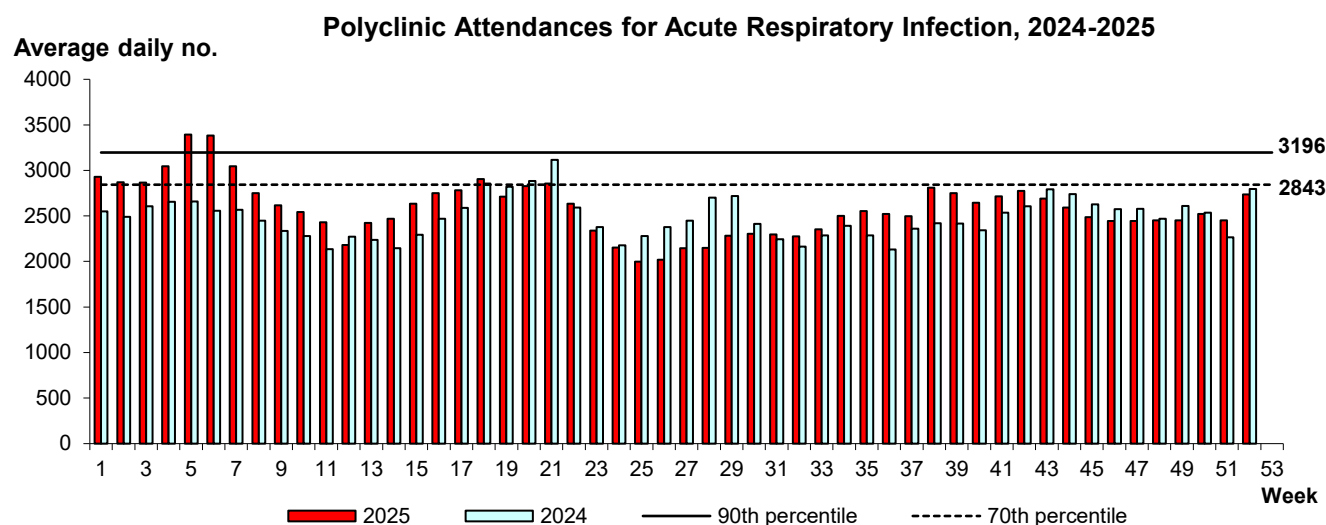

Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) Situation in Singapore 2025

ARI indicators for E-week 52 (21 - 27 Dec 2025) were as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI was 2735 (over 4 working days) in E-week 52.



In E-week 52, the top respiratory pathogens among adult and paediatric samples from the National Surveillance Programme for Acute Respiratory Infection[§] (ARI) were:

- Adult samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (26%), non-SARS seasonal coronaviruses (15%), and influenza (11%).
- Paediatric samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (32%), influenza (14%), and parainfluenza viruses (12%).

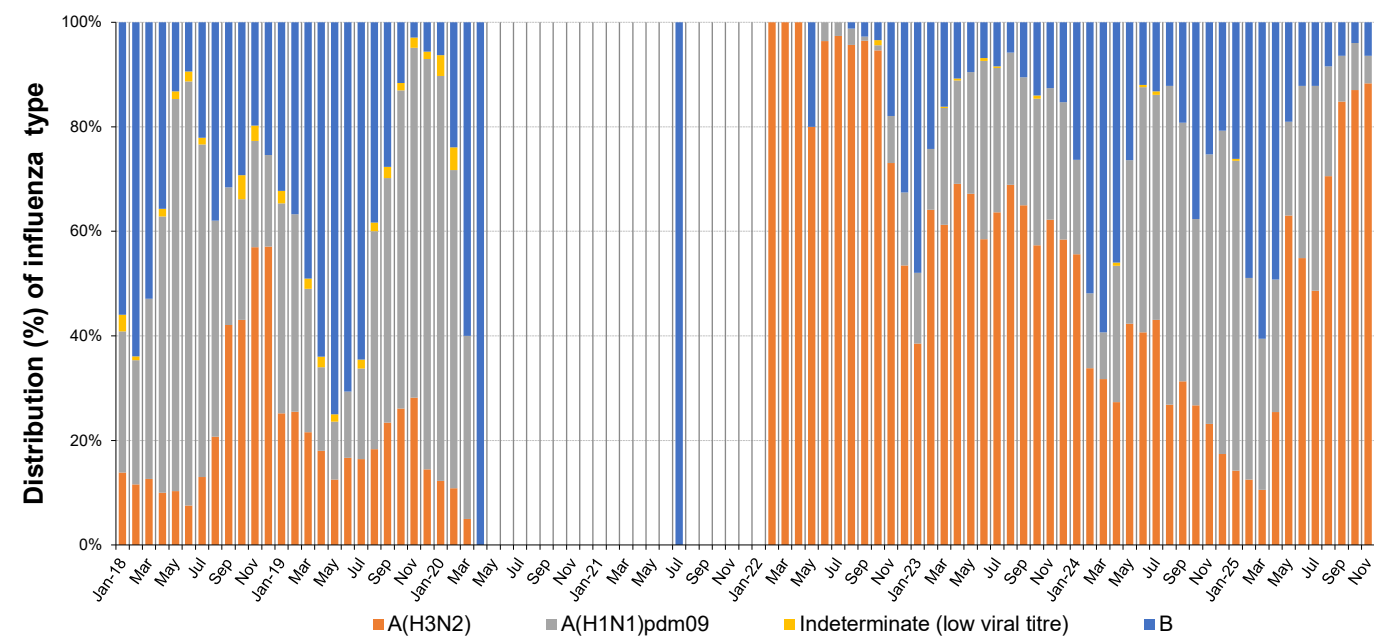
[§] CDA monitors the trends of respiratory pathogens in the community through our sentinel surveillance programme for Acute Respiratory Infections (ARI) which includes polyclinics and selected general practitioner (GP) clinics.

