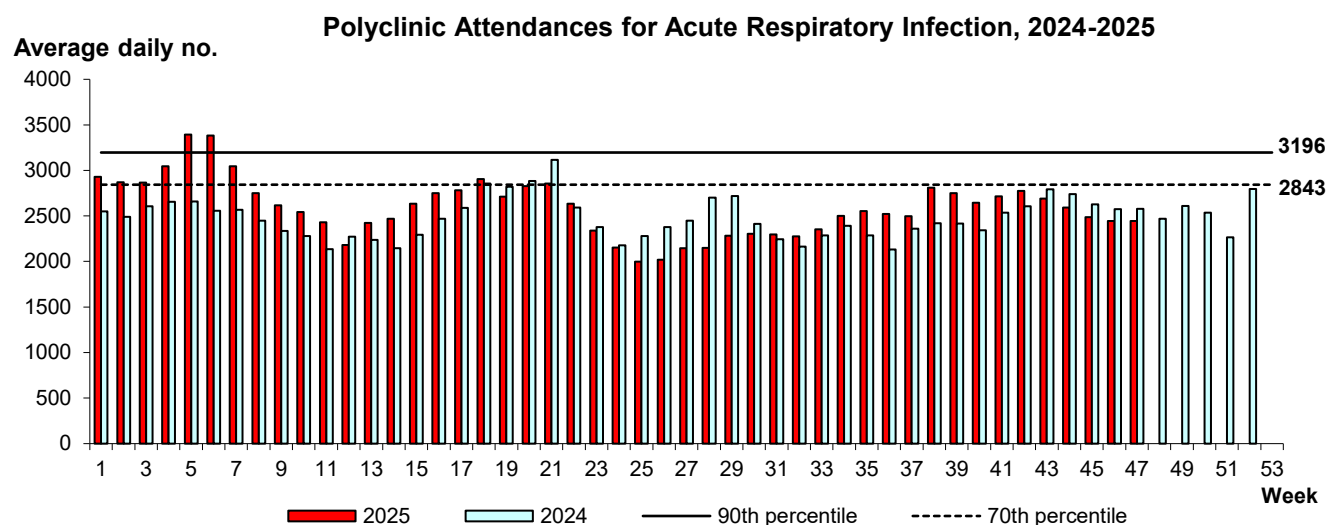

Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI) Situation in Singapore 2025

ARI indicators for E-week 47 (16 - 22 Nov 2025) were as follows:

The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI was 2443 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 47.



In E-week 47, the top respiratory pathogens among adult and paediatric samples from the National Surveillance Programme for Acute Respiratory Infection[§] (ARI) were:

- Adult samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (25%), Influenza (15%), and Non-SARS seasonal coronaviruses (9%).
- Paediatric samples: Human rhinovirus/enterovirus (31%), Influenza (12%), and Non-SARS seasonal coronaviruses (9%).

