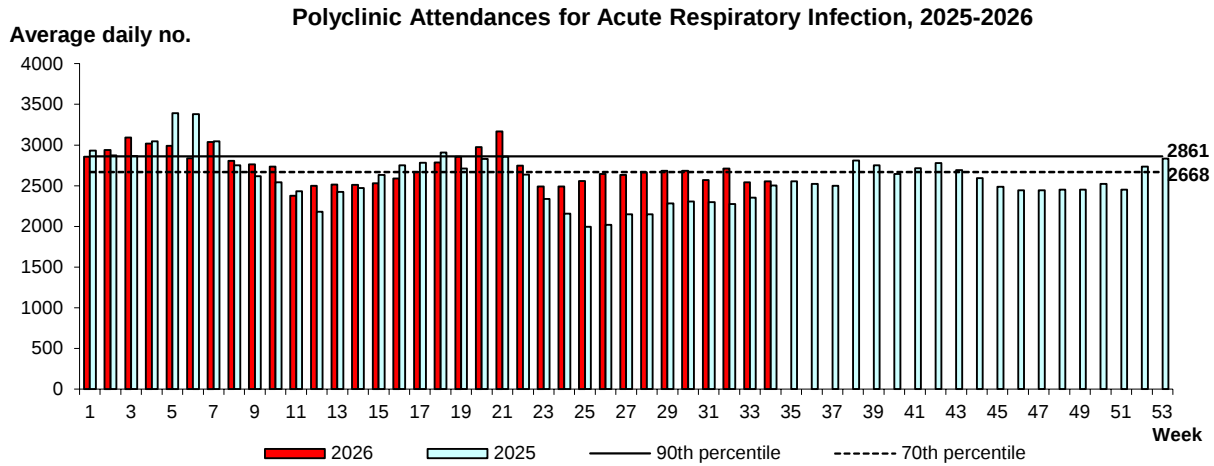

Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) Situation in Singapore 2026

ARI indicators for E-week 34 (23 - 29 Aug 2026) were as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI was 2555 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 34.



In E-week 34, the top respiratory pathogens among adult and paediatric samples from the National Surveillance Programme for Acute Respiratory Infection[§] (ARI) were:

- Adult samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (24%), influenza (20%), non-SARS seasonal coronaviruses (4%), and parainfluenza viruses (4%).
- Paediatric samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (29%), influenza (18%), and respiratory syncytial virus (14%).

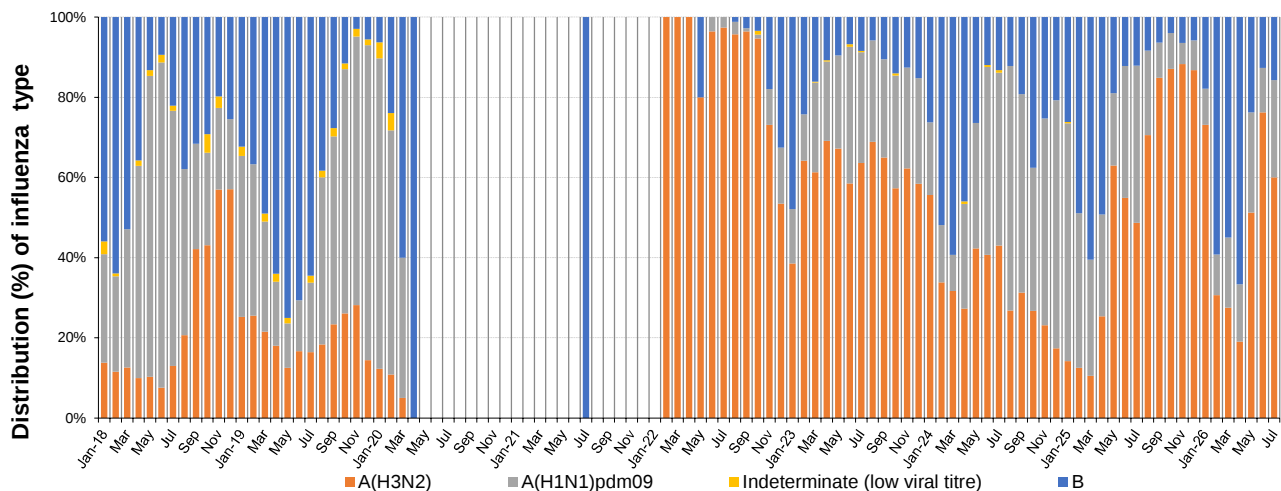
[§] CDA monitors the trends of respiratory pathogens in the community through our sentinel surveillance programme for Acute Respiratory Infections (ARI) which includes polyclinics and selected general practitioner (GP) clinics.

