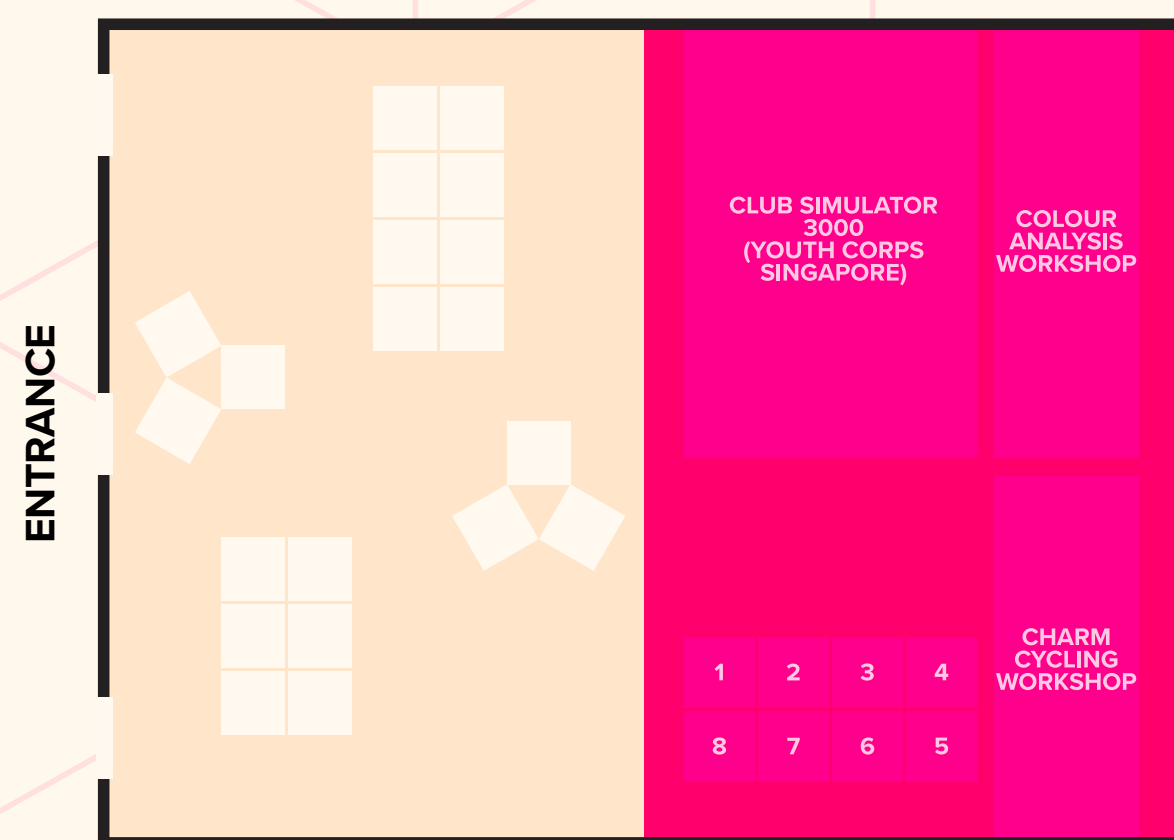
Participatory Budgeting is a process where YOU decide how a defined sum of public budget is spent.

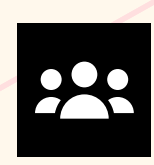
