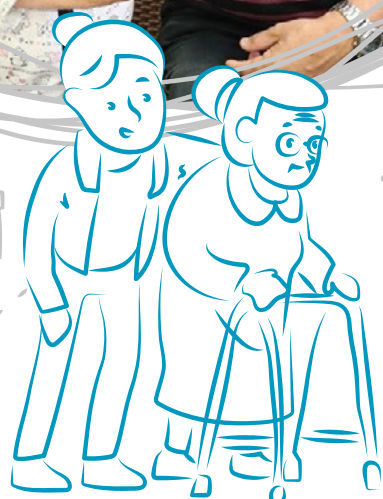

Dear Friends,

FY 2018/2019 has been a fruitful year for the South West Community.

The South West Community Development Council redoubled its efforts to forge meaningful partnerships so as to deliver more holistic and inclusive programmes for our community. As a result, the number of our corporate and community partners grew by 20% to nearly 900 and together, we reached out to about 270,000 residents. In addition, 14,000 households also benefitted from 20 local assistance schemes and programmes.

We are grateful for the kind generosity of many Singaporeans. Corporate cash donations grew by 10% to almost \$1 million, giving impetus to the vibrant myriad of programmes in the South West District. To meet new and emerging needs, we launched 13 fresh and enhanced initiatives, such as Festive Cheers @ South West 2018's interfaith festive giving and Love Your Living Environment Youth Challenge which spur youth to promote a greener and cleaner environment. Other key efforts included CARE Ride @ South West for intergenerational bonding, and the SkillsFuture Festival Executive Series @ South West for residents to stay ahead with relevant skills for the future.

All these progress would not have been possible without your support. Thank you for your commitment and contributions that have strengthened and uplifted our community. Let us continue to work together to build a caring and inclusive South West.

2018/2019财政年度是西南社区卓有成效的一年。

西南社区发展理事会投入加倍努力，通过极具意义的伙伴关系，为我们的社区提供更全面和具包容性的方案。在这年度里，我们的企业和社区伙伴总数增长了20%，达到近900名伙伴。我们与这些伙伴们一同让27万名居民受惠。并且，共有1万4千户家庭从20个地方援助计划中获得帮助。

感恩新加坡民众慷慨解囊，使善心捐款增长了10%而达到近一百万元，协助推动西南社区各种蓬勃精彩的活动计划。为了迎合不断涌现的需求，我们推出了13项全新与加强版的计划，如有跨文化、宗教信仰团体分发温馨礼包的2018年“欢庆佳节在西南”（Festive Cheers @ South West）、激励青少年推动环保和环境整洁的“热爱你的生活环境西南社区青年挑战”（Love Your Living Environment Youth Challenge）等。其他主要项目还有促进代际关系的“关爱巴士西南游”（CARE Ride @ South West），以及让居民掌握相关技能以与时俱进的西南技能创前程之行政系列（SkillsFuture Festival Executive Series @ South West）。

若没有大家的鼎力支持，必不能取得这么多骄人的成果。感谢有你们的付出和贡献，我们的社区才得以改进和提升。且让彼此继续携手努力，打造更具有关爱和包容精神的西南社区。

Tahun fiskal 2018/2019 menjadi tahun yang membuahkan hasil bagi Komuniti Barat Daya.

CDC Barat Daya menggandakan semula usahanya untuk menjalin persahabatan yang bermakna untuk menyampaikan program yang lebih holistik dan inklusif untuk komuniti kita. Hasilnya, bilangan badan korporat dan rakan kongsi komuniti kita berkembang sebanyak 20% sehingga hampir 900 badan korporat dan bersama-sama, kita mendekati hampir 270,000 para penduduk. Selain itu, 14,000 isi rumah juga menerima manfaat daripada hampir 20 skim bantuan setempat.