COVID-19 and Influenza

The positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n= 183) in the community was 32% in E-week 34. The positivity rate for COVID-19 among ARI samples (n= 356) in the community was 2% in E-week 34.

Of the 165 specimens tested positive for influenza in July 2026, 40 were positive for influenza A(pH1N1) (24.2%), 99 were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (60.0%), and 26 were positive for influenza B (15.8%).

Monthly Influenza Surveillance

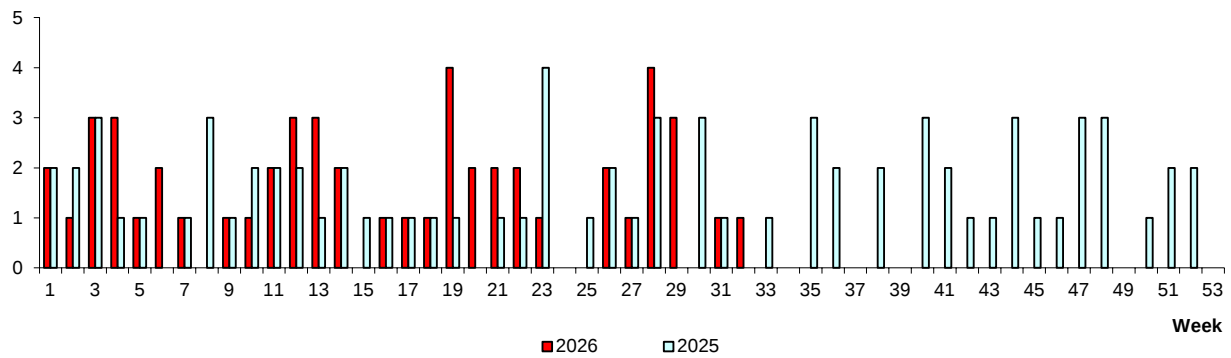

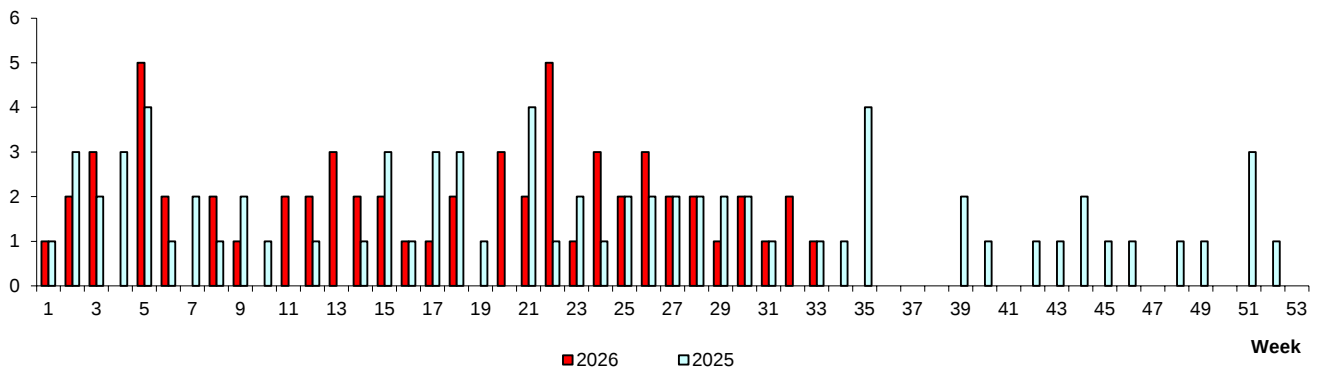

Paratyphoid/Typhoid



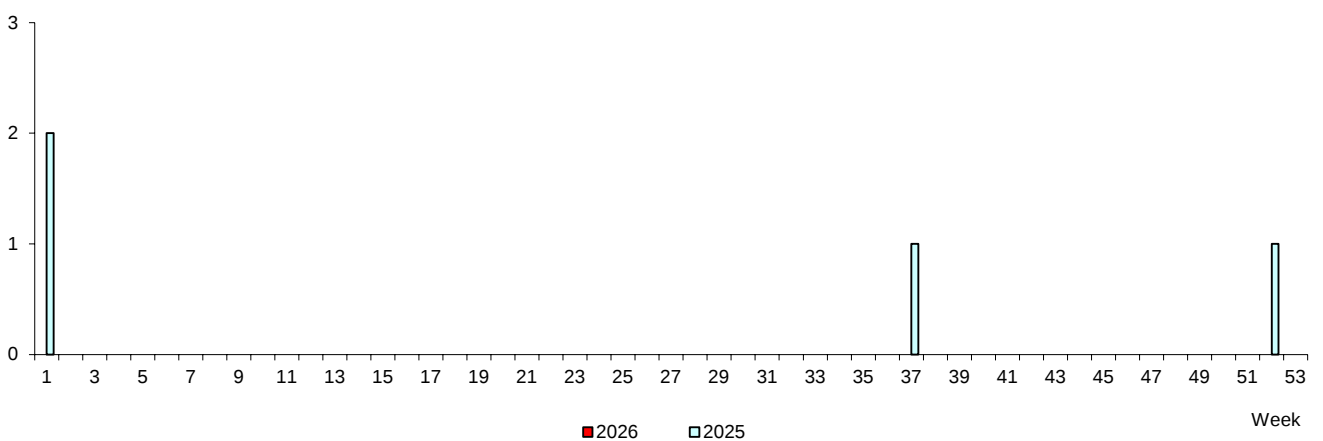

