

### Guidelines for Duration of Data Migration and post-Data Migration Activities

	<b>Primary Care Sector (e.g. General Practitioners)</b>	<b>Community Care Sector (e.g. Active Ageing Centres)</b>
<b>Development of Data Migration Plan</b>	Up to two (2) weeks	Between two (2) to six (6) weeks <sup>[1]</sup>

<b>Follow-up post-Data Migration activities</b>	Approximately two (2) weeks from full cut-over to new Healthcare IT System	Approximately two (2) weeks from full cut-over to new Healthcare IT System
<b>Total duration</b>	Between two (2) weeks to ten (10) weeks, depending on number of clinics (and data to be migrated) and previous experience with migrating data from the Outgoing Healthcare IT Vendor	Between four (4) weeks to twelve (12) weeks, depending on number of providers (and data to be migrated) and previous experience with migrating data from the Outgoing Healthcare IT Vendor

[1] If data mapping is included, this would take another two (2) weeks.

[2] The time taken will also depend on any customisation/ enhancement needed to the Incoming Healthcare IT Vendor's system to meet Client's functional requirements.
