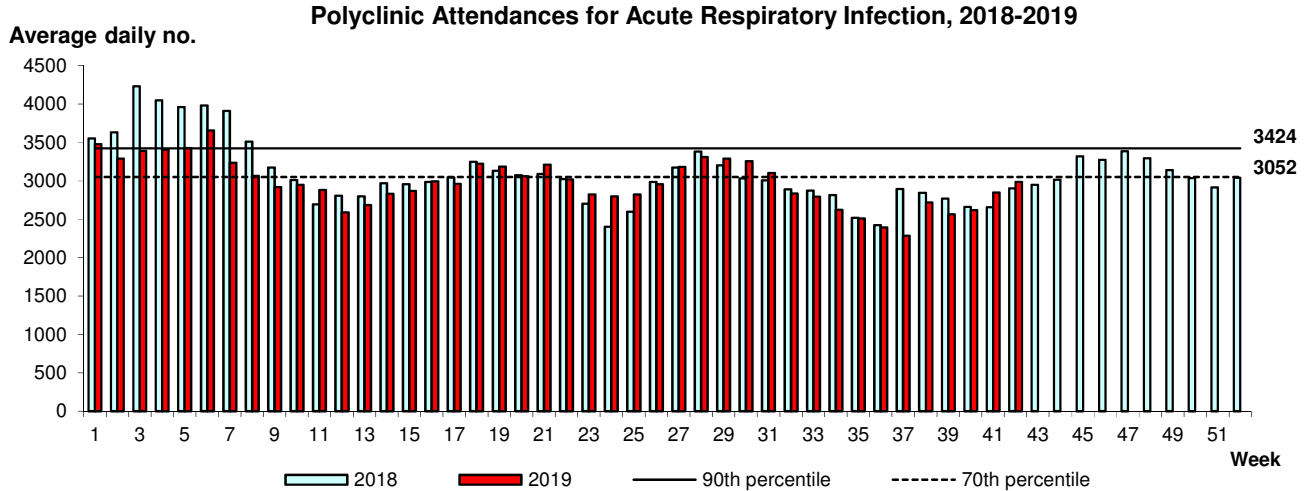

Influenza Situation in Singapore 2019

Influenza indicators for E-week 42 (13 - 19 Oct 2019) are as follows:

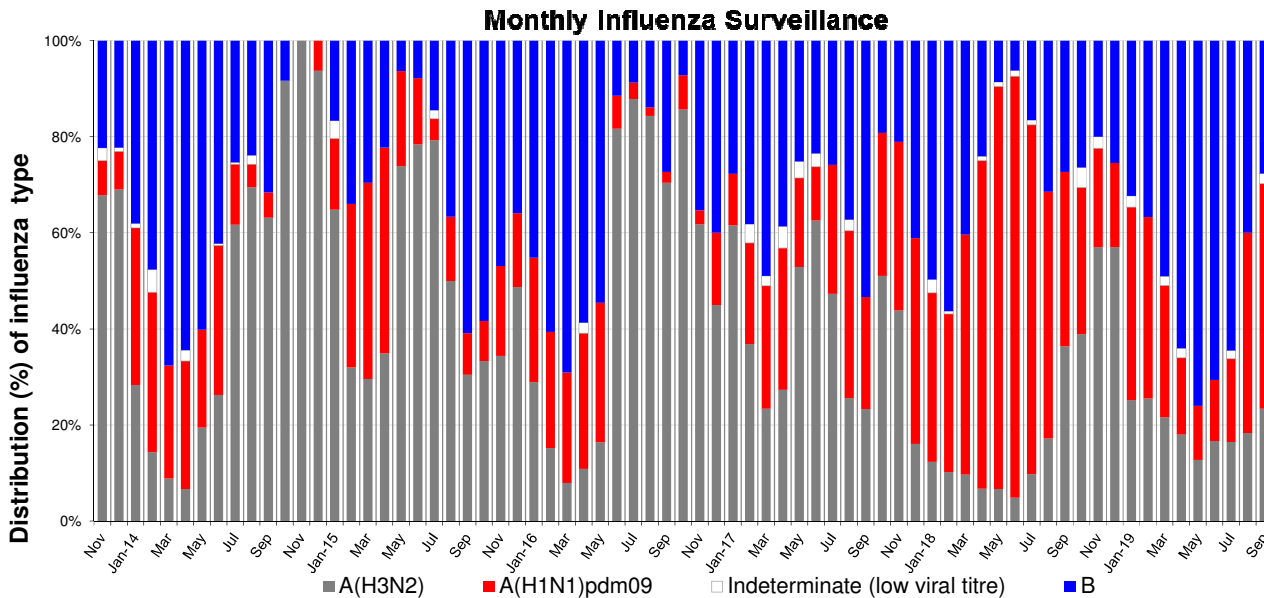
The average daily number of patients seeking treatment in the polyclinics for ARI is 2987 (over 5.5 working days) in E-week 42.



