Trap-Neuter-Rehome/Release-Manage (TNRM)) Programme for Community Cats



The Animal & Veterinary Service (AVS) implemented the TNRM Cats programme on 1 September 2024. TNRM is a humane, science-based approach to sustainably manage the community cat population, whereby cats are trapped, sterilised and microchipped before being rehomed or released. The TNRM Cats Grant is open to all AVS Animal Welfare Group partners for application.

Funding Support under AVS

Grant partners can seek reimbursement from AVS by submitting the required documentation (e.g. certificates and invoices).