Kami bersyukur atas kemurahan hati ramai rakyat Singapura. Derma wang tunai meningkat sebanyak 10% kepada hampir \$1 juta, lantas memberikan dorongan kepada kepelbagaian program yang memeriahkan di daerah Barat Daya. Untuk memenuhi keperluan yang baharu dan akan datang, kami melancarkan 13 inisiatif yang segar dan dipertingkat seperti Sorakan Perayaan @ Barat Daya (Festive Cheers @ South West) yang merupakan perayaan pelbagai agama dan Cabaran Belia Sayang Alam Sekitar Hidup Anda (Love Your Living Environment Youth Challenge) yang menggalakkan orang muda untuk mempromosikan persekitaran yang lebih hijau dan bersih. Usaha penting yang lain termasuk Tumpangan CARE @ Barat Daya (CARE Ride @ South West) untuk jalinan antara generasi dan Siri Eksekutif Festival SkillsFuture @ Barat Daya untuk residen kekal maju dengan kemahiran relevan untuk masa depan.

Semua kemajuan ini tidak akan terjadi tanpa sokongan anda. Terima kasih atas komitmen dan sumbangan yang telah memperkasakan dan meningkatkan komuniti kita. Mari kita terus bekerja bersama untuk membina Barat Daya yang penyayang dan inklusif.