The proportion of patients with influenza-like illness (ILI) among the polyclinic attendances for ARI is 1.8%.

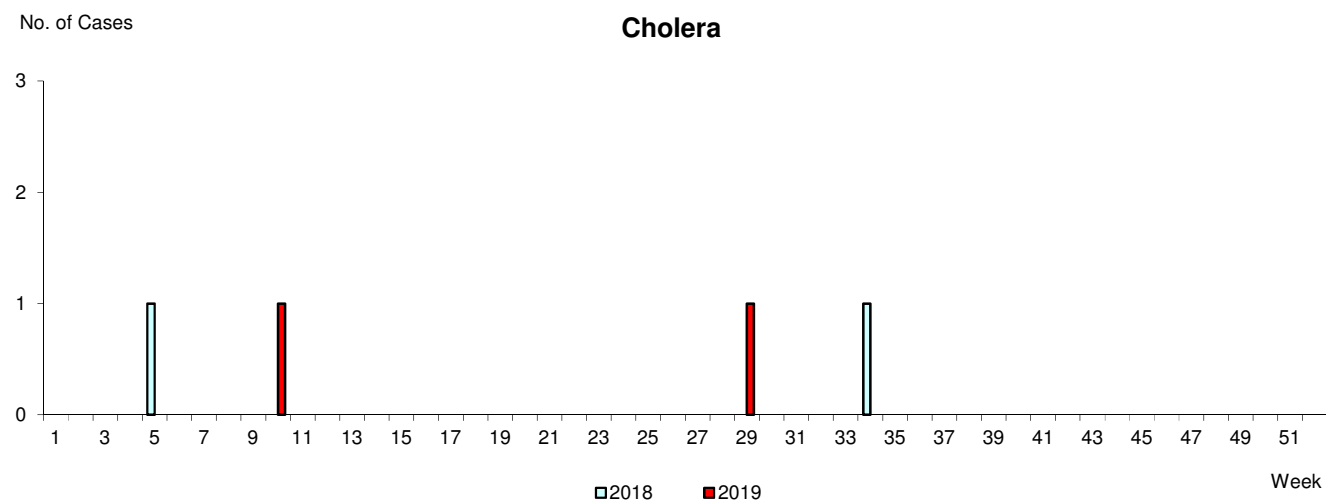
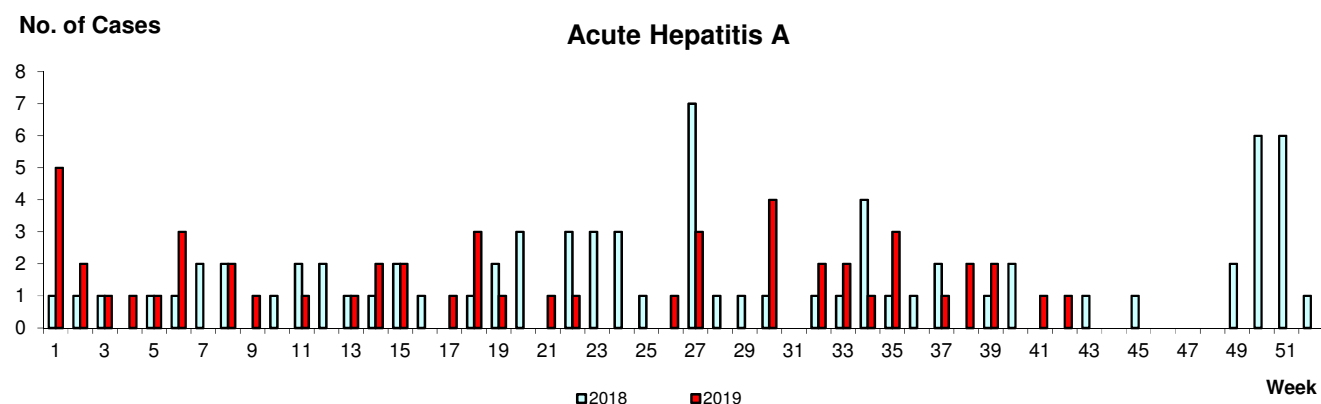
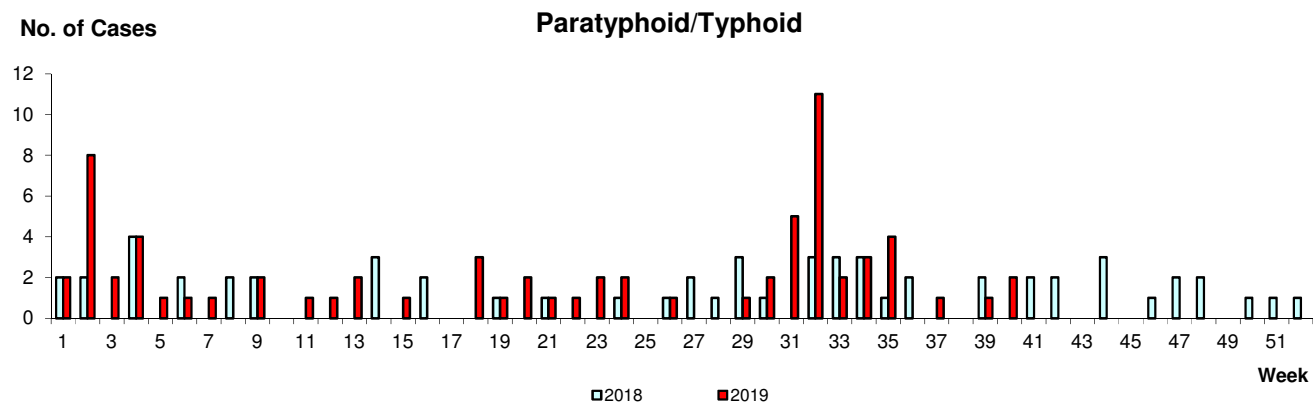
The overall positivity rate for influenza among ILI samples (n=253) in the community was 20.2% in the past 4 weeks.