COVID-19 and Influenza

The proportion of patients with influenza-like illness (ILI) among the polyclinic attendances for ARI was 0.5%.
The positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n= 72) in the community was 18% in E-week 52. The positivity rate for COVID-19 among ARI samples (n= 159) in the community was 0% in E-week 52.

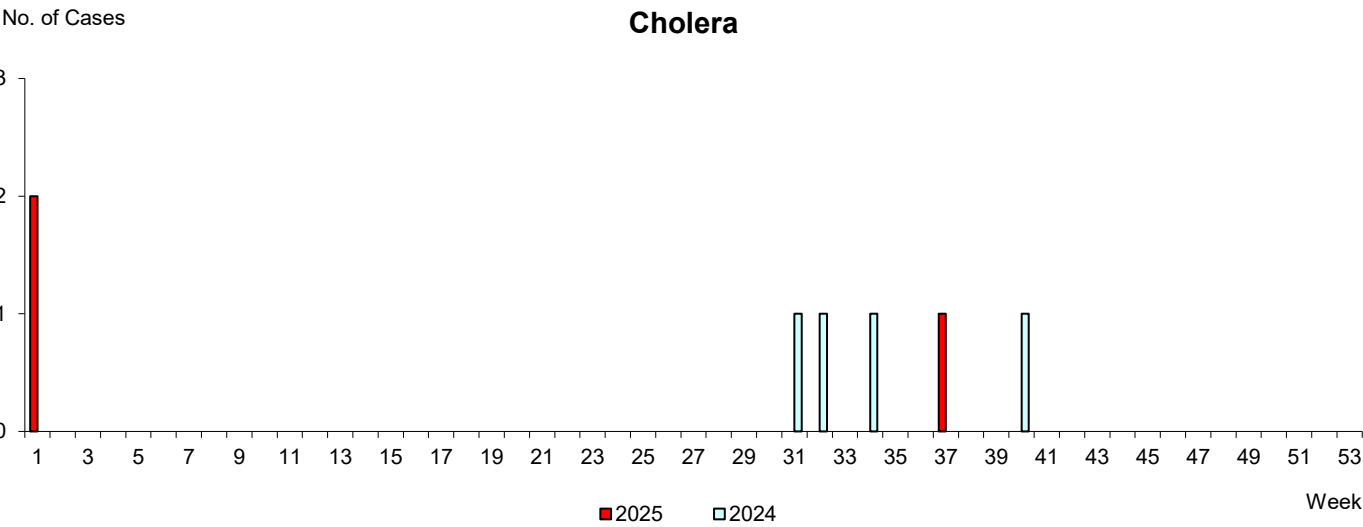
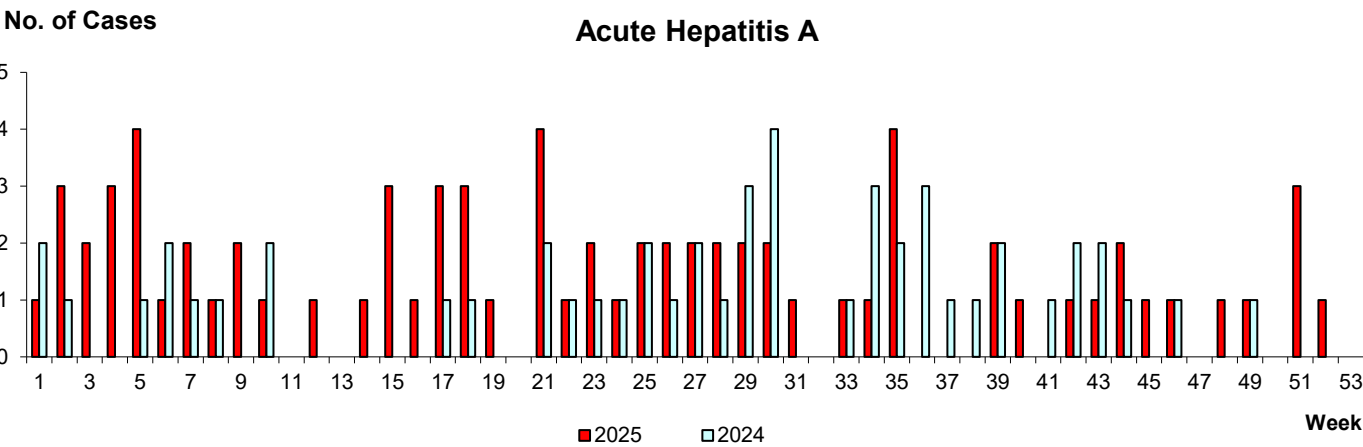
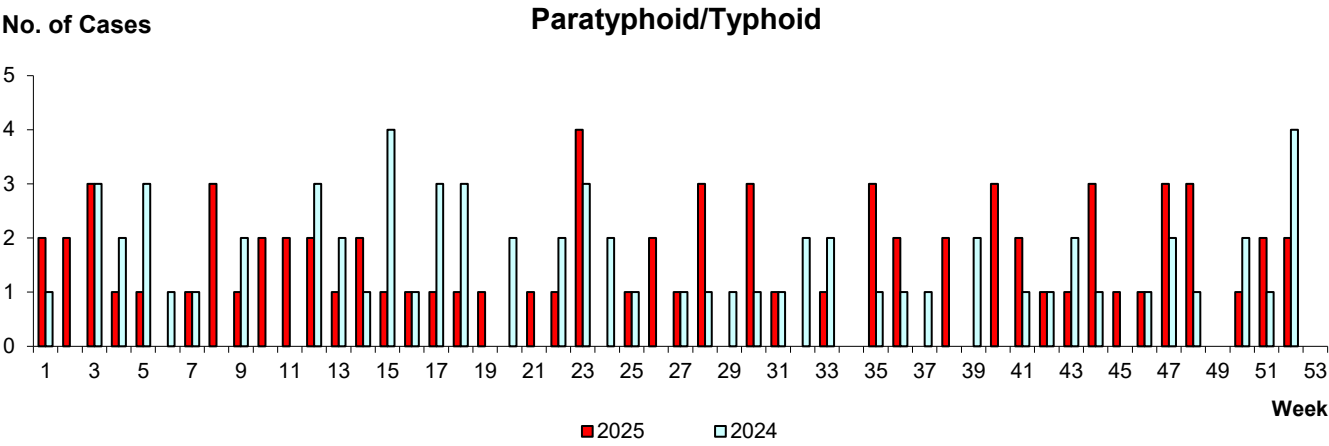
Of the 171 specimens tested positive for influenza in November 2025, nine were positive for influenza A(pH1N1) (5%), 151 were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (88%), and 11 were positive for influenza B (7%).

