Expansion of hospital bed capacity & polyclinic network



Hospitals: 2,800 additional beds by 2030

- From 2027: Singapore General Hospital Elective Care Centre's opening; Sengkang General Hospital to add beds.
- From 2028: Redeveloped Alexandra Hospital to open progressively.
- From 2029: New Eastern General Hospital Campus to open progressively.
- Woodlands Hospital and Tan Tock Seng Hospital Integrated Care Hub will continue to ramp up bed capacity.



Polyclinics: 32 by 2030

- Completed by 2027: 3 new polyclinics in Bidadari, Kaki Bukit and Yew Tee.
- Completed by 2030: Taman Jurong Polyclinic completion; redevelopment of Clementi Polyclinic, Jurong Polyclinic, Queenstown Polyclinic and Toa Payoh Polyclinic.
- After 2030: New Bishan polyclinic, and consolidation of Bukit Merah and Outram polyclinics into one at Tiong Bahru.


Support for healthcare providers to onboard and contribute to NEHR

- **Launch of NEHR Connect Grant** - up to \$45 million to help healthcare providers defray costs to onboard and contribute to the National Electronic Health Record (NEHR), from July 2026.
- **Resources to help healthcare providers meet cybersecurity and data security obligations**, e.g. starter kit, training courses, self-assessment tool.



5 subdisciplines providing direct care with higher-risk assessments and interventions will be registered under the Allied Health Professions Act 2011. This will improve safety of psychological services and raise standards of care.

Strengthening regulatory framework for practice of Psychology



MOH and other partner Ministries will work with Singapore Psychological Society to provide clearer guidance on the type of psychological services and help the public identify the appropriate psychologist for their treatment needs.

Accelerated pathway for Clinical Psychology Specialisation

Eligible NUS undergraduates will be offered the option of an accelerated pathway to specialise in Clinical Psychology at Master's level, from intake cohort of 2026.

This will support the growing demand for mental health services and complement the existing regulatory framework.

Redesigning Nursing Post-Diploma Specialty programme into Work-Study format

Nanyang Polytechnic and Ngee Ann Polytechnic's nursing post-diploma specialty programmes to transit into work-study format in phases.

This helps to bridge the gap between study and practice, enabling nurses to be more confident and ready for their new roles upon completion of the programme.