Of the specimens tested positive for influenza in Sep 2019, they were positive for influenza A(H3N2) (23.4%), influenza A(H1N1)pdm09 (46.8%) and influenza B (27.7%). 2.1% of the influenza A specimens were untypable due to low viral titre.



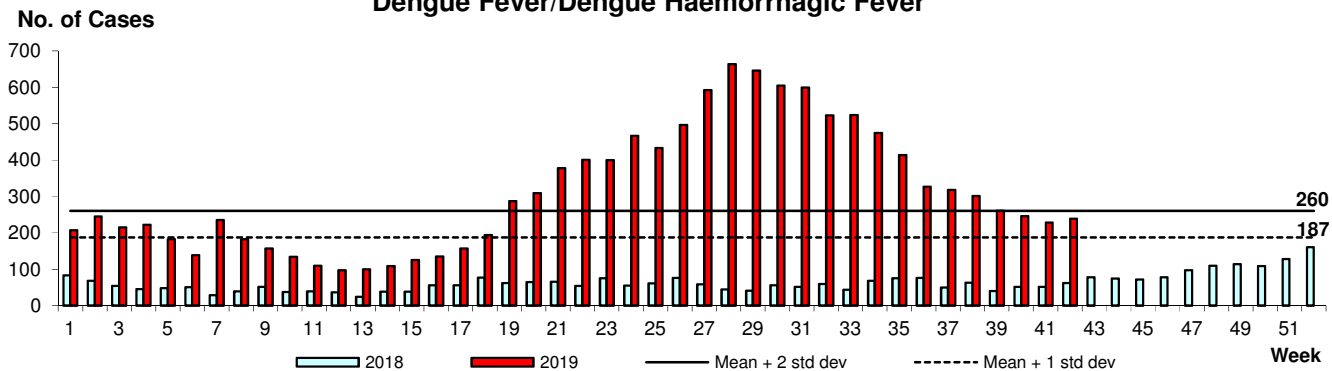

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF FOOD/WATER-BORNE DISEASES, 2018-2019

