**Higher MediSave withdrawal limits** for outpatient treatment of chronic conditions under Chronic Disease Management Programme (CDMP), and selected vaccinations and tests.

- **Basic annual withdrawal limit - from \$500 to \$700**
- **Annual limit for patients with complex chronic conditions - from \$700 to \$1,000**

## MediSave Chronic and Preventive Care scheme (previously "MediSave500/700")

**CDMP expanded to include hyperthyroidism and hypothyroidism** - eligible for MediSave and CHAS subsidies.

MOH is studying the inclusion of other chronic conditions, e.g. eczema.



## Genetic testing for Hereditary Breast and Ovarian Cancer (HBOC)

**Those with HBOC-associated gene variants have a much higher risk of developing breast and ovarian cancer, and will benefit from early detection and prevention interventions.**

### **Support for genetic testing:**

- Up to 70% means-tested subsidies. Pioneer and Merdeka Generation seniors eligible for additional subsidies.
- Enhanced MediSave Chronic and Preventive Care scheme limits can be used
- Flexi-MediSave: Patients who are 60 and above may use this to defray their costs fully

**Support for relevant downstream interventions: Subsidies and MediSave coverage** (e.g. drug treatments and intensified surveillance)

### **Support for risk-reducing surgeries:**

**Extension of MediSave and MediShield Life coverage** for risk-reducing surgeries