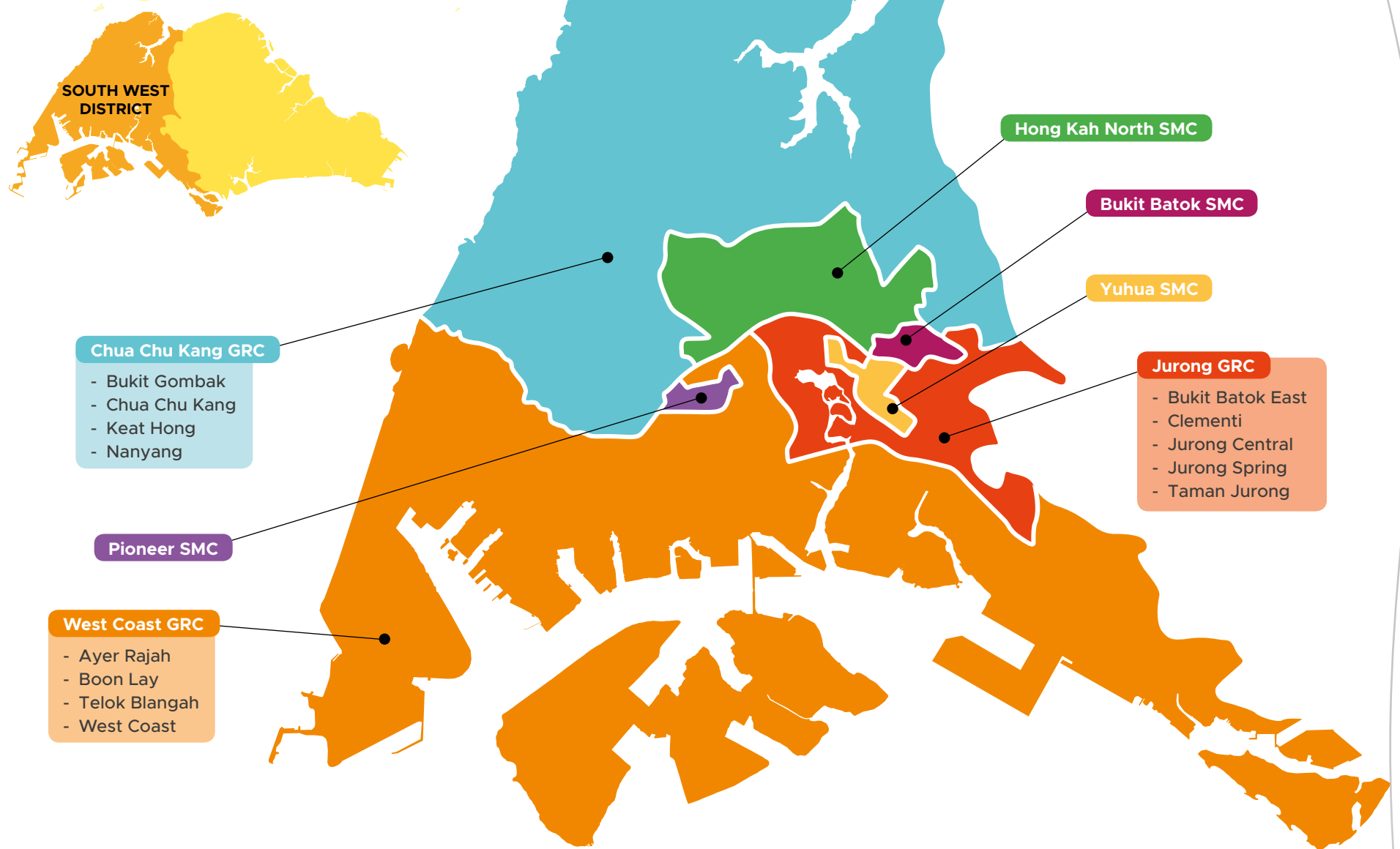
அன்பார்ந்த நண்பர்களை

நிதியாண்டு 2018/2019, தென் மேற்கு சமூகத்திற்கு ஒரு பயனுள்ள ஆண்டாக அமைந்தது. தென்மேற்கு சமூக மேம்பாட்டு மன்றம் நமது சமூகத்திற்கு மேலும் முழுமையாகவும் அனைவருக்கும் பயன்தரும் வகையிலும் திட்டங்களை அளிப்பதற்காக, அர்த்தமுள்ள கூட்டணியை ஏற்படுத்துவதற்கான முயற்சிகளை இரட்டிப்பாக்கியுள்ளது. இதன் விளைவாக கிட்டத்தட்ட 900 பெருநிறுவன மற்றும் சமூக பங்காளிகளுடன் (சென்ற நிதியாண்டை விட 20% அதிகம்) நாங்கள் ஒன்று சேர்ந்து சுமார் 270,000 குடியிருப்பாளர்களுக்கு உதவினோம். அதுமட்டுமல்லாமல் கூடுதலாக 14,000 குடும்பங்கள், சுமார் 20 உள்ளூர் உதவித் திட்டங்களின் மூலம் பயனடைந்துள்ளன.

தாராள மனம் கொண்ட பல சிங்கப்பூர்களுக்கு நாங்கள் நன்றி கூற விரும்புகிறோம். ரொக்க நன்கொடைகள் 10% அதிகரித்ததால் சுமார் \$1 மில்லியன் மதிப்புள்ள நன்கொடைகள் கிடைத்தன. இந்த நன்கொடைகளின் அதிகரிப்பு தென் மேற்கு வட்டாரத்திற்கான எண்ணற்றத் திட்டங்களுக்கு தூண்டுதலாக அமைந்தது. புதிதாக தோன்றும் தேவைகளைப் பூர்த்தி செய்ய, மதநல்லிணக்க பரிசளிப்பு விழா, “..பெஸ்டிவ் சியர்ஸ் @ தென்மேற்கு 2018” (Festive Cheers @ South West 2018) மற்றும் இளையர்களை பசுமையான மற்றும் சுத்தமான தூழலை ஊக்குவிக்கத் தூண்டும், “நீங்கள் வாழும் தூழலை நேசியங்கள் இளையர் சவால்” (Love Your Living Environment Youth Challenge) போன்ற 13 புதிய மேம்படுத்தப்பட்ட முயற்சிகளை நாங்கள் தொடங்கினோம். தென் மேற்கில் தலைமுறைகளுக்கு இடையிலான பிணைப்புக்கான “கேர் ரைடு @ தென்மேற்கு” (CARE Ride), மற்றும் தென் மேற்கு குடியிருப்பாளர்களின் எதிர்காலத்திற்குத் தேவையான திறன்களைப் பெற்று முன்னோக்கிச் செல்ல உதவும் “ஸ்கில்ஸ்-பூய்ச்சர் விழா செயலாண்மைத் தொடர்” (SkillsFuture Festival Executive Series) போன்ற முக்கிய அம்சங்களும் இடம் பெற்றன.