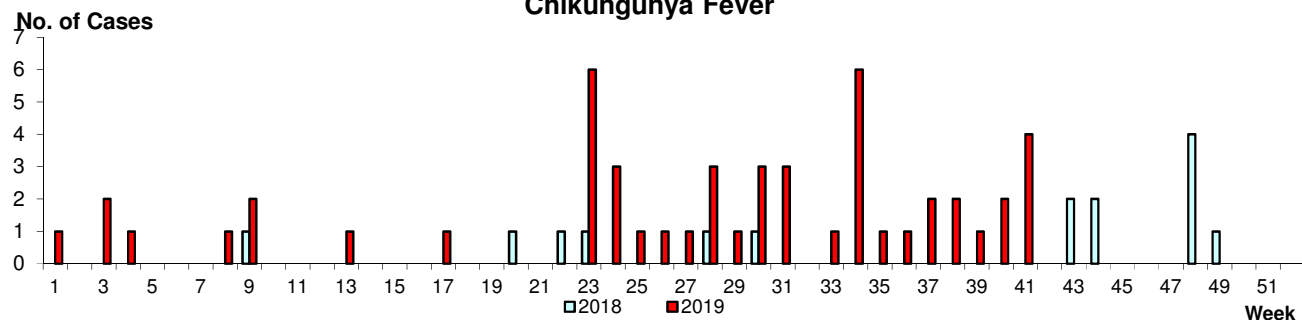

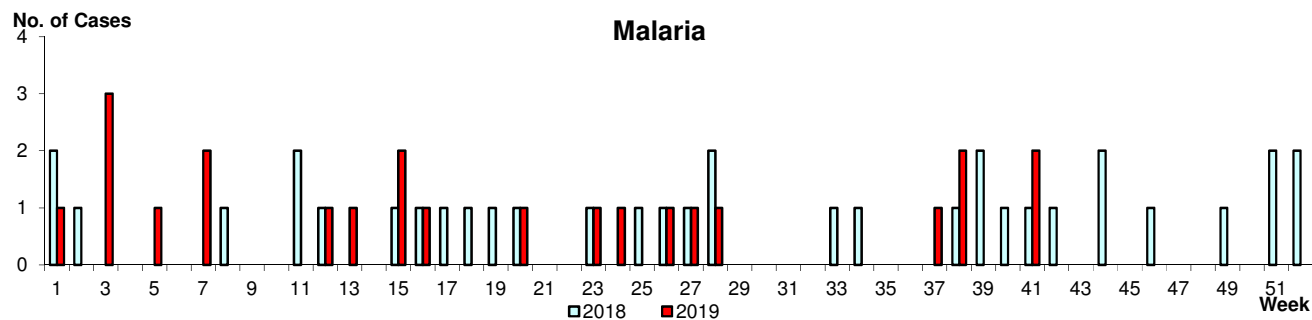

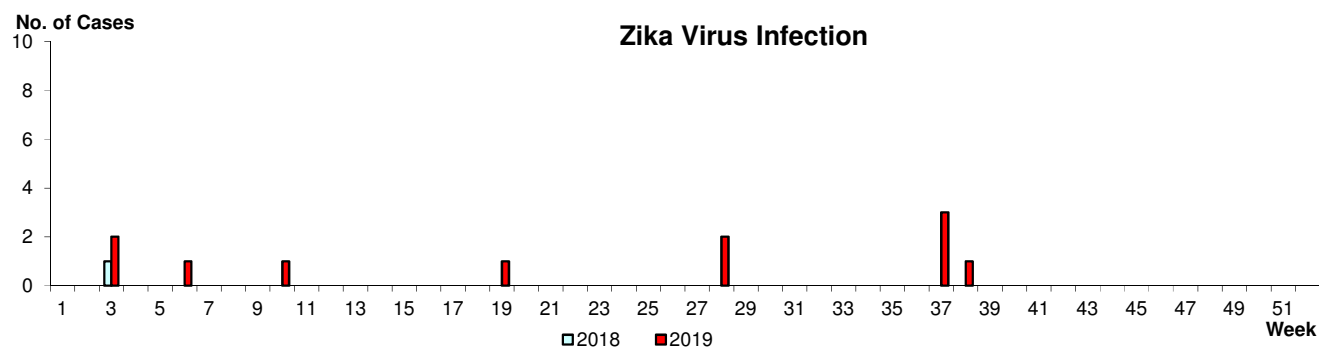