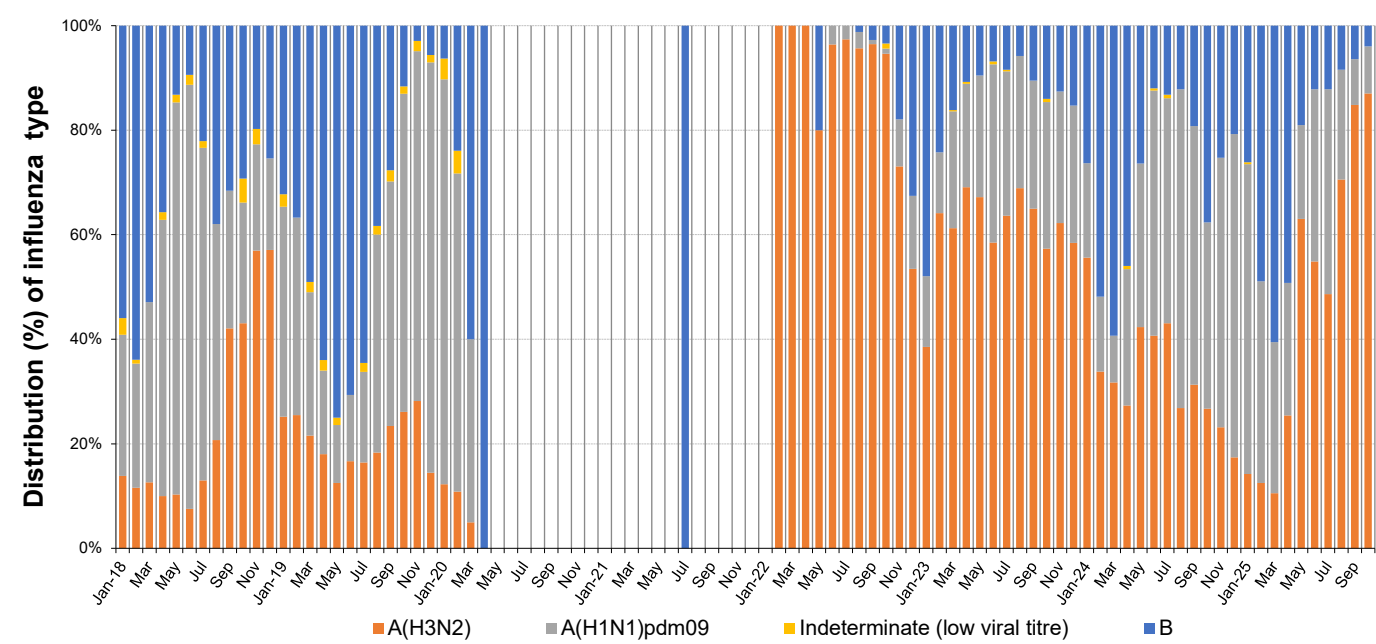
[§] CDA monitors the trends of respiratory pathogens in the community through our sentinel surveillance programme for Acute Respiratory Infections (ARI) which includes polyclinics and selected general practitioner (GP) clinics.

COVID-19 and Influenza

The proportion of patients with influenza-like illness (ILI) among the polyclinic attendances for ARI was 0.6%.
The positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n= 192) in the community was 20% in E-week 47. The positivity rate for COVID-19 among ARI samples (n= 353) in the community was 1% in E-week 47.

