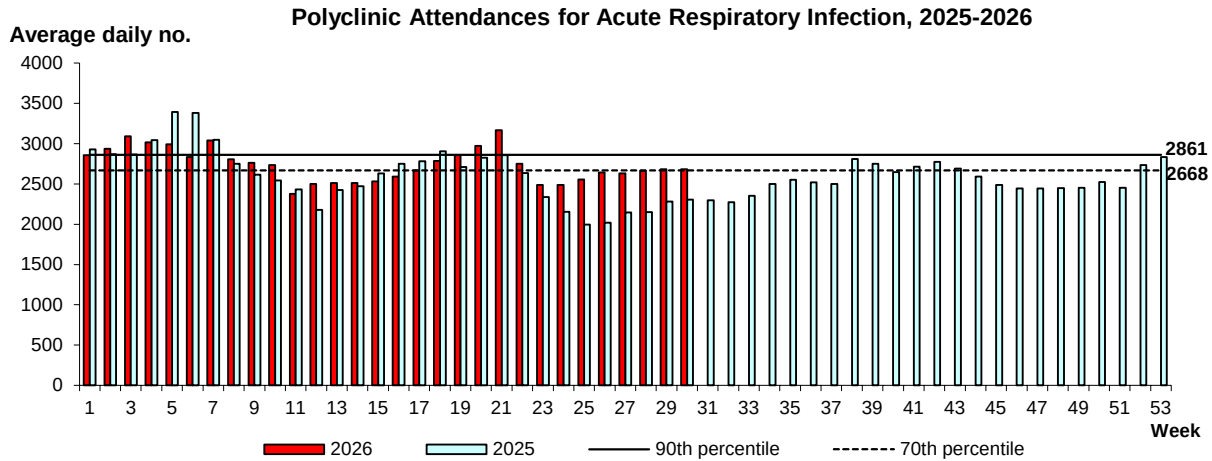

Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) Situation in Singapore 2026

ARI indicators for E-week 30 (26 Jul 2026 - 1 Aug 2026) were as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI was 2682 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 30.



In E-week 30, the top respiratory pathogens among adult and paediatric samples from the National Surveillance Programme for Acute Respiratory Infection[§] (ARI) were:

- Adult samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (22%), influenza (16%), and SARS-CoV-2 (8%).
- Paediatric samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (43%), influenza (12%), and respiratory syncytial virus (12%).

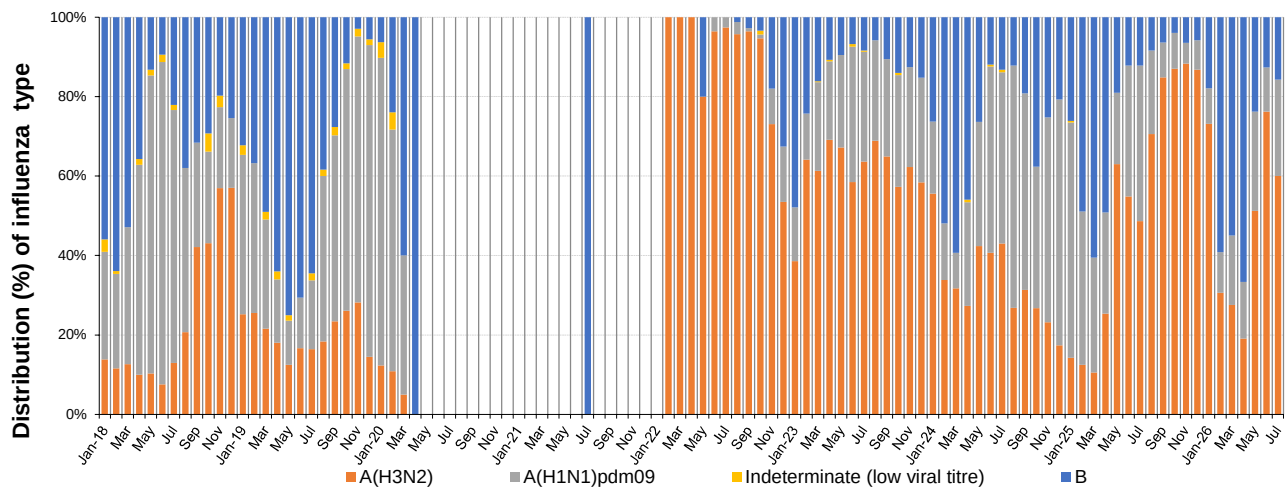
[§] CDA monitors the trends of respiratory pathogens in the community through our sentinel surveillance programme for Acute Respiratory Infections (ARI) which includes polyclinics and selected general practitioner (GP) clinics.

