WHAT IS THE 'ISTANA'?

The Istana, which means 'Palace' in Malay, is a significant historical landmark in Singapore. Built by the British colonial government in 1869, the Istana grounds cover an area of about 40 hectares and have witnessed many important events in Singapore's history. It is also home to some 260 plant species and diverse wildlife.

Fun Fact: The first Istana Open House was held on 1 January 1960.

Held during the Istana Open House, the Istana Heritage Tours are conducted in English and Mandarin at hourly intervals from 9am to 4pm. Fees apply, and all proceeds go to the benefitting organisations supported by the President's Challenge. Registration fees are not inclusive of admission fees to enter the Istana.