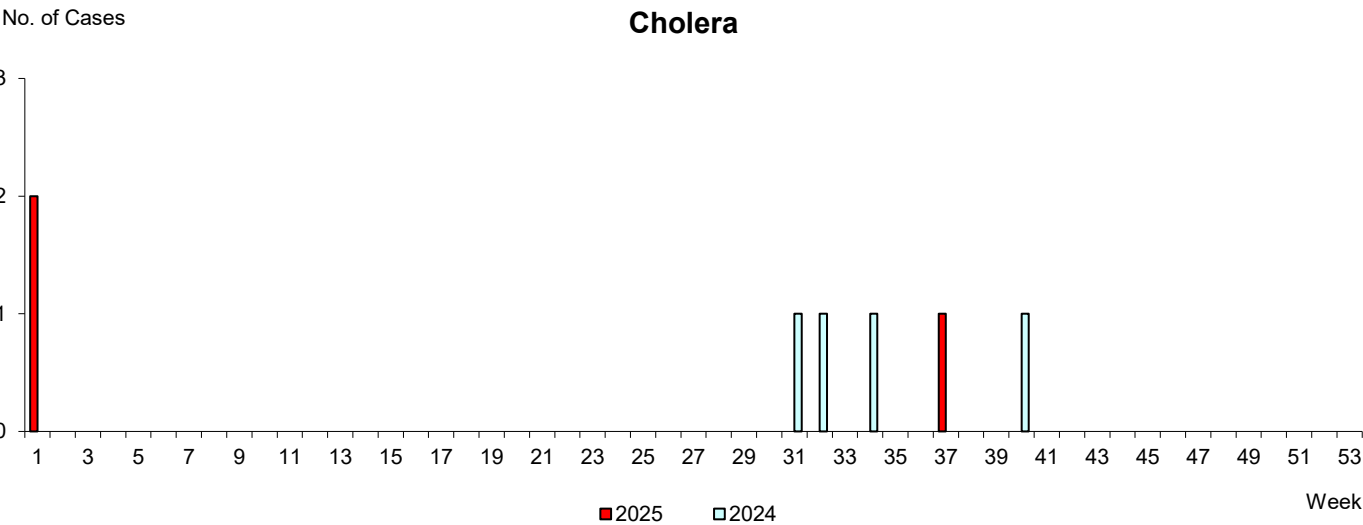
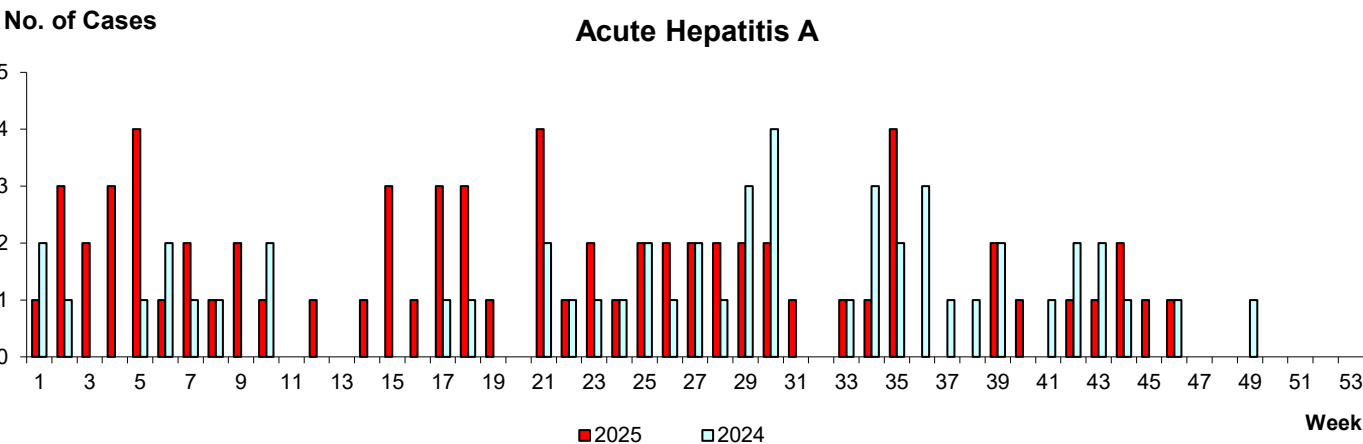
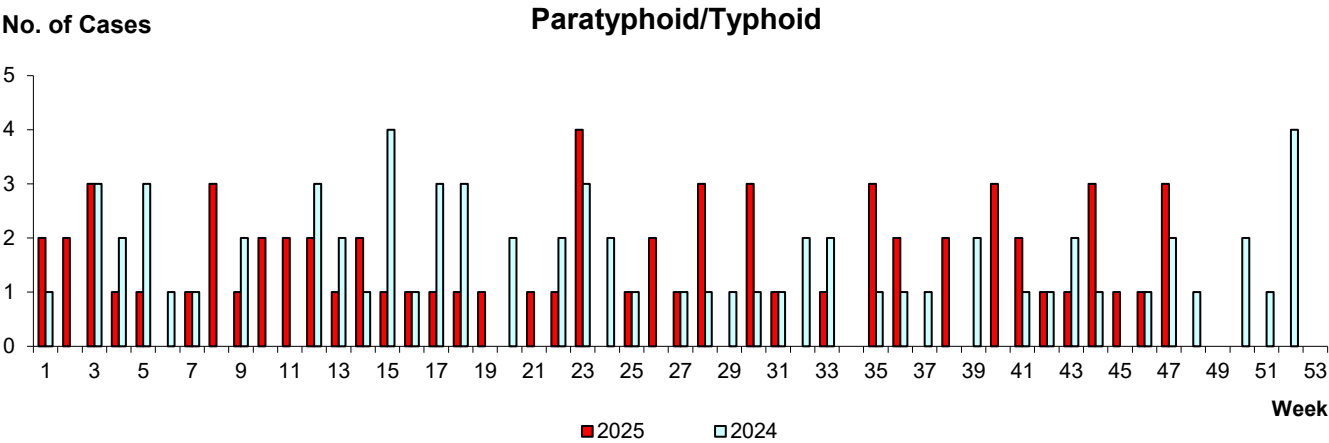
Of the 278 specimens tested positive for influenza in October 2025, 25 were positive for Influenza A(pH1N1) (9%), 242 were positive for Influenza A(H3N2) (87%), and 11 were positive for Influenza B (4%).