COVID-19 and Influenza

The positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n= 162) in the community was 20% in E-week 30. The positivity rate for COVID-19 among ARI samples (n= 320) in the community was 6% in E-week 30.

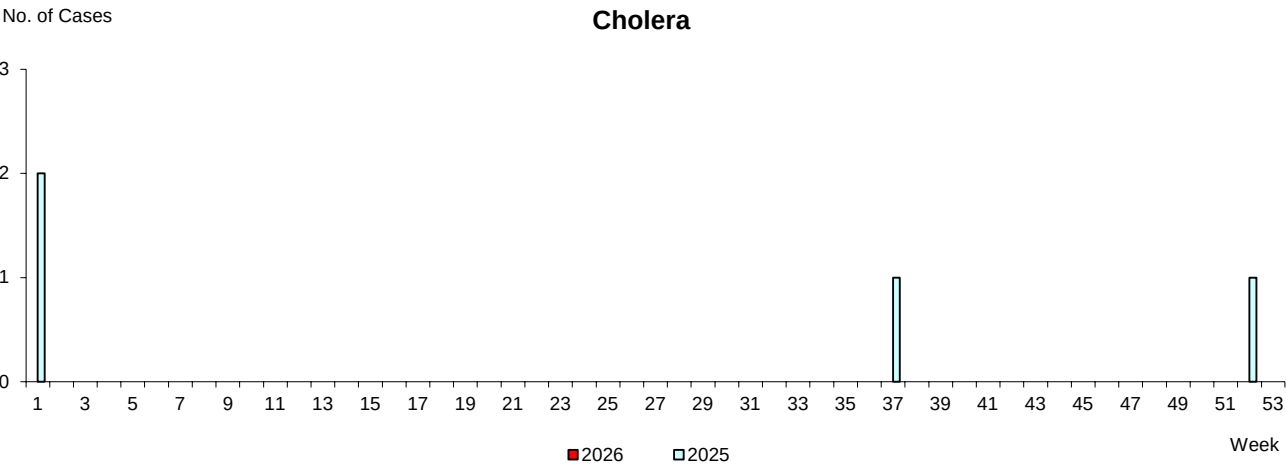
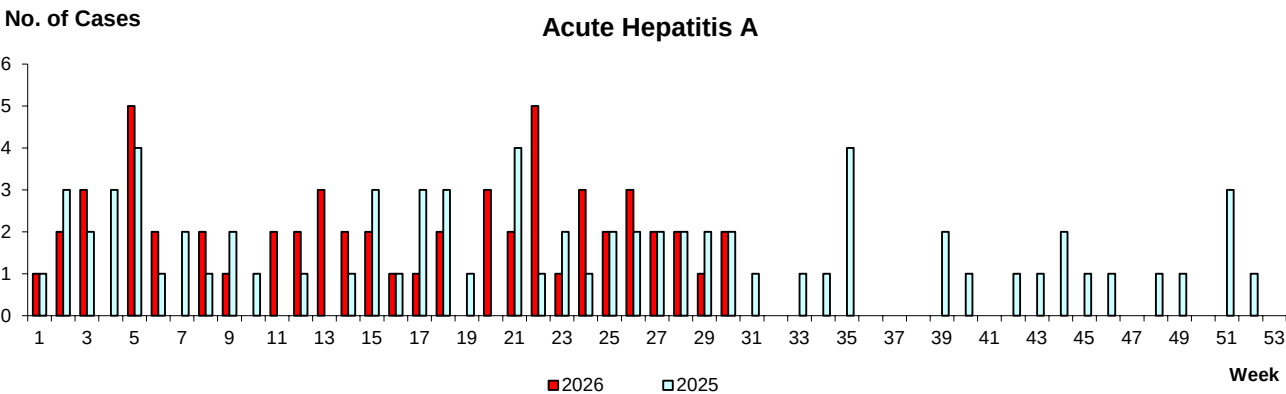
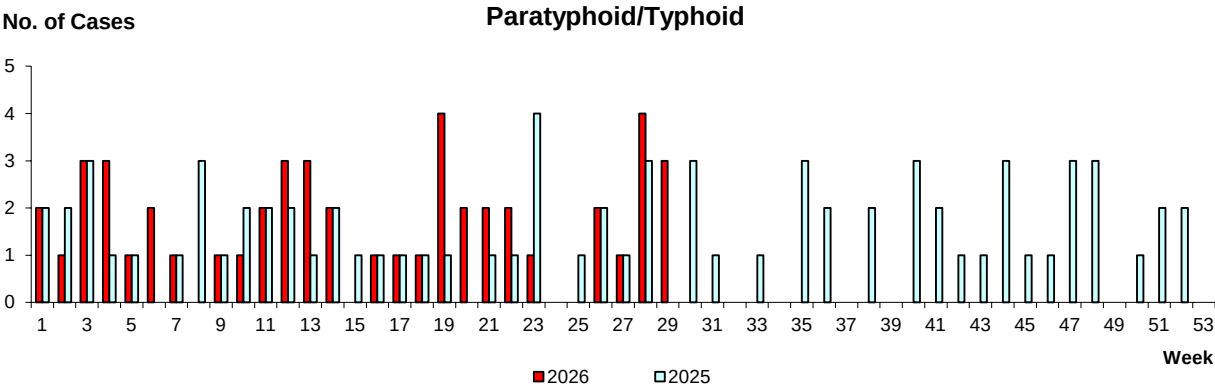
Of the 165 specimens tested positive for influenza in July 2026, 40 were positive for influenza A(pH1N1) (24.2%), 99 were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (60.0%), and 26 were positive for influenza B (15.8%).