Monthly Influenza Surveillance

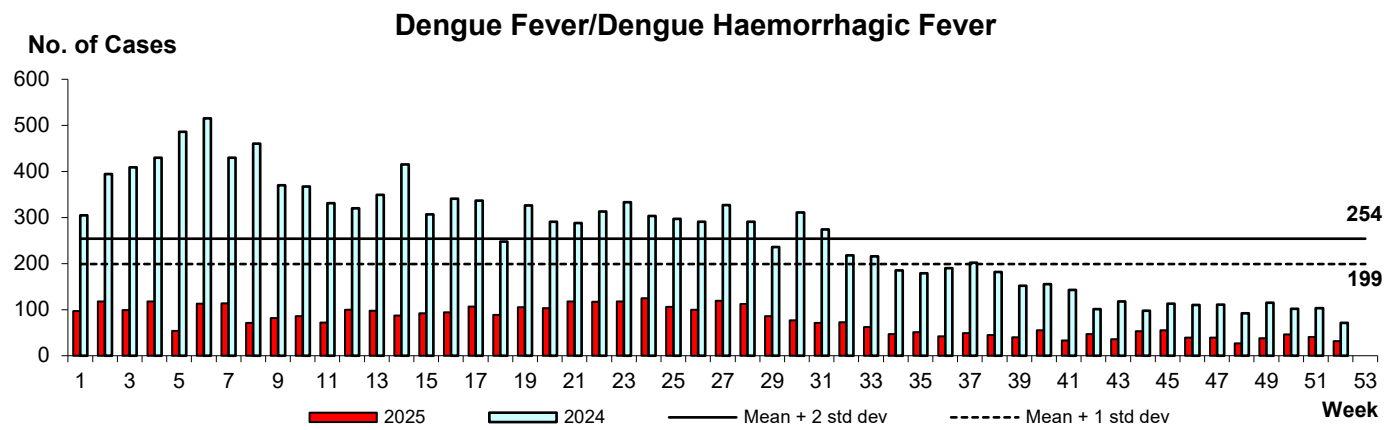

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



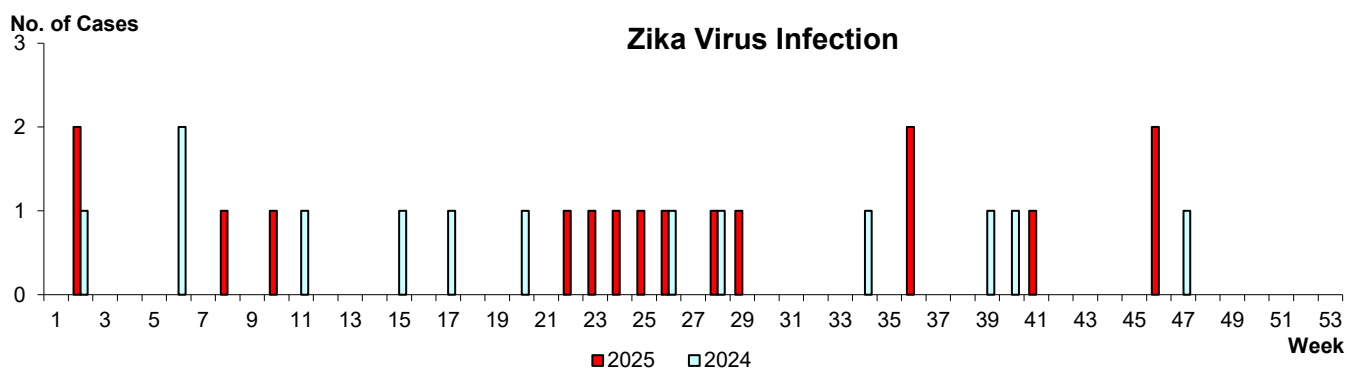