Monthly Influenza Surveillance

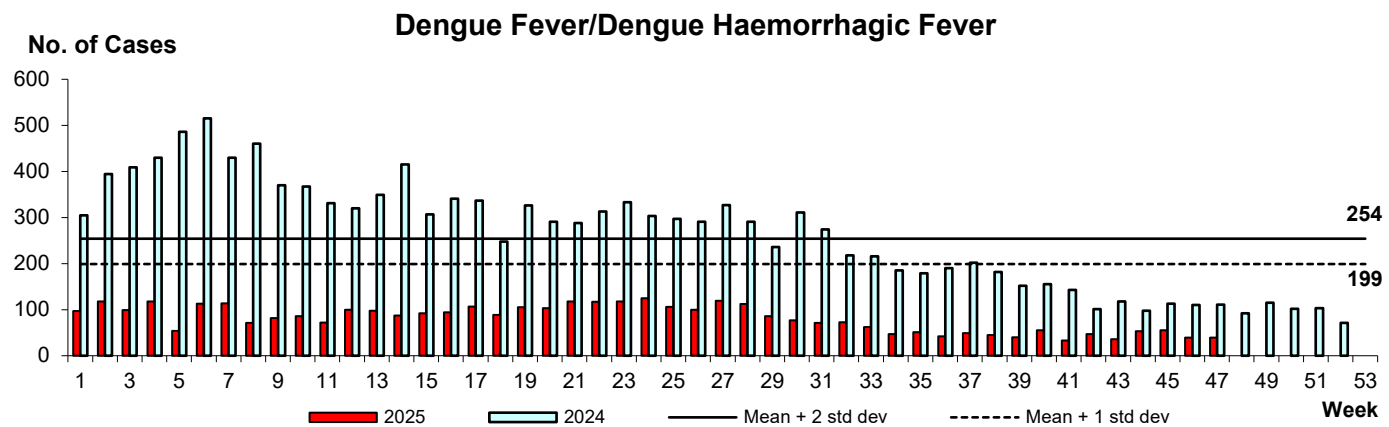


Based on influenza-like illness (ILI) samples from GPs and polyclinics

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



