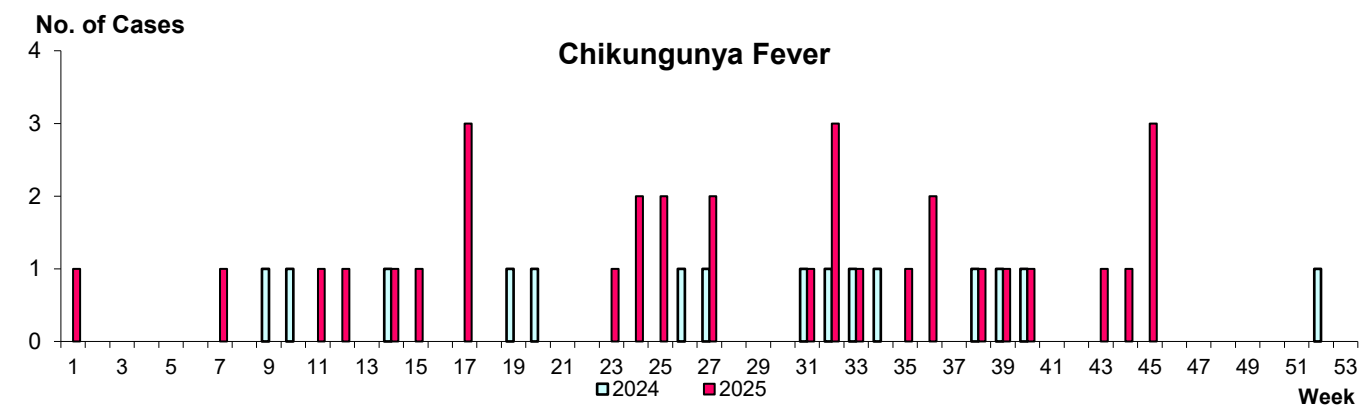
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF VECTOR-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



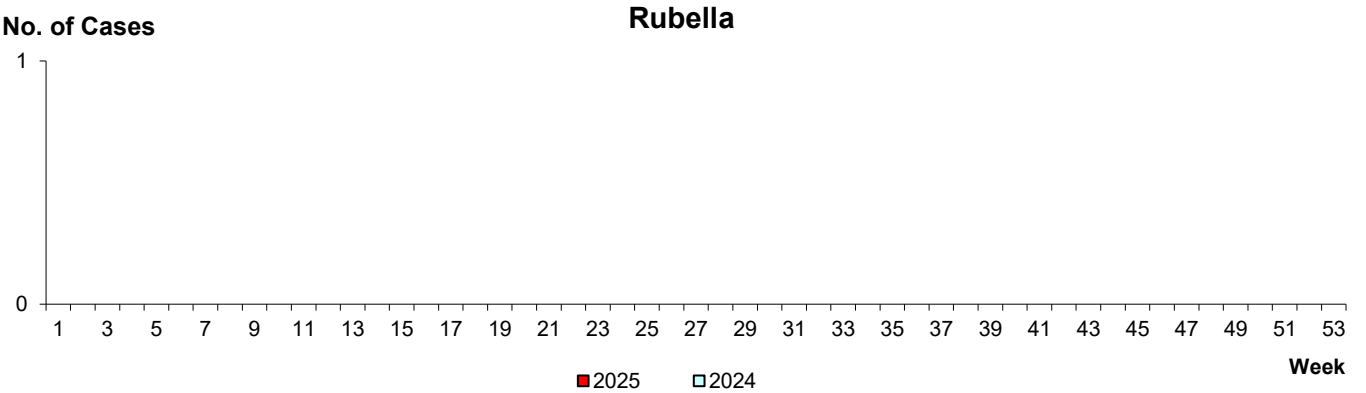
