Dr Lee Pei Hua is an Infectious Diseases (ID) Consultant at the **National Centre for Infectious Diseases (NCID)** and **Tan Tock Seng Hospital, Singapore**.

She graduated from the University of Manchester, UK, with a Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBChB) in 2012 and completed her specialist training in Infectious Diseases in 2022.

Dr Lee currently serves as the Deputy Head of the Enhanced HIV Programme, a multidisciplinary team that cares for the largest cohort of people living with HIV in Singapore. She also leads the HIV Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) service at NCID. She is also a member of the Action for AIDS Singapore (AfA), an NGO that is dedicated to fighting HIV infection and AIDS in Singapore.

Dr Wong Chen Seong is the Director, HIV-Hepatitis-STI Division, Communicable Diseases Agency.

Dr Wong leads a team of dedicated and capable public health officers in the formulation and implementation of the national response to HIV, Hepatitis B and C, and the sexually transmitted infections at CDA.

He is also a Senior Consultant Physician in the Department of Infectious Diseases, TTSH and NCID, where he provides care for people living with HIV, as well as those requiring treatment for sexually transmitted infections and other infectious diseases.

Dr Wong previously served as the Head of the NCID/TTSH Clinical HIV Programme, as well as the Director of the National HIV Programme. He is actively involved in medical education, as well as research in the fields of HIV prevention and treatment and the socio-behavioural aspects of HIV.