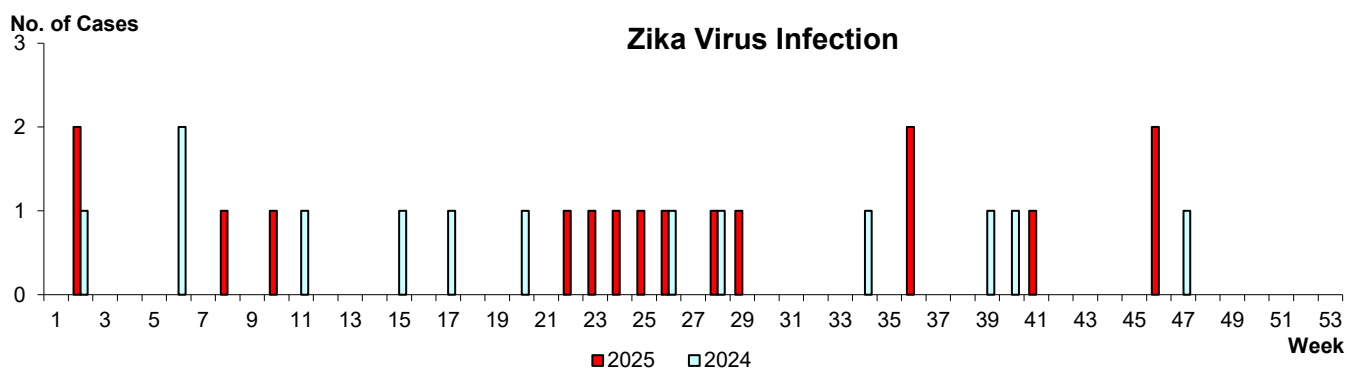
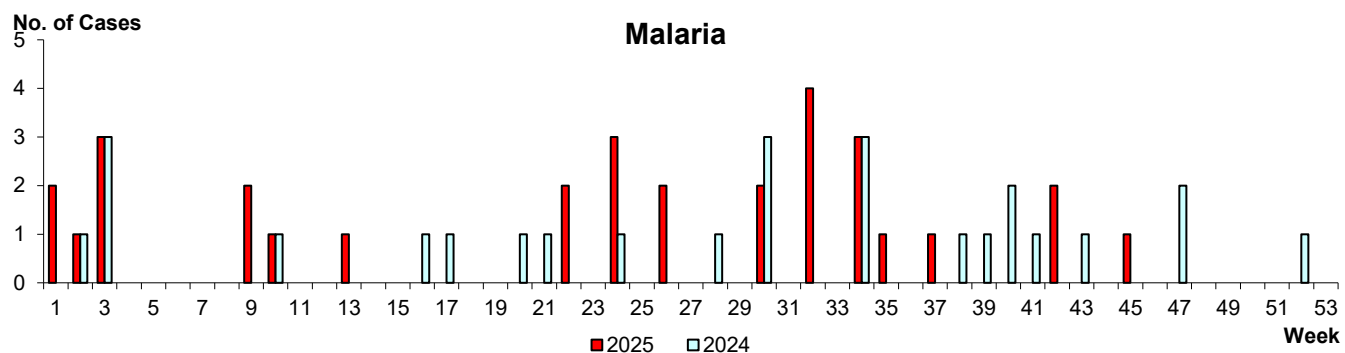
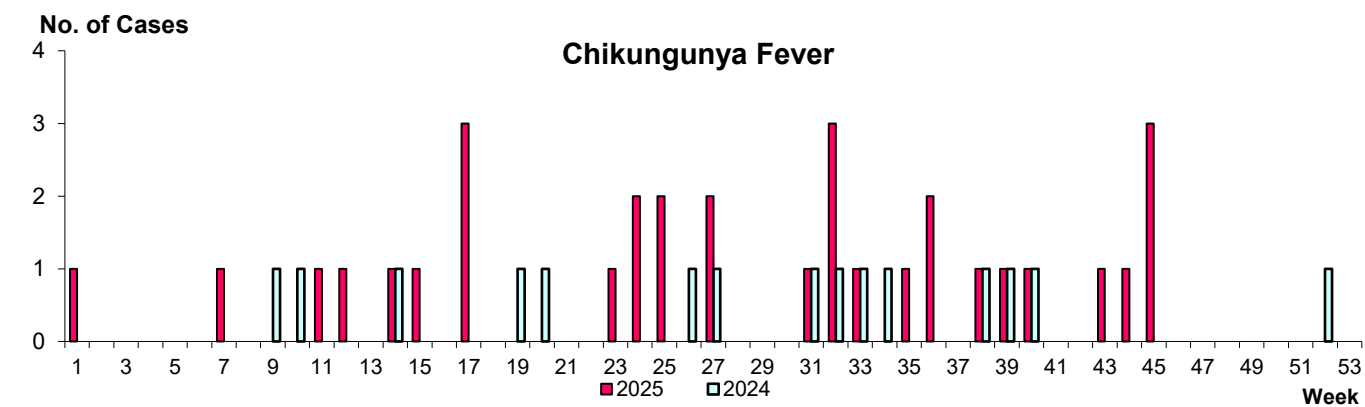
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF VECTOR-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