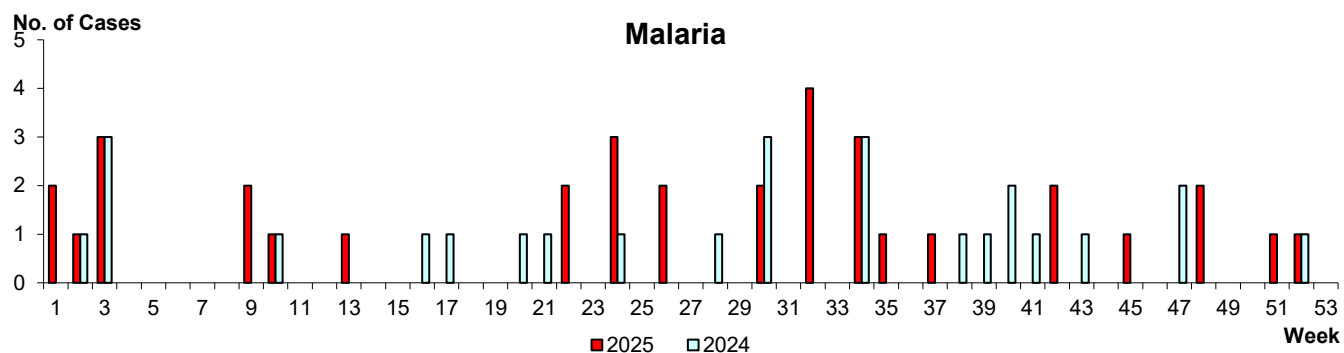
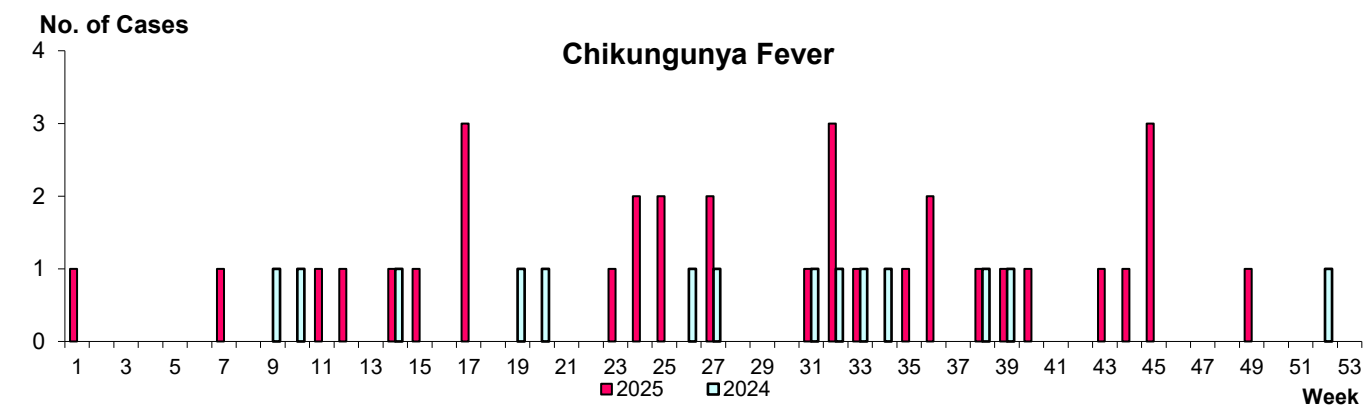
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF VECTOR-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