WEEKLY INCIDENCE OF AIR/DROPLET-BORNE DISEASES, 2018-2019



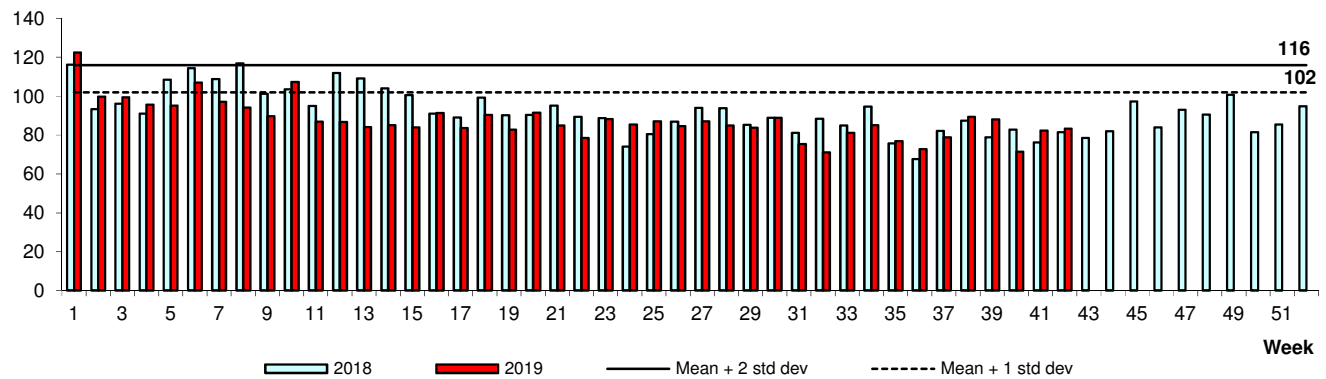

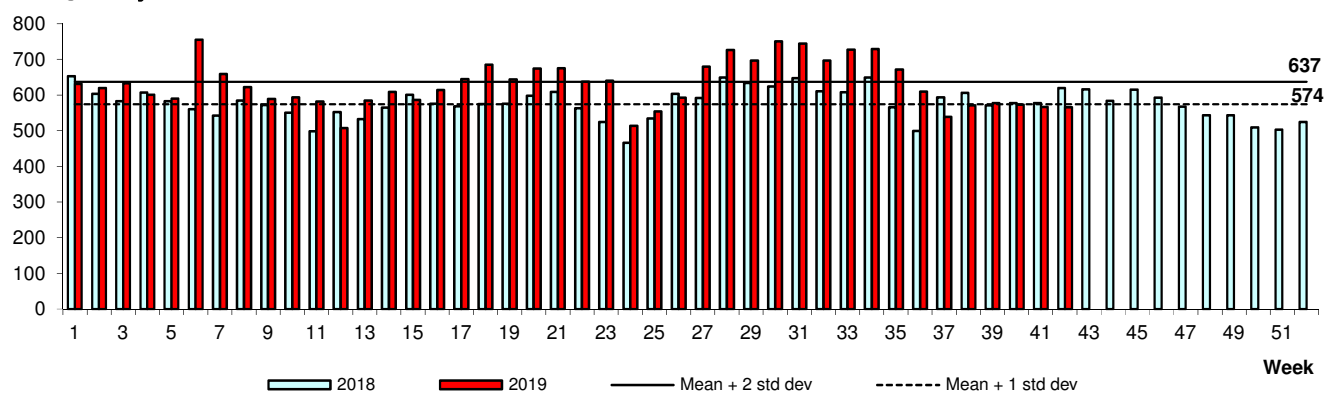
Conjunctivitis