Monthly Influenza Surveillance

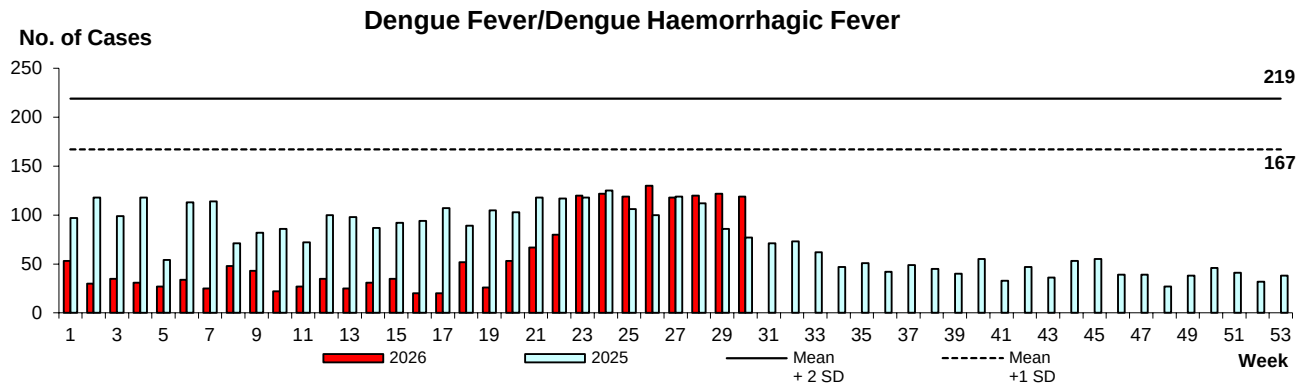

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026



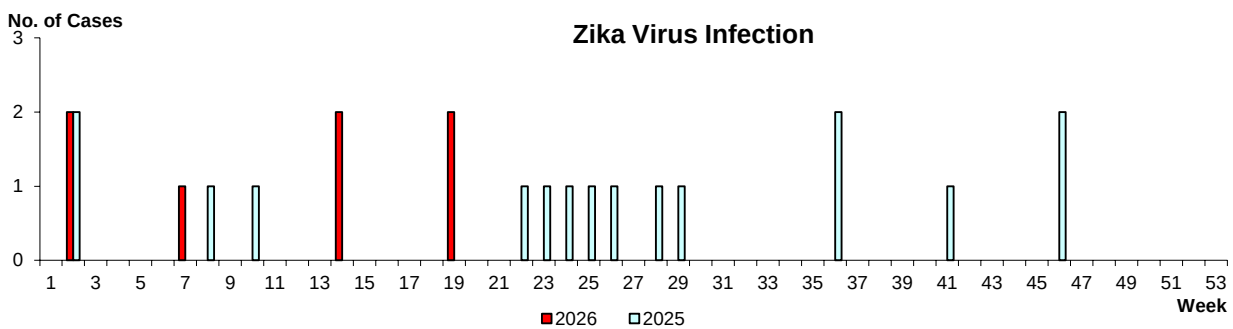
