OneAviation Resilience Package - Extension of Cost Relief for Aviation Companies

Airlines

- 10% rebate on landing charges for all scheduled passenger flights (excluding freighters) landing in Singapore between 1 April 2022 and 30 September 2022.
- 60% rebate on parking charges for all scheduled passenger flights (excluding freighters) at Changi Airport and Seletar Airport between 1 April 2022 and 30 September 2022.
- 60% rebate off fees payable by Singapore-based carriers between 1 April 2022 and 31 March 2023 for their Certificates of Airworthiness, as well as for providing scheduled air services.
- 40% rebate on rental paid for lounges and offices within Changi Airport and Seletar Airport terminal buildings between 1 April 2022 and 30 September 2022.

Ground Handlers

- 40% rebate on rental paid for lounges and offices within Changi Airport and Seletar Airport terminal buildings between 1 April 2022 and 30 September 2022.
- 40% rebate off license fees payable for ground handling and catering services at Changi Airport and Seletar Airport from 1 April 2022 and 30 September 2022.

Other Aviation Stakeholders

- Rebates on fees, charges, and rental.

The Changi Airport Group and the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore will share more details with eligible companies.

The Government will review the need to extend cost relief for 2H FY22/23 later this year, depending on the COVID-19 situation and the extent of air travel recovery.