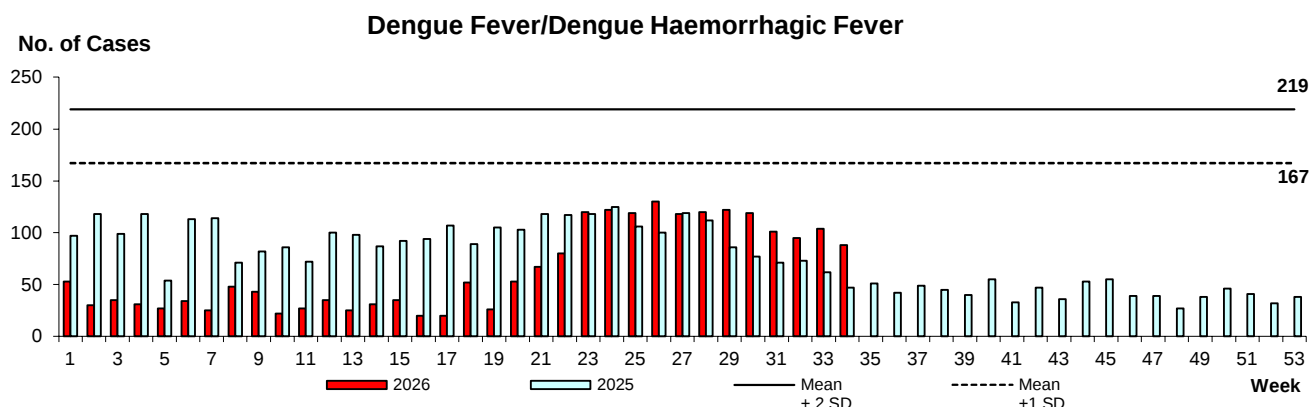

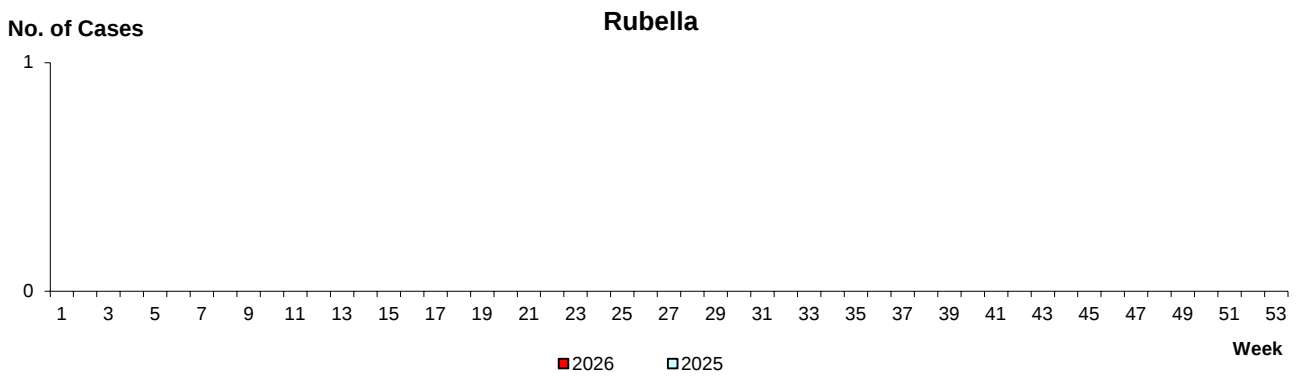
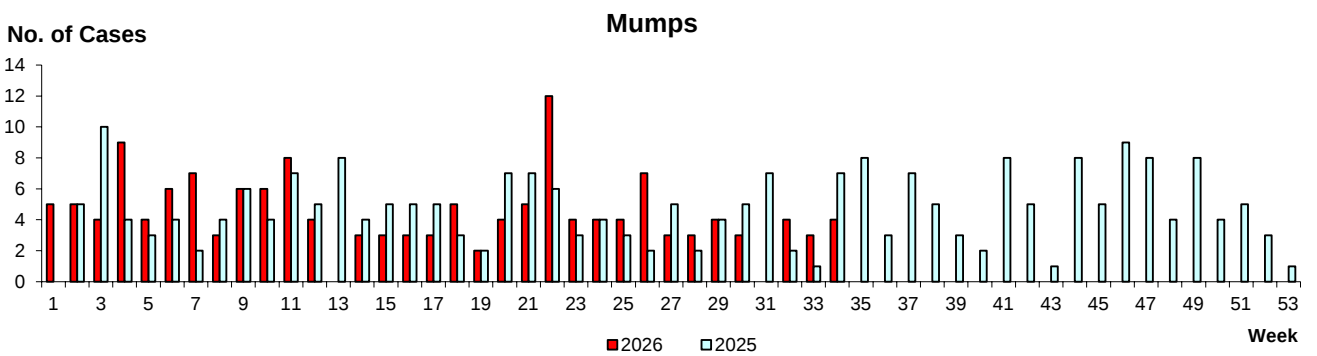
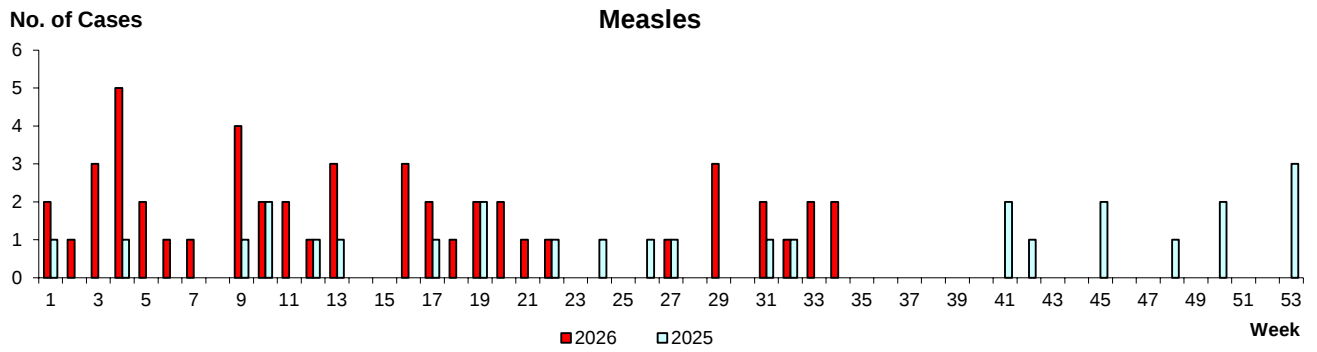
The number of dengue notifications was 88 in E-week 34.

The number of hospital admissions decreased to 10 in E-week 34, compared to 15 in E-week 33.