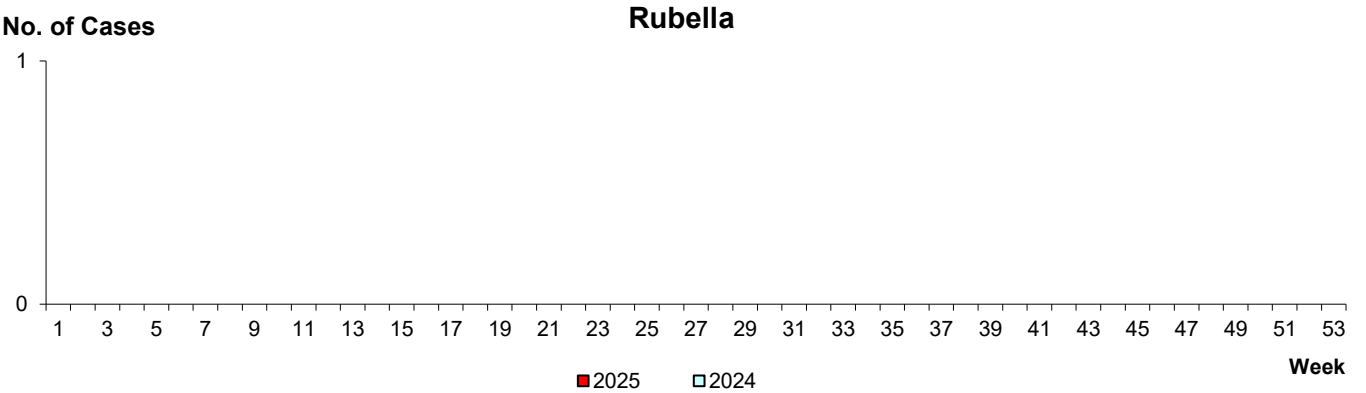
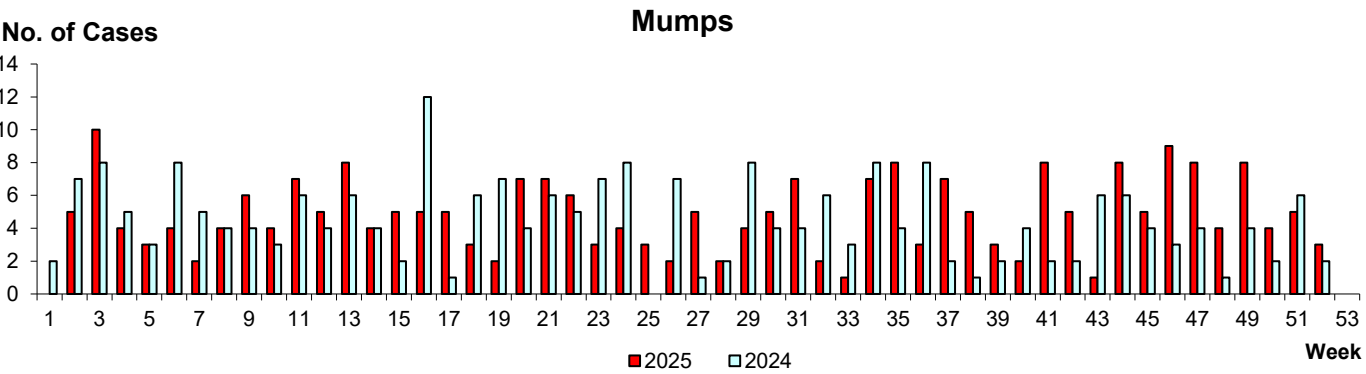
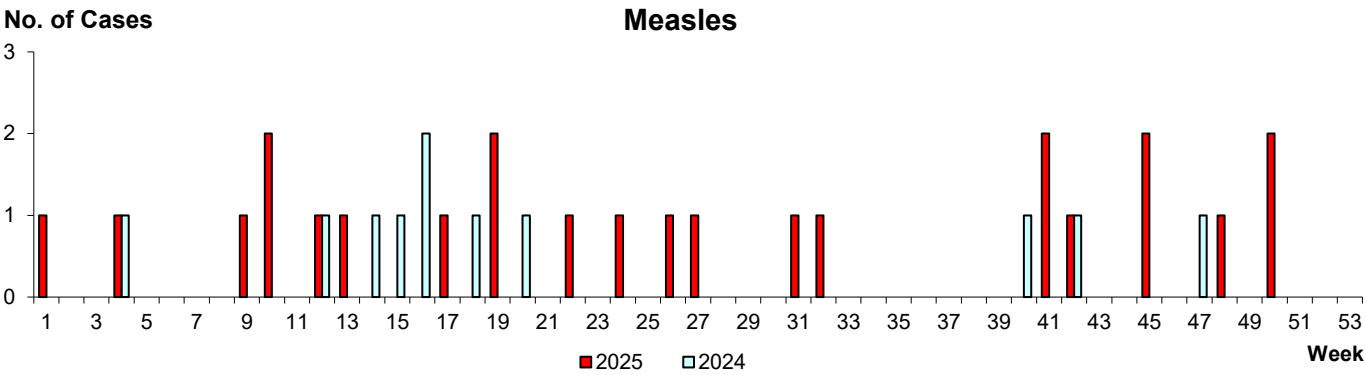
The number of dengue notifications was 32 in E-week 52.