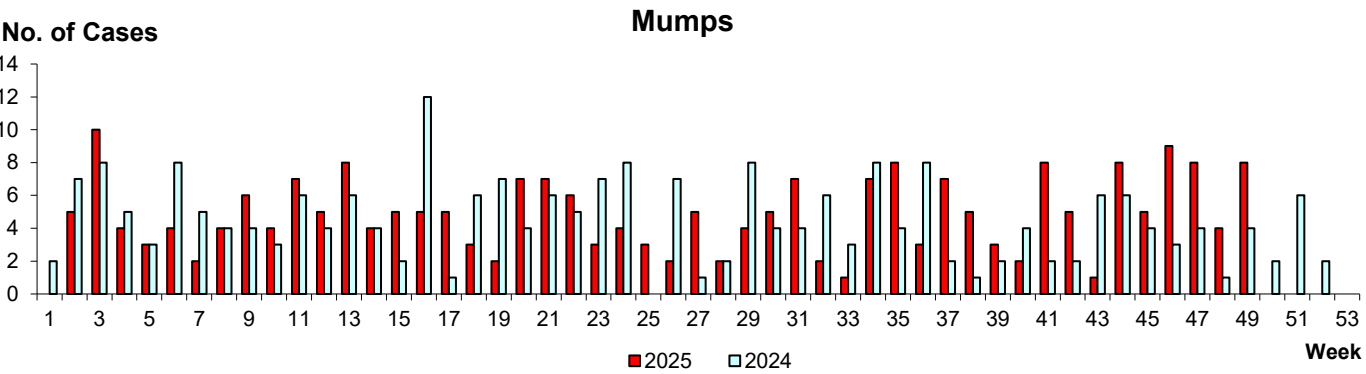
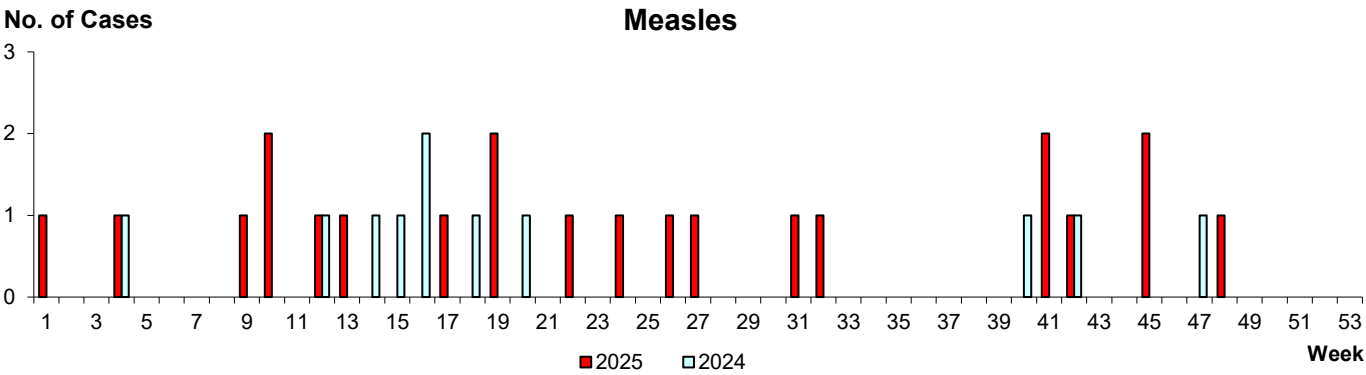
The number of dengue notifications was 38 in E-week 49.

The number of hospital admissions increased to 8 in E-week 49, compared to 3 in E-week 48.

