## LETTERS CONFIRMING ISSUANCE AND CANCELLATION OF SINGAPORE PASSPORTS

As of 1 March 2026, the Embassy will cease issuing letters confirming the issuance of new Singapore passports and/or the cancellation of old passports of Singaporeans.

The Embassy notes that Singapore passports are officially recognised by the Royal Thai Government and have advanced security features which enable trained officers to verify their authenticity. Old passports are cancelled in a visible way through the punching of holes in the document. Therefore, unless there is a reason to suspect forgery, Singapore passports should be accepted as proof of identity and Singapore citizenship of the holder, without additional requirements.
