### Sports

#### RI Sports Selection Criteria

- ▶ You must demonstrate interest and talent in sports beyond the abilities of children in your age-group  
OR
- ▶ You must have a record of accomplished performance in sports at National School Games, national and/or international levels.

#### Required Commitment

- ▶ Successful applicants for the Sports Domain are required to join the CCA of the talent area that they are accepted in.

## Annex A: Minimum Criteria for Specific Sports

- ▶ To help you decide if you should apply for a particular sports talent area, we have listed the **minimum** criteria which you should have attained in the specific sport.
- ▶ Applicants may not be shortlisted for an interview even when they meet the minimum criteria. The final shortlist will be decided based on the ranking of all applicants according to their sports trials, sporting achievements and academic results.
- ▶ Applicants should apply for **ONLY ONE** talent area from the Sports domain. Applying to multiple talent areas within the Sports domain may **void your DSA-Sec application**. Appeals or changes will not be permitted.

DSA Sports	Minimum Criteria
Badminton	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participated in 2026 Inter-Primary School Badminton NSG and in the starting line-up, OR</li> <li>• Participated in a local tournament (singles or doubles) and achieved a Top 4 placing - e.g. Pilot Pen Championship.</li> </ul>
Basketball	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participated in 2026 Inter-Primary School Basketball NSG and in the starting line-up for the competition.</li> </ul>
Cricket	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participated in a sanctioned hardball tournament in 2025/6, OR currently training with a cricket academy. Records of participation in sanctioned hardball tournament or current training in cricket academy must be provided in application.</li> </ul>
Cross Country	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participated in any long-distance events at the National Inter-Primary School Track &amp; Field Meet (NSG) 2026 or any official Track &amp; Field competition and achieved a Top 8 placing in at least 1 individual event.</li> </ul>
Hockey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participated in 2026 Inter-Primary School Hockey NSG and in the starting line-up of the competition, OR</li> <li>• Participated in any SHF age group competition</li> <li>• Active Participant in ActiveSG Hockey Academy</li> </ul>
Rugby	<p><u>Applicants from schools with Rugby CCA</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participated in 2026 Inter-Primary School Rugby NSG and in the starting line-up for the competition.</li> </ul> <p><u>Applicants from schools without Rugby CCA</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Trained and competed in club competitions under external junior rugby clubs in 2026</li> </ul>

Table Tennis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Participated in 2026 Inter-Primary School Table Tennis NSG and in the starting line-up, OR</li> <li>Member of the Junior Development Squad, OR</li> <li>Participated in the Crocodile Age Group Under 12 competition and achieved Top 8 placing</li> </ul>
Tennis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Participated in 2026 Inter-Primary School Tennis (NSG) and in the starting line-up, AND/OR</li> <li>Participated in local age group tournaments sanctioned by the Singapore Tennis Association and is ranked top 20 in Singapore, in the U12 category</li> </ul>
Track and Field	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Participated in the National Inter-Primary School Track &amp; Field Meet (NSG) 2026 or any official Track &amp; Field competition and achieved a Top 8 placing in at least 1 individual event.</li> </ul>