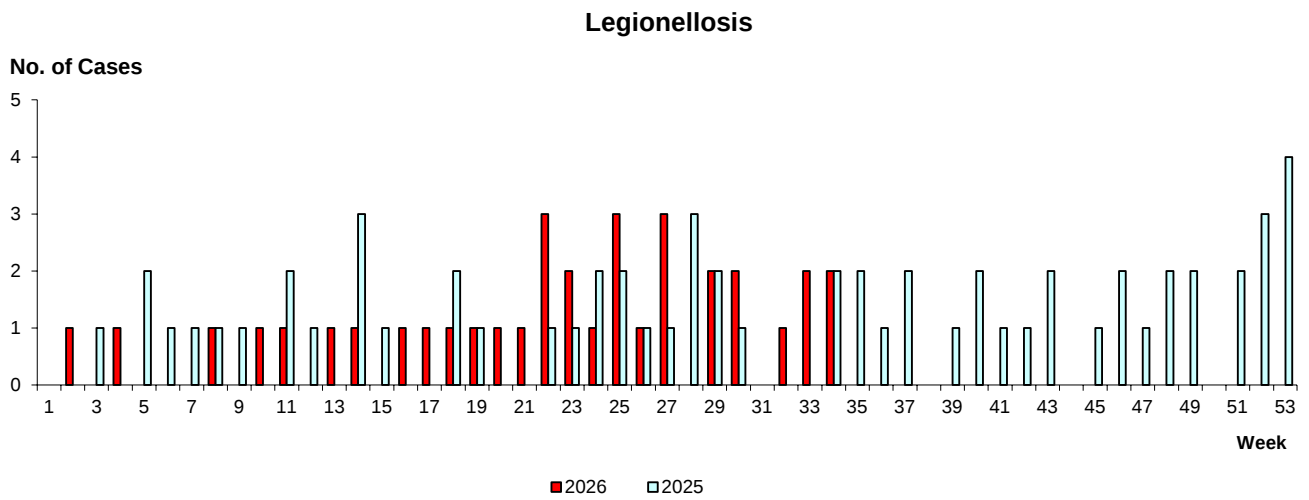
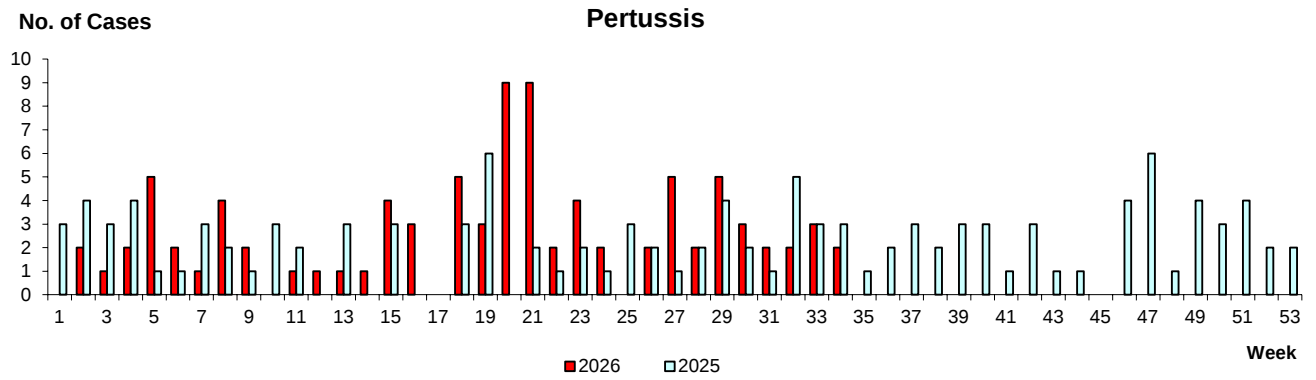
Preliminary results of all positive dengue samples serotyped in Aug 2026 showed DEN-1, DEN-2, DEN-3 and DEN-4 at 11.1%, 51.6%, 33.3% and 4.0% respectively.



WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2025-2026



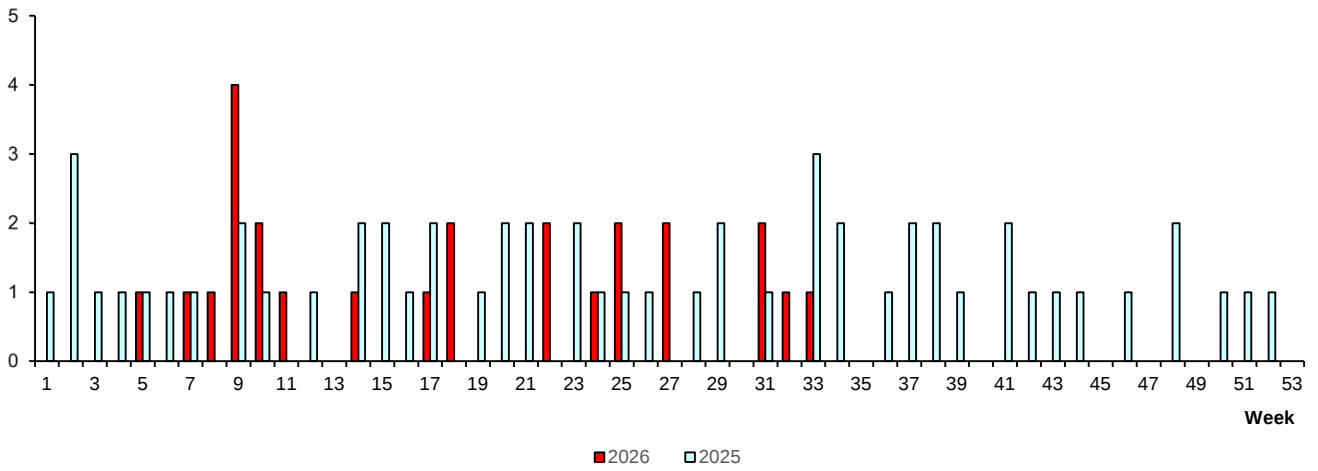
