

FACT SHEET ON HEALTHHUB

About HealthHub

1. HealthHub is Singapore's first one-stop online health information and services portal and mobile application. HealthHub leverages on technology to provide Singaporeans with easy access to reliable health-related content, key medical records and e-services. This early release is designed to solicit user feedback to build a digital companion for healthy living, and aims to increase health literacy, encourage the adoption of healthy habits and to nudge Singaporeans to take greater ownership of their own health and wellness.
2. HealthHub is available at www.healthhub.sg. The mobile application – downloadable from the Apple App store and Google Play Store – will make localised health and wellness content, as well as personalised healthcare information, easily accessible for users.
3. Over the next few years, the portal will be enhanced to provide Singaporeans with reliable health-related content, key medical records and e-services.

Features which are currently available

4. Localised and citizen-centric health and wellness content: This takes the Singapore lifestyle and healthcare trends into perspective, and spans a myriad of topics, including chronic diseases, mental wellbeing, nutrition and physical activity. This was made possible by consolidating information from public healthcare institutions. Upon personalising their profiles, users will receive article and content recommendations tailored according to their areas of interest.
5. Key health records¹: Parents will be able to view their children's health records, such as immunisation records, dental health records and referral letters through HealthHub with a SingPass login. It also provides personal patient information, such as hospital discharge summary, lab test results (chronic diseases), screening records and future medical appointments. The information presented within HealthHub is drawn from a number of IT systems including the NEHR (National Electronic Healthcare Record) System, School Health System, School Dental System and National Immunisation Registry. Digitisation of medical records is an ongoing effort throughout healthcare and this journey will take some time to complete.
6. Health and wellness mobile deals: HealthHub makes healthy living easier and more rewarding through mobile deals redeemable at various healthcare, wellness, recreation, fitness and food and beverage establishments.
7. Healthpoints: HealthHub users can earn and accumulate Healthpoints by sharing health articles, events and apps read through social media. These Healthpoints can be converted to rewards such as NTUC LinkPoints, which can be used to offset grocery bills, redeem vouchers and other deals offered by participating partners.
8. Directory of healthcare facilities and services: This guide allows users to locate the nearest and most appropriate facility for their medical and lifestyle needs such as polyclinics, screening centres, healthier eateries and sports facilities.

 - Student Health/Dental Consent Form

 - Patient Medication (e.g. Medication reminders, Medication Refill, Medication Adherence Data)
 - Medication Information Leaflet
 - Patient Self Management of Chronic Conditions