The number of hospital admissions decreased to 4 in E-week 52, compared to 5 in E-week 51.

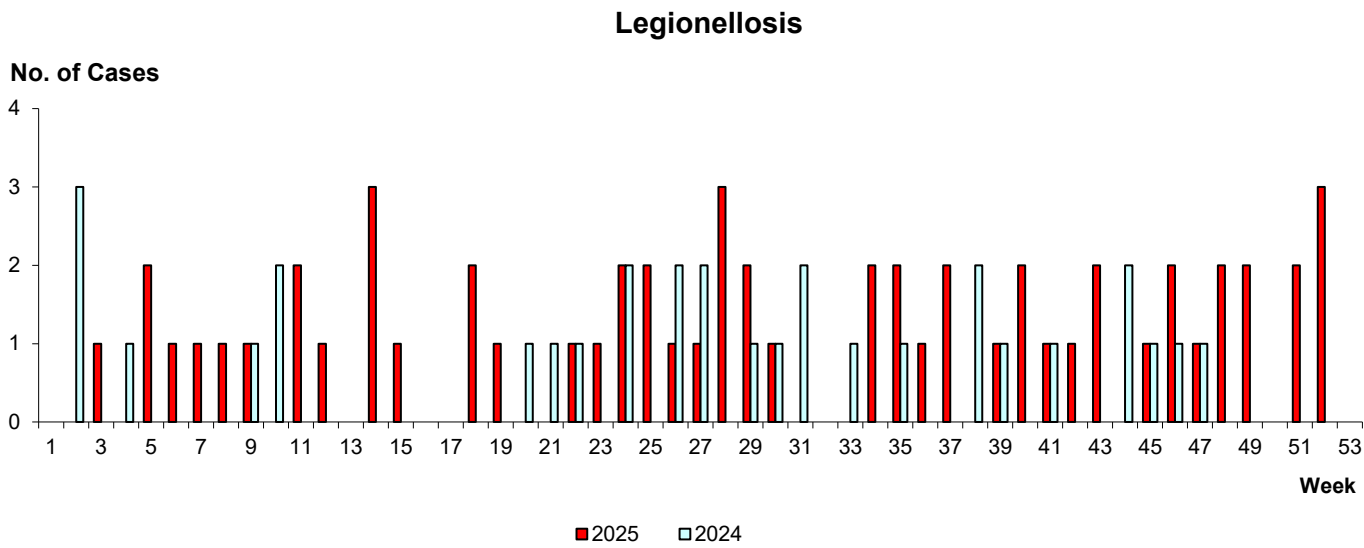
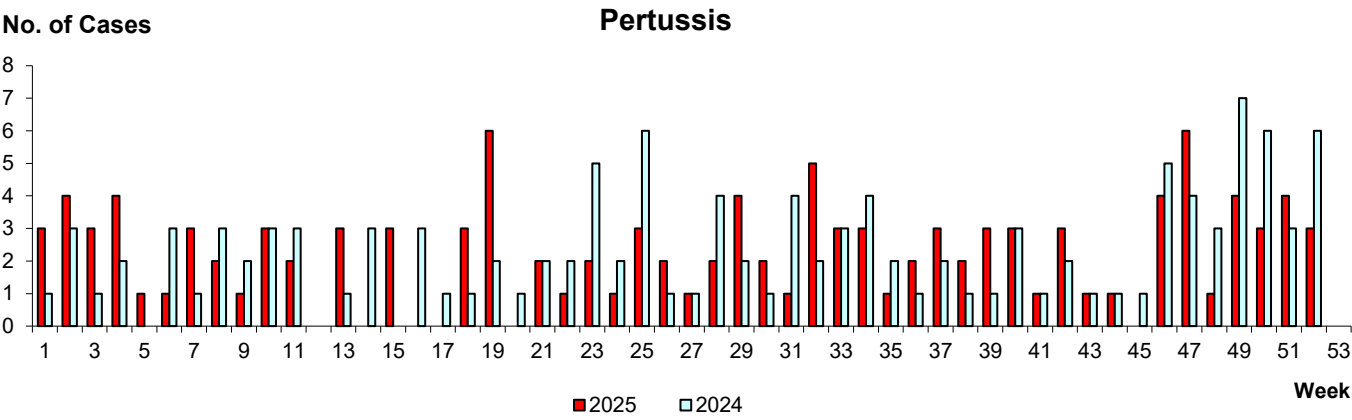
Preliminary results of all positive dengue samples serotyped in December 2025 showed DEN-1, DEN-2, DEN-3 and DEN-4 at 12.9%, 58.1%, 25.8% and 3.2% respectively.



WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



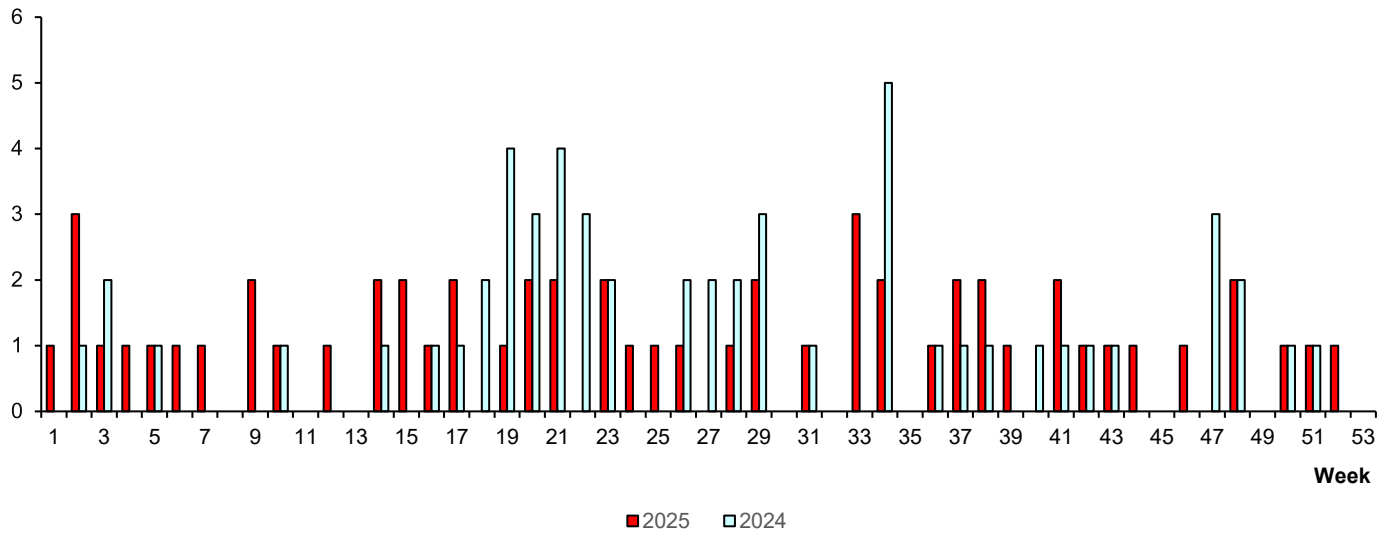
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025