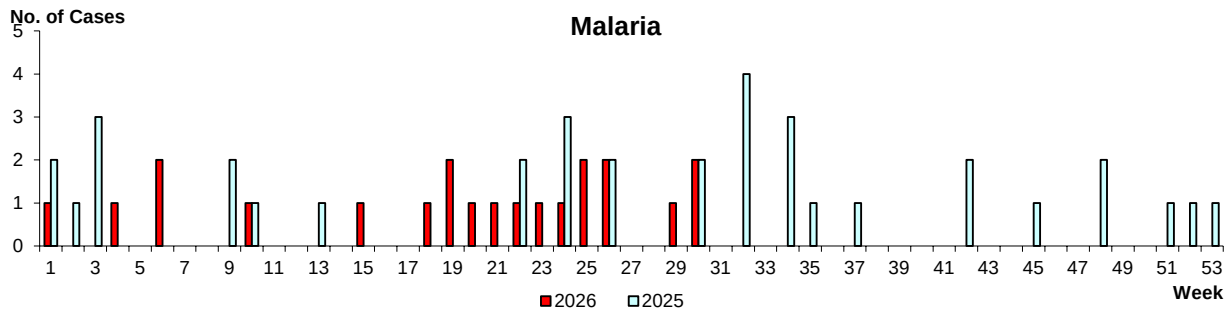
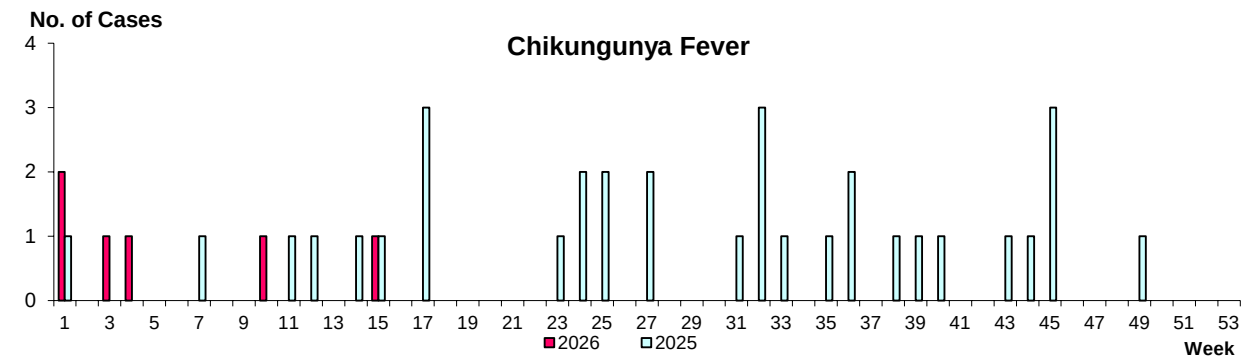
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF VECTOR-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026