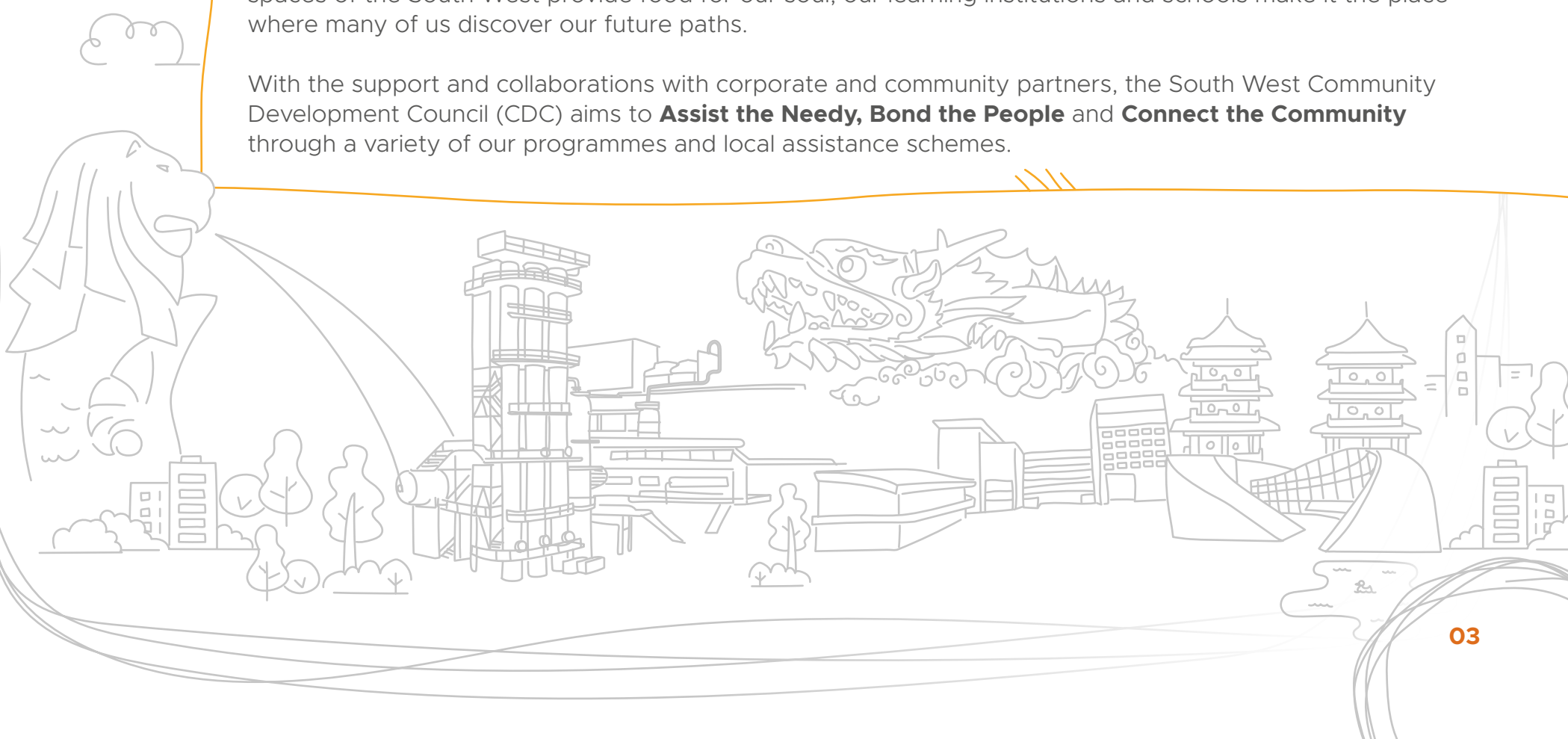
OUR SOUTH WEST OUR HOME

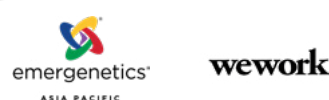
SKILLSFUTURE EXECUTIVE SERIES