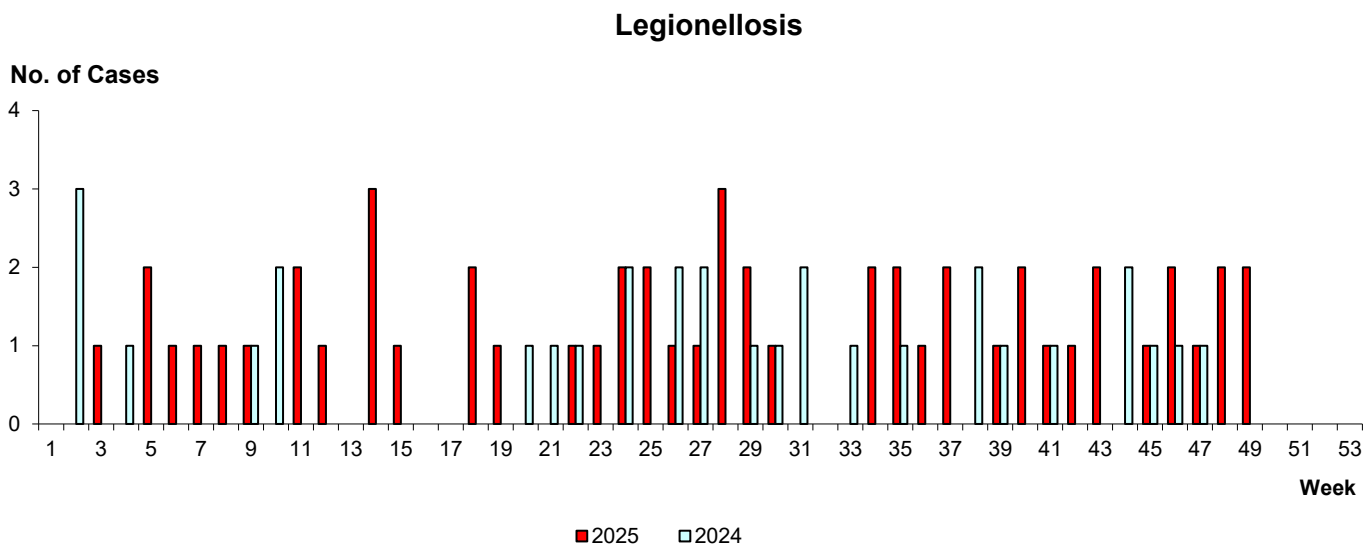
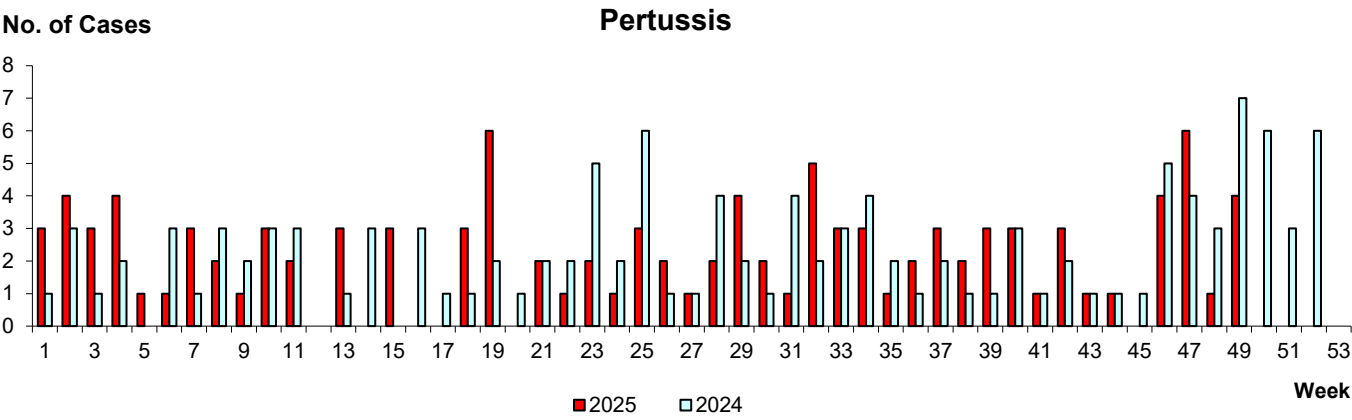
Preliminary results of all positive dengue samples serotyped in November 2025 showed DEN-1, DEN-2, DEN-3 and DEN-4 at 16.2%, 43.2%, 29.7% and 10.8% respectively.



WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



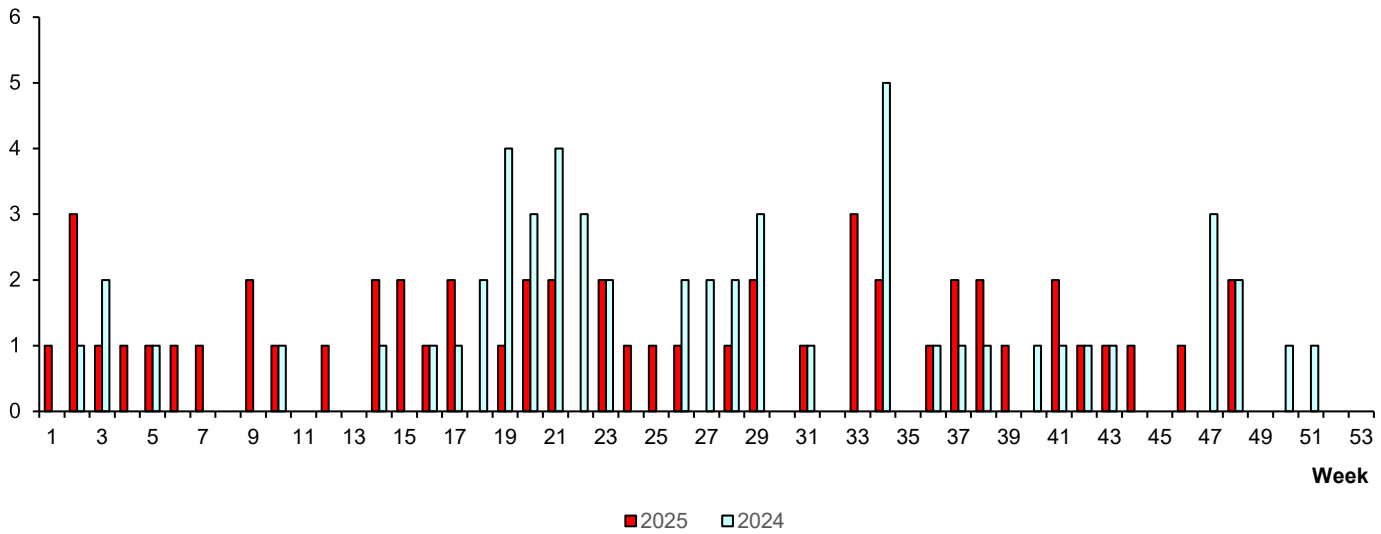
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025

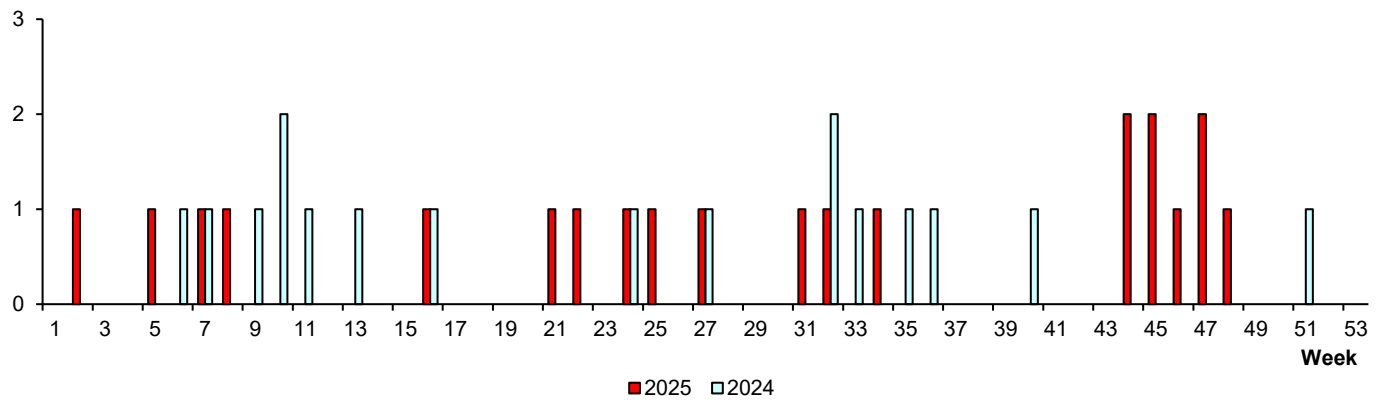