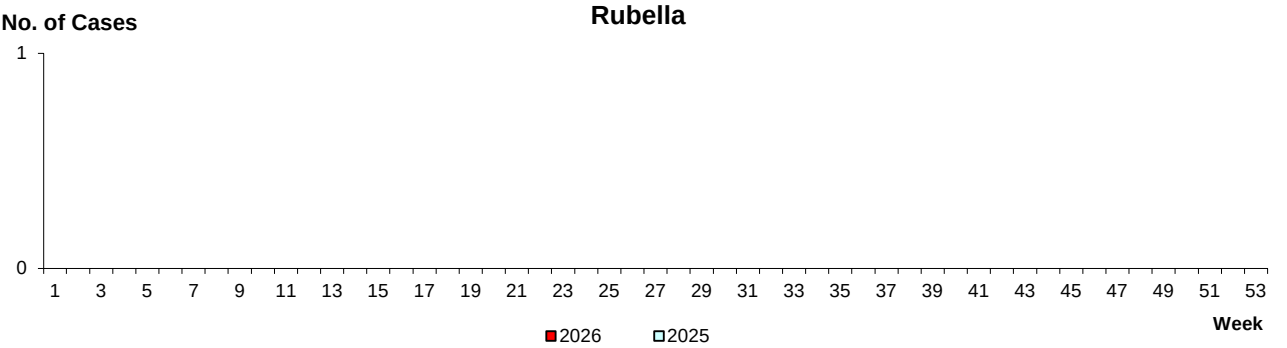
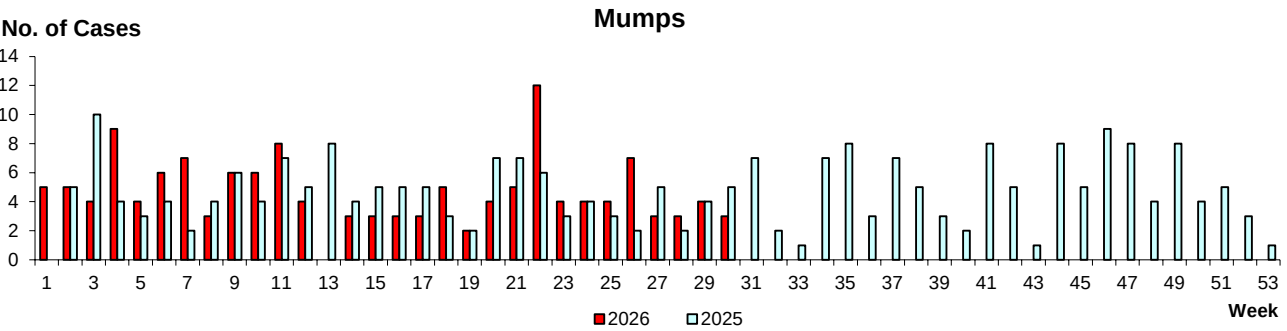
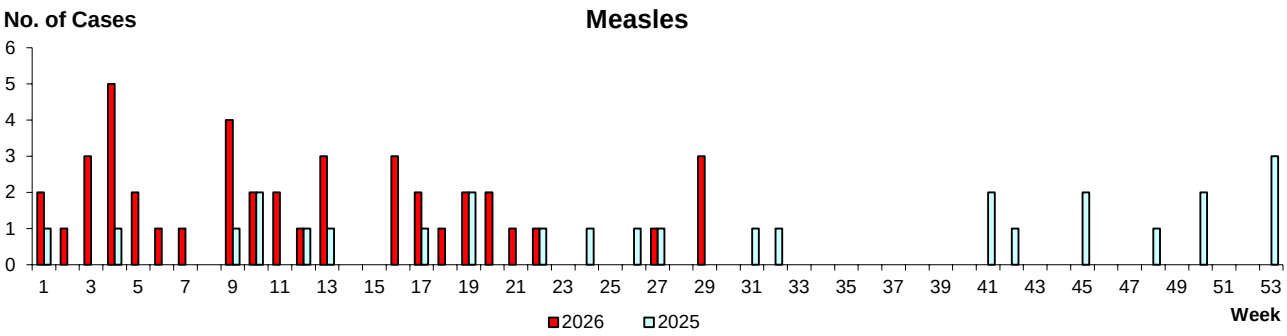
The number of dengue notifications was 119 in E-week 30.

The number of hospital admissions decreased to 15 in E-week 30, compared to 21 in E-week 29.

