8 WAYS TO BE A GOOD GERBIL OWNER



Give Your Gerbil Company

Gerbils are social animals. Give them social interaction by keeping them in pairs or small groups. Ensure that pairs are of the same sex or sterilised to avoid unwanted litters.



Give Your Gerbils a Large Cage

Provide your pets with a big cage (at least 4000cm²) with a solid bottom to reduce stress.



3 Create a Safe and Enriching Environment for Your Gerbils

Give your gerbils deep bedding, a large wheel, and other accessories for it to exhibit natural behaviours like burrowing.




Clean Your Gerbils' Cage Regularly

Spot clean daily and deep clean when necessary to reduce odour and the risks of illness.



5 Keep Your Gerbils' Cage in a Safe Environment

Keep your gerbils safely indoors and away from sun, rain, and other larger pets.



6 Provide Appropriate Gerbil Food and Fresh Water

Offer nutritionally well-balanced food to ensure your gerbils' health.





Play and interact with your gerbils to bond with them. Take the opportunity to check on them for any signs of illness.



8 Bring Your Gerbils to the Vet When Necessary

If your gerbils are unwell or injured, bring them to a vet experienced with gerbils for treatment.