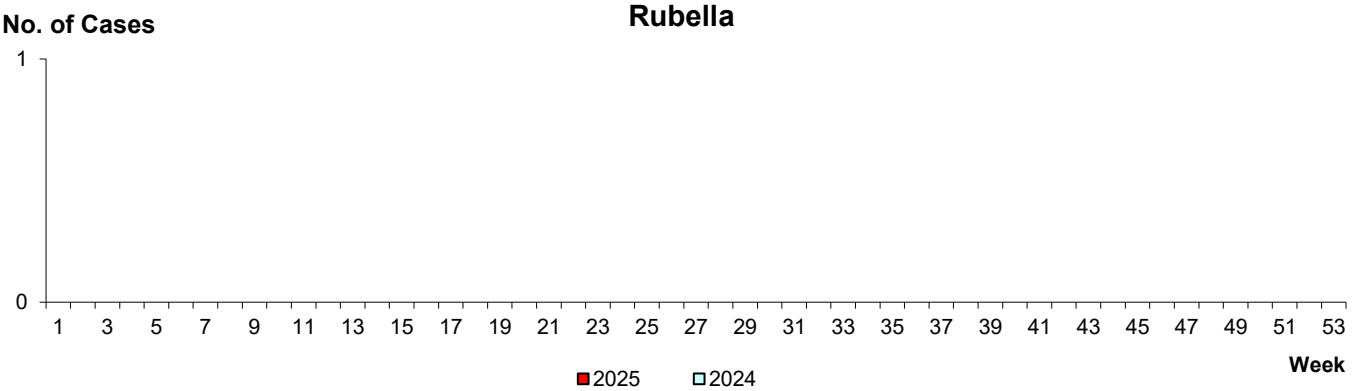
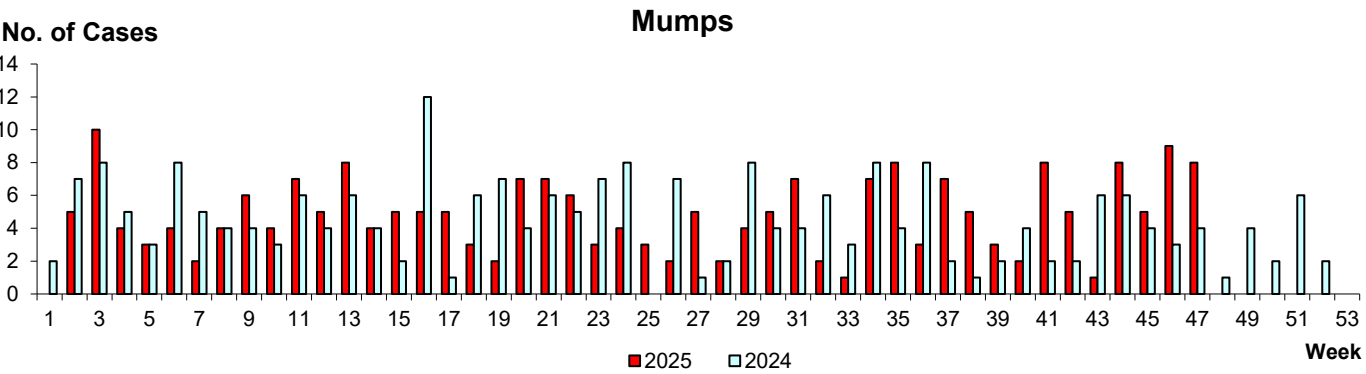
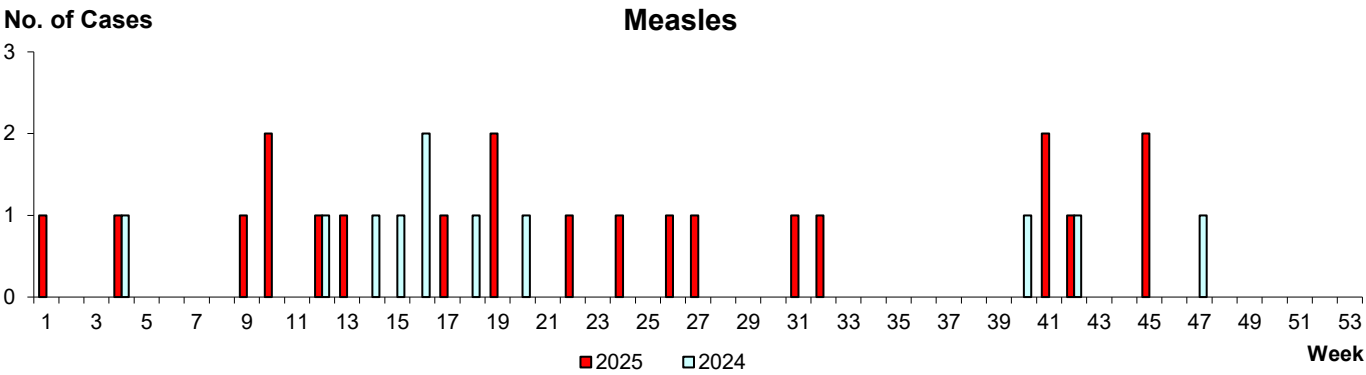
The number of dengue notifications was 39 in E-week 47.

The number of hospital admissions decreased to 4 in E-week 47, compared to 9 in E-week 46.