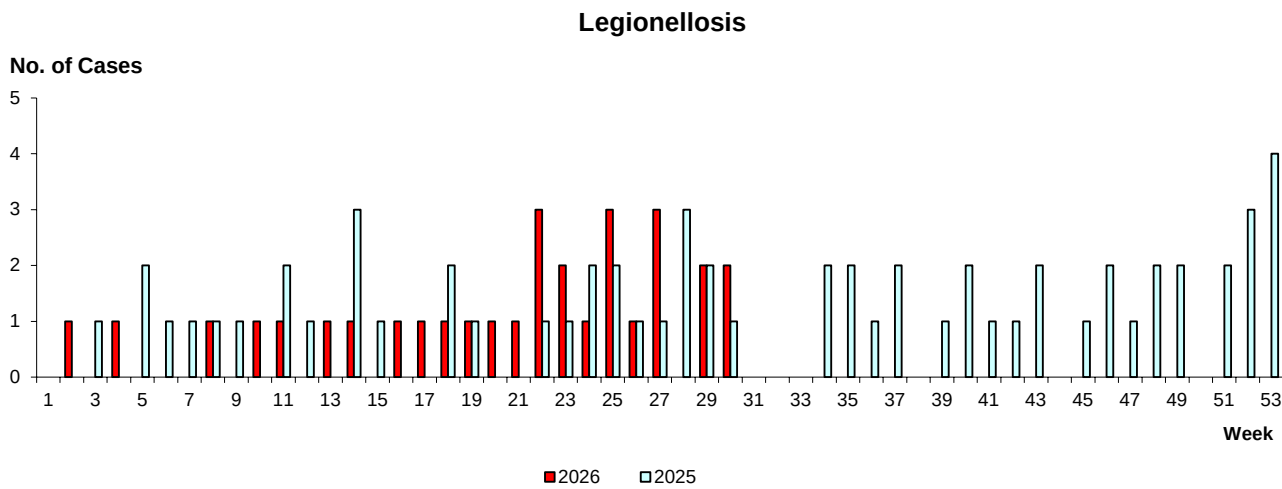
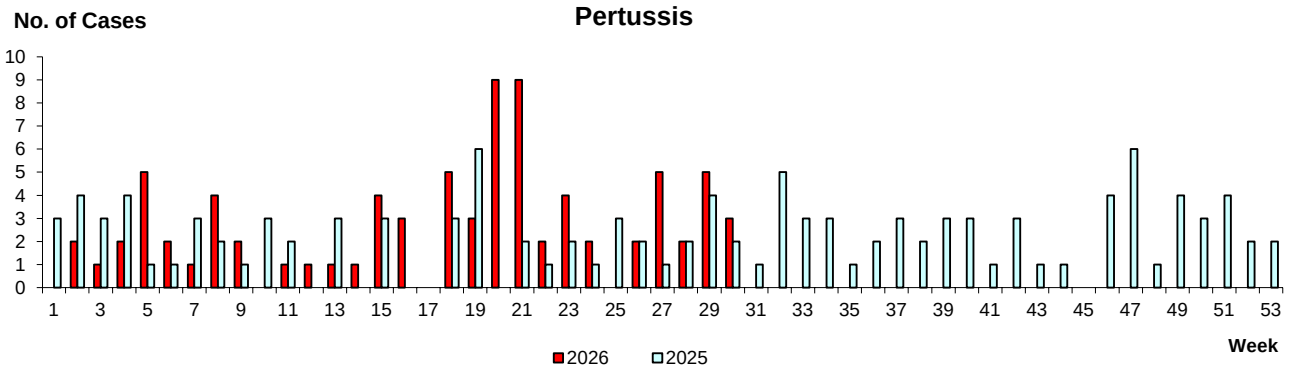
Preliminary results of all positive dengue samples serotyped in July 2026 showed DEN-1, DEN-2, DEN-3 and DEN-4 at 5.3%, 42.1%, 52.6% and 0.0% respectively.



WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026

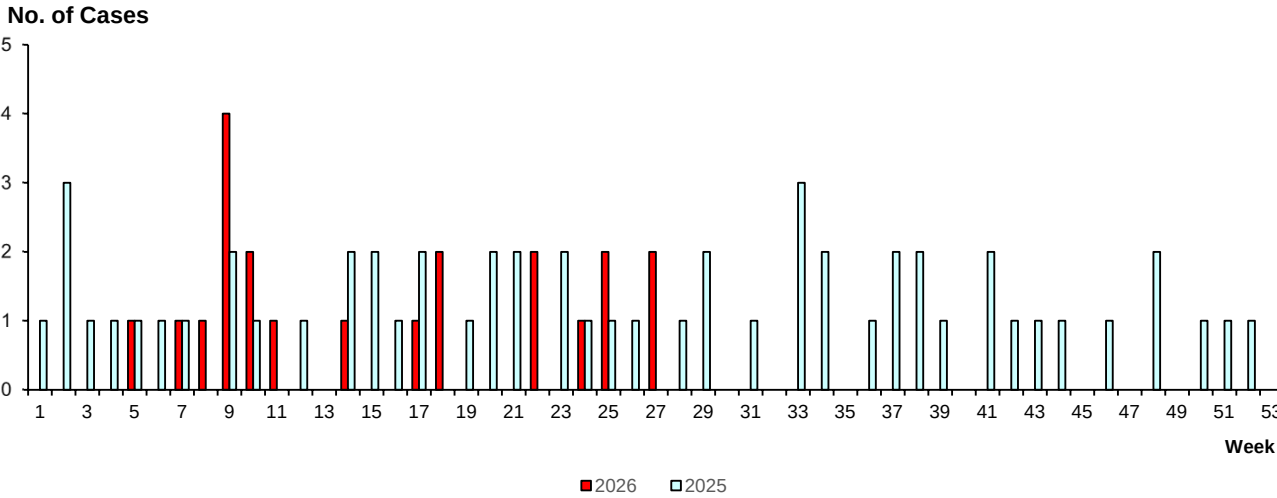


WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026