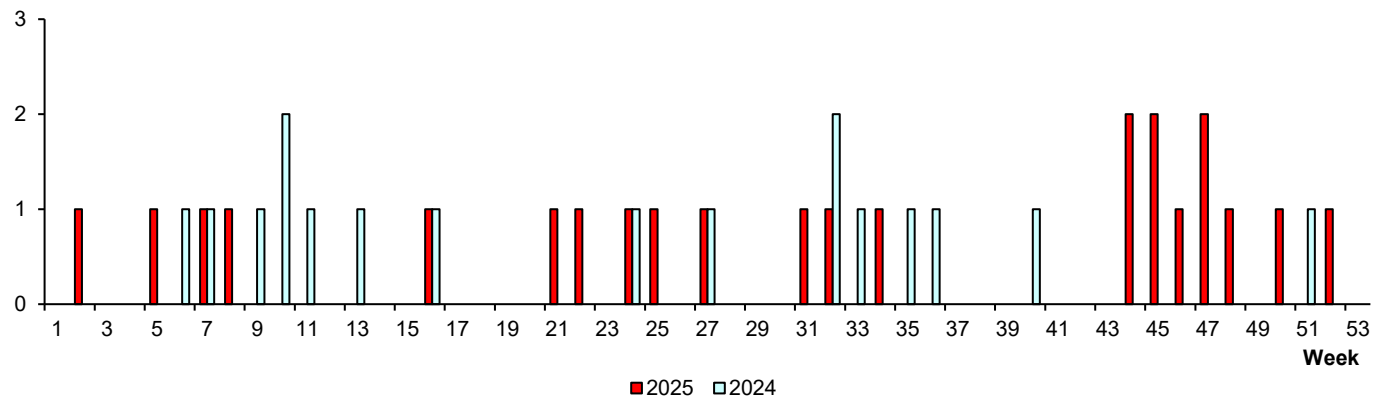

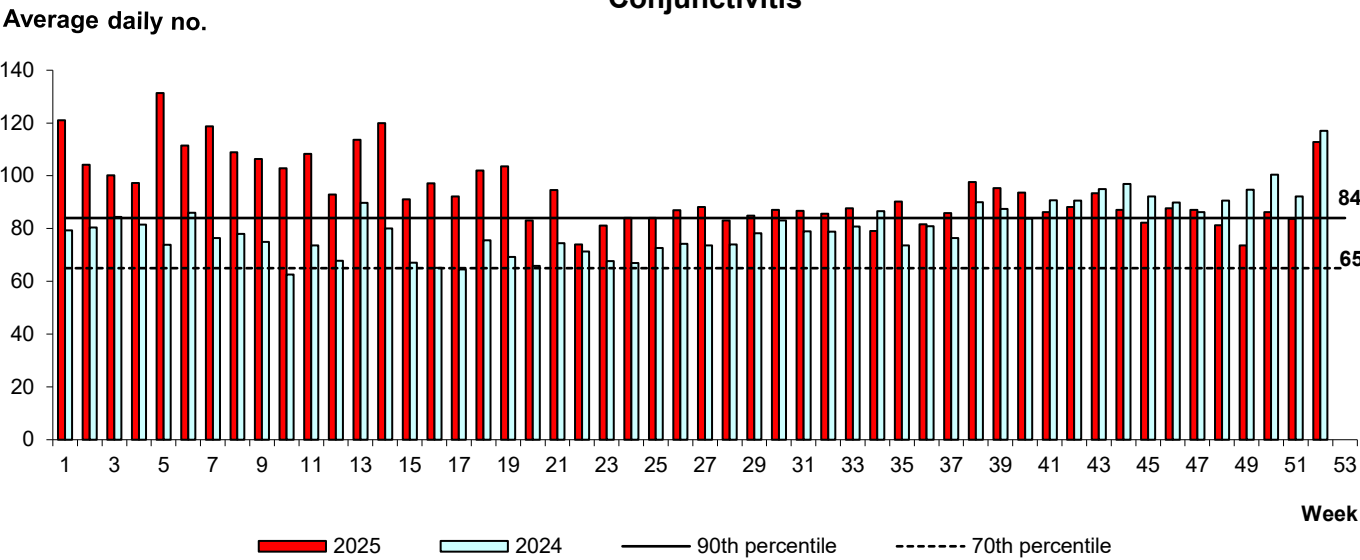

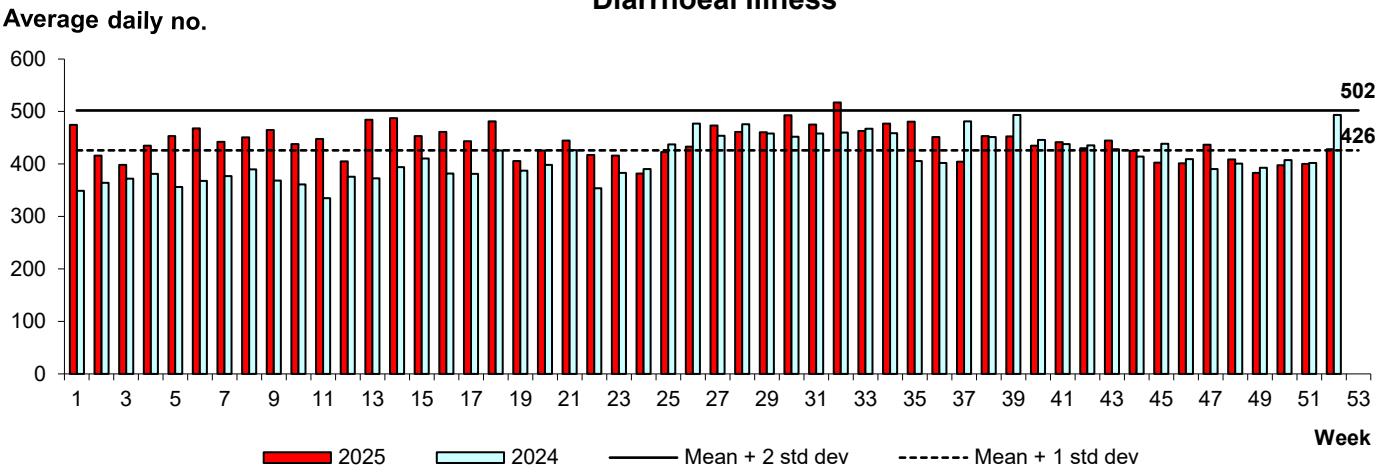