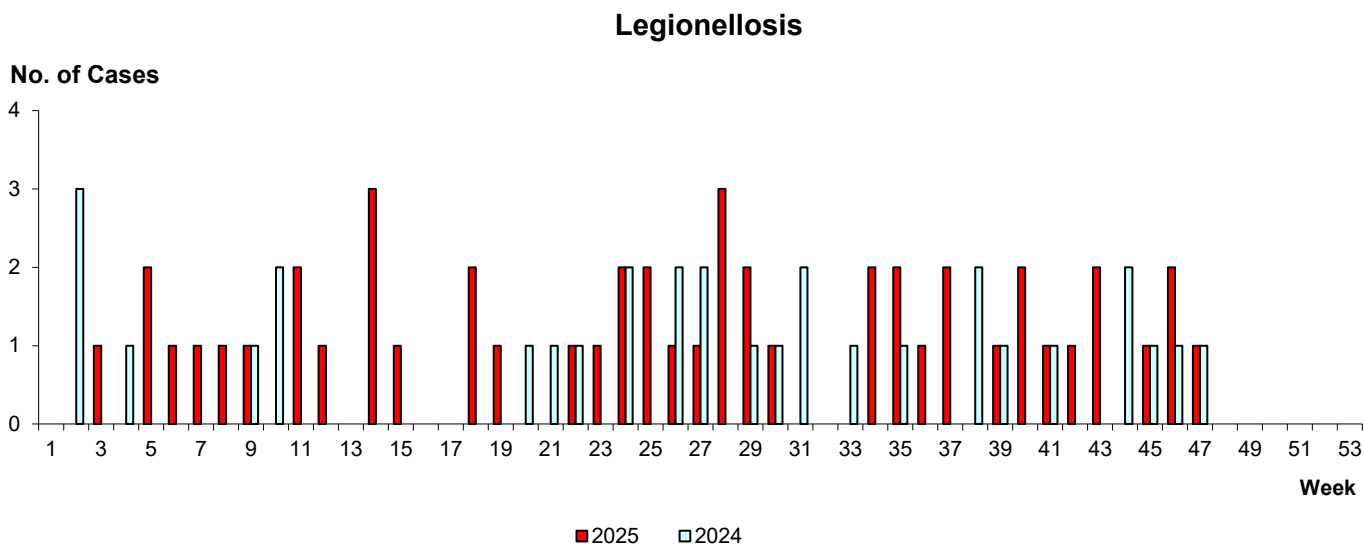
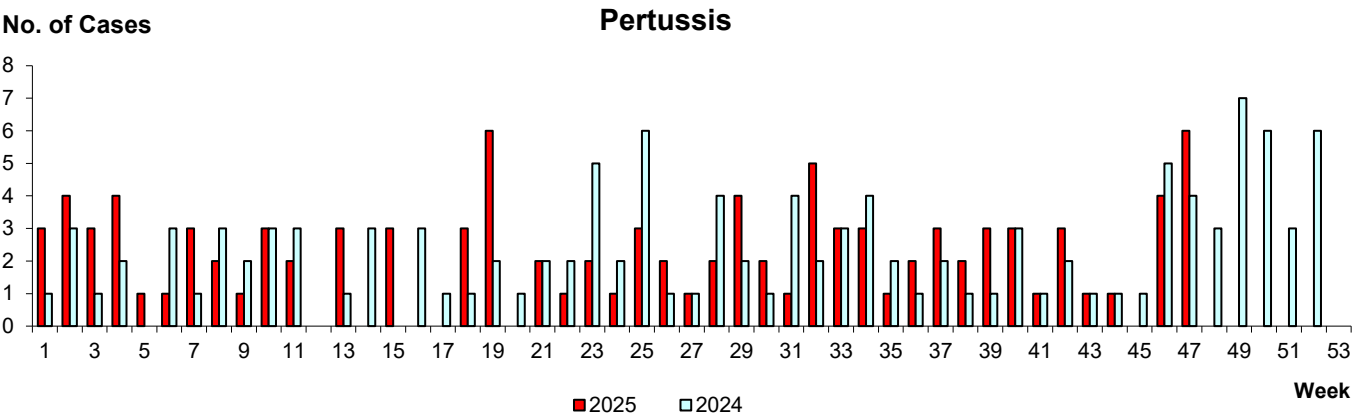
Preliminary results of all positive dengue samples serotyped in November 2025 showed DEN-1, DEN-2, DEN-3 and DEN-4 at 20.8%, 41.7%, 29.2% and 8.3% respectively.



WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025



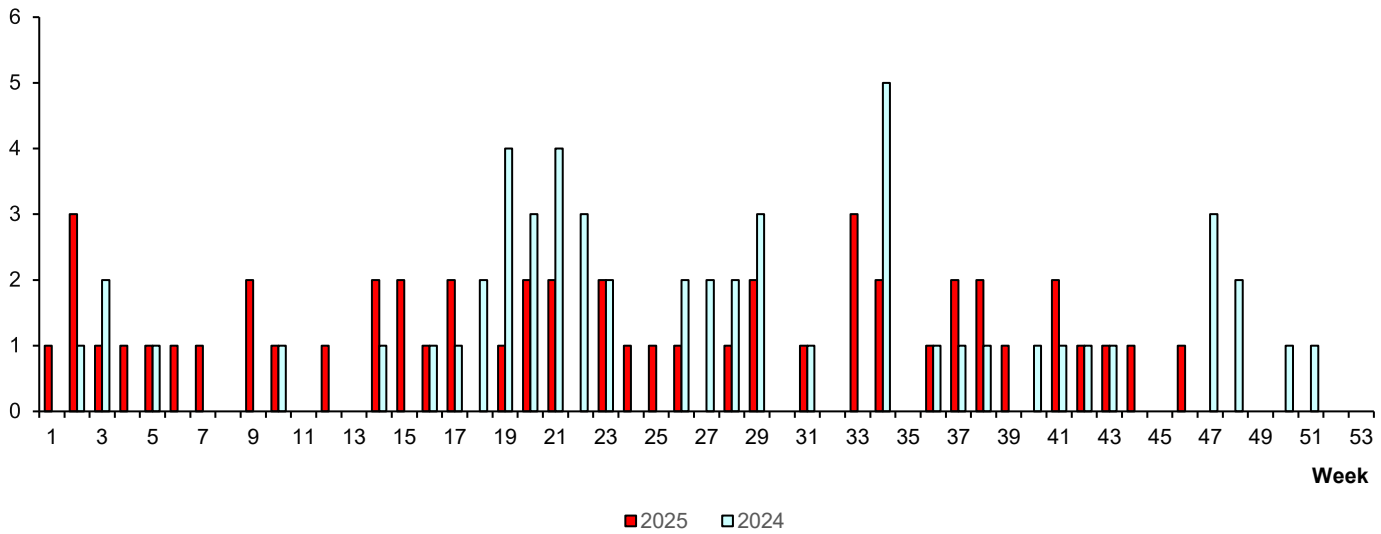
WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2024-2025

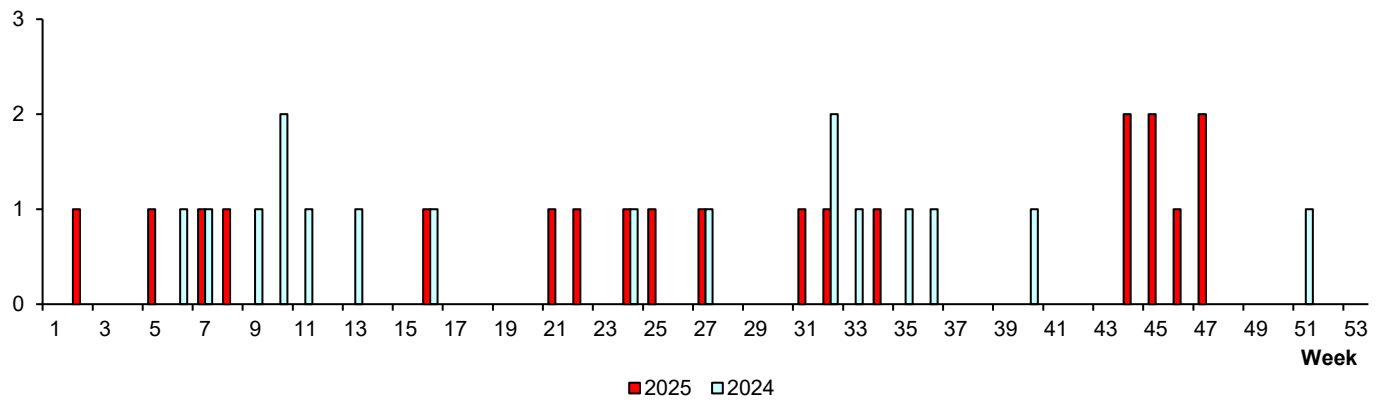