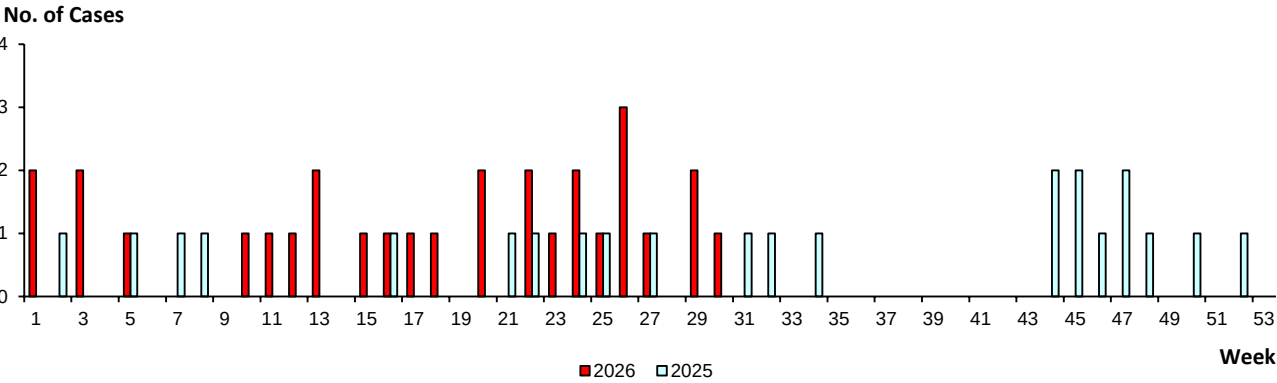

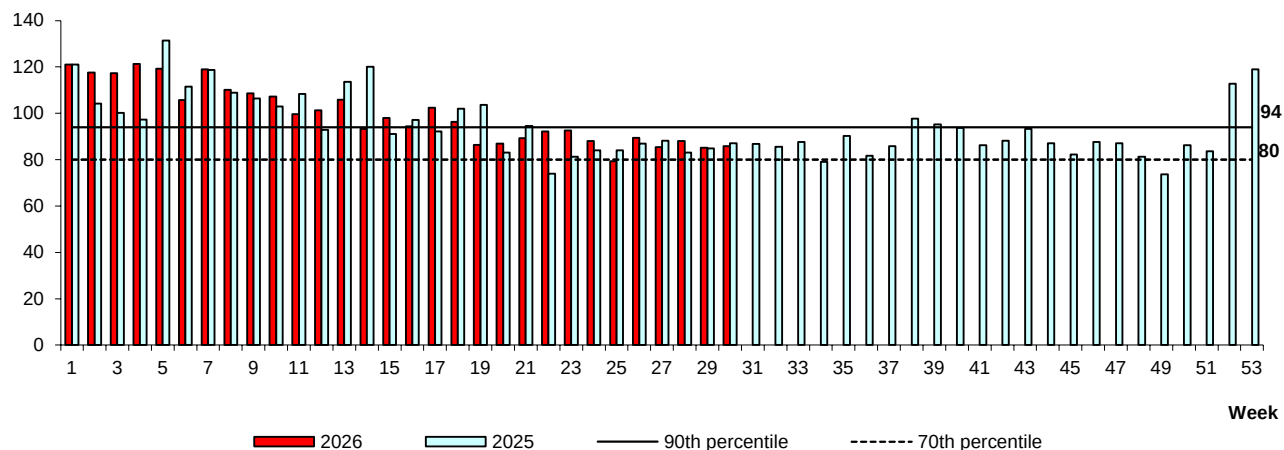

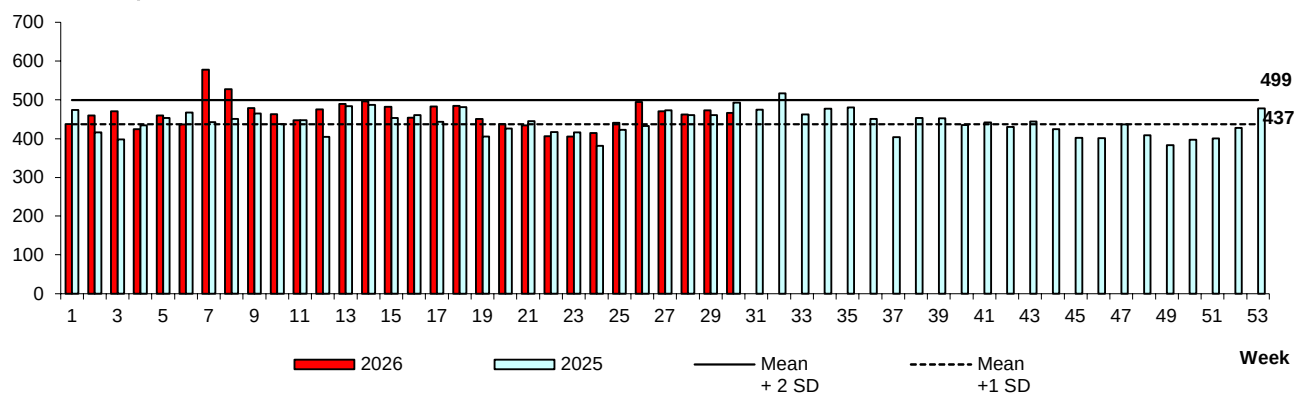

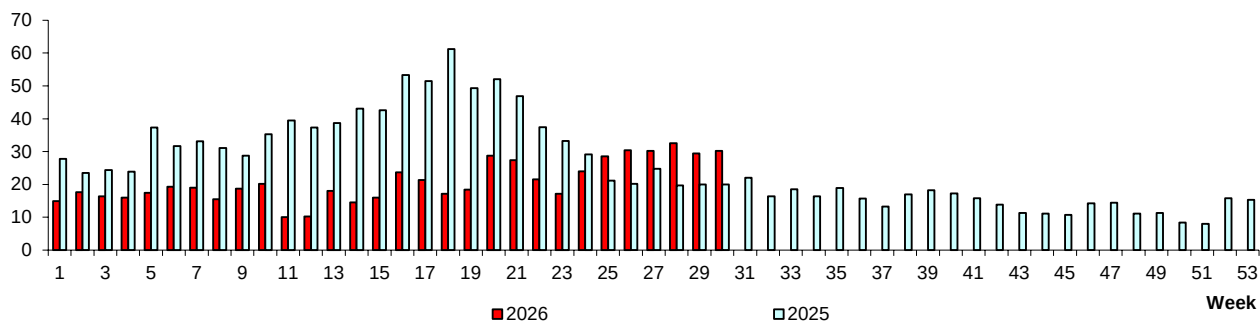
